


Daily Report 244/2019

15 October 2019¹

Summary

- Compared with the previous 24 hours, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations in both Donetsk and Luhansk regions.
- Civilians, including children, injured from hand grenades and landmines in non-government-controlled areas of Donetsk and Luhansk regions.
- Small-arms fire was assessed as directed at SMM mini-unmanned aerial vehicles near government-controlled Novotroitske and Berezove.
- Inside the Stanytsia Luhanska disengagement area, the SMM continued observing clearing of vegetation by members of the armed formations.
- Inside the disengagement areas near Zolote and Petrivske, the SMM continued seeing military and military-type presence and hardware.
- The Mission monitored adherence to the ceasefire to facilitate the operation of and repairs to critical civilian infrastructure along the contact line.
- The SMM monitored events related to the Defender of Ukraine Day.
- Restrictions of the Mission's freedom of movement continued, including at a checkpoint of the armed formations near Bezimenne, Zaichenko, Novoazovsk, and at a border crossing point near non-government-controlled Izvaryne.*



In Donetsk region, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations, including more explosions (about 325), compared with the <u>previous 24 hours</u> (76 explosions). The majority of ceasefire violations were recorded in northerly directions of Shyrokyne (government-controlled, 100km south of Donetsk), in areas west, north-west and south-south-east of Horlivka (non-government-controlled, 39km north-east of Donetsk) and in areas south-east, south-west and west-south-west of Svitlodarsk (government-controlled, 57km north-east of Donetsk), where the majority of explosions were recorded.

In Luhansk region, the Mission recorded more ceasefire violations, including more explosions (six), compared with the <u>previous 24 hours</u> (one explosion). The majority of ceasefire violations, including most of explosions, were recorded at southerly directions of Popasna (government-controlled, 69km west of Luhansk).

Civilians, including children, injured from hand grenades and landmines in nongovernment-controlled areas of Donetsk and Luhansk regions

The SMM followed up on reports of a boy injured from the explosion of a hand grenade in Sontseve (non-government-controlled, 55km south-east of Donetsk) on 12 October. On 14 October, at Donetsk Regional Clinical Trauma Hospital, medical staff told the SMM that a nine-year-old boy had been admitted on 12 October with an injury to his left hand caused by a detonation, as result of which he had to have four fingers amputated. At the same hospital, the mother (in her forties) of the boy told the Mission that her son had been injured on 12 October in Sontseve, when an object he picked up on the side of the road exploded in his hand.

The Mission followed up on reports of two women and a man injured at a cemetery in Donetsk city (non-government-controlled) on 12 October. On 13 October at the Hospital No.9 in Donetsk city, the SMM saw a woman (in her fifties) lying on her side, her right arm suspended by a metal rail and an iodine-soaked bandage around her right wrist. She told the Mission that on 12 October she had been at the Novodivyche cemetery with her son (in his twenties) helping a friend (a woman in her fifties) clean a grave of a relative when she touched a green hand grenade which subsequently detonated. The woman told the Mission that her son had also sustained injuries in the explosion. Medical staff at the hospital told the SMM that two women (in their fifties) and a man (in his twenties) had been admitted to the hospital on 12 October with multiple shrapnel injuries caused by the detonation of a device, and that one of the women had been later transferred to the Regional Clinical Kalinina Hospital in Donetsk city (at this hospital, medical staff refused to provide information, citing lack of request to those in control*). On 14 October, the second woman told the Mission over the phone that she had sustained injuries from an explosion which occurred when she and her friend with her son were cleaning their relatives' grave at the Novodivyche cemetery.

On 13 October, the SMM followed up on reports of a 33-year-old man injured by a landmine in Krasny Yar (non-government-controlled, 12km north-east of Luhansk). On 13 October in a residential area of Krasny Yar, about 200m west of the Siverskyi Donets riverbank, the Mission saw a man in civilian clothing on a stretcher, carried by members of the armed formations from a field to an ambulance. It saw that the man had severe injuries to his right leg. On 14 October at a hospital in Luhansk city, medical staff told the SMM that a man from Krasny Yar had been admitted on 13 October with injuries from a mine explosion, as the result of which part of his right leg had to be amputated.

The SMM also followed up on reports of five children (three boys and two girls) injured from a hand grenade on 28 September in Chornohorivka (formerly Krasna Zoria, non-government-controlled, 51km south-west of Luhansk). On 7 October, medical staff at a children's hospital

in Luhansk told the Mission that five children from Chornohorivka had been admitted on 28 September with injuries. On 30 September in Chornohorivka, a woman (in her sixties) told the Mission that on 28 September she had seen five children (three boys and two girls) injured. On the same day, in Chornohorivka the SMM saw a small fresh crater covered with leaves, on the right side of road. On 14 October, the father (in his thirties) of the girls told the Mission that on 28 September he had seen three boys throw an object on the ground which exploded near the road. At the time, his daughters had been standing in front of their house, about 8m from the boys, and suffered shrapnel injuries.

Small-arms fire assessed as directed at SMM mini unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV) near Novotroitske and Berezove

While conducting a mini-UAV flight on the southern edge of Novotroitske (government-controlled, 36km south-west of Donetsk), the Mission heard 15-20 shots of small-arms fire, about 100-200m north-north-east, assessed as aimed at the UAV, which was flying about 800m north-north-east of the SMM's location.

While conducting another mini-UAV flight about 1km north-east of Berezove (government-controlled, 31km south-west of Donetsk), the Mission heard a burst and five shots of small-arms fire about 1km east, assessed as aimed at the UAV, which was flying about 1.2km east of the SMM's location.

On both occasions, the SMM safely landed the UAV and left the area.*

Disengagement areas near Stanytsia Luhanska, Zolote and Petrivske⁵

On 14 October, inside the **disengagement area near Stanytsia Luhanska** (government-controlled, 16km north-east of Luhansk), the SMM saw three members of the armed formations starting a small fire to burn garbage and vegetation on the southern edge of the broken section of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge. The Mission also observed members of the armed formations (wearing "JCCC" armbands) on the southern edge of the broken section of the bridge and the checkpoint of the armed formations.

On the evening of 13 October, the SMM camera in Stanytsia Luhanska recorded an illumination flare at an assessed range of 3-5km south-west, assessed as outside the disengagement area but within its 5km periphery.

On the night of 13-14 October, the SMM camera in **Zolote** (government-controlled, 60km west of Luhansk) recorded an illumination flare at an assessed range of 4-6km south-east (unable to assess whether inside or outside the disengagement area). It also recorded two projectiles and an undetermined explosion, all at an assessed range of 3-6km at easterly directions, all assessed as outside the disengagement area but within its 5km periphery.

On 13 October, inside the disengagement area near Zolote, an SMM long-range UAV <u>again</u> spotted a defensive position of the Ukrainian Armed Forces on road T-1316 south of the railway tracks. Outside the Zolote disengagement area, the UAV spotted an armoured reconnaissance vehicle (BRM-1K) at the checkpoint of the Ukrainian Armed Forces about 300m north of the disengagement area. About 800m further north, the UAV spotted a military

camp with an excavator, a mobile crane and two mobile workshops mounted on trucks, as well as four additional trucks.

On 14 October, inside the disengagement area, the SMM saw the completion of the installation of soil-filled Hesco-type barriers about 30m south of the northern edge of the disengagement area, on the eastern side of road T-1316 (for previous observations, see <u>SMM</u> Daily Report 14 October 2019).

On 13 October, inside the **disengagement area near Petrivske** (non-government-controlled, 41km south of Donetsk), an SMM long-range UAV <u>again</u> spotted an armoured personnel carrier (APC) (BTR-variant) and two trucks about 1.2km south of its northern edge and about 1.2km west of its eastern edge, assessed as belonging to the Ukrainian Armed Forces. About 150m further south the same UAV <u>again</u> spotted a heavy utility truck, and about 680m west-north-west of the aforementioned position it spotted an APC (BTR variant) in a treeline, all assessed as belonging to the Ukrainian Armed Forces. The same UAV also spotted defensive positions about 380m and 560m south of the disengagement area's northern edge and about 700m and 2km west of its eastern edge, respectively. The SMM long-range UAV also spotted a defensive position inside a treeline on the south-eastern corner of the Petrivske disengagement area, about 40m north of is southern edge and about 100m west of its eastern edge, near the most forward position of the Ukrainian Armed Forces.

Outside the disengagement area, the same UAV <u>again</u> spotted defensive positions of the armed formations, about 400m west of the disengagement area's north-eastern edge and about 80m of a <u>previously reported</u> trench, which extends for about 80m inside the disengagement area from these positions.

On 14 October, while positioned north of Petrivske, the SMM heard an undetermined explosion at an assessed range of 3-4km south-west, assessed as inside the disengagement area. The Mission also heard four bursts of small-arms fire at an assessed range of 1-2km south-west (unable to assess whether inside or outside the disengagement area), as well as 52 undetermined explosions and four bursts of small-arms fire, at an assessed range of 2-5km west and 2-6km south-east respectively; an uncountable number of bursts of small-arms fire and 34 shots and bursts of heavy-machine-gun and small-arms fire, all at an assessed range of 2-4km at westerly and 1-3km at southerly directions, all assessed as outside the disengagement area but within its 5km periphery. On the same day, while positioned near Bohdanivka (government-controlled, 41km south-west of Donetsk), the SMM heard nine undetermined explosions and 15 bursts of small-arms fire, all at an assessed range of 2-4km north-west, all assessed as outside the Petrivske disengagement area but within its 5km periphery.

Withdrawal of weapons

The SMM continued to monitor the withdrawal of weapons in implementation of the Memorandum and the Package of Measures and its Addendum.

On 13 October, the Mission observed three weapons in violation of withdrawal lines in non-government-controlled areas of Donetsk region. It also observed 16 weapons beyond withdrawal lines but outside storage sites in government-controlled areas of Donetsk region (for more details, see the tables below).

Indications of military and military-type presence in the security zone⁶

The SMM observed military and military-type presence in the security zone in government-controlled areas of Donetsk and Luhansk regions as well as in non-government-controlled areas of Donetsk region, including armoured personnel carriers, armoured combat vehicles and infantry fighting vehicles (for more details, see the table below).

Works at the checkpoint of the armed formations near Horlivka

On 13 October, within a checkpoint of the armed formations in Horlivka, the SMM saw that the ground of an area (50m long and 10m wide) where cars usually queue had been scrapped. It saw two dump trucks and two excavators next to it as well as several freshly dug ditches about 2m of the road. The Mission observed regular vehicular traffic at the checkpoint.

Cargo train in non-government-controlled area

On 14 October, near the railway station in Debaltseve (non-government-controlled, 58km north-east of Donetsk), the SMM saw a train powered by a locomotive pulling 30-40 coal wagons, some carrying coal and some covered, with identifiable administrative numbers of freight companies registered in the Russian Federation. The train was heading south-west

SMM facilitation of operation of and repair works to civilian infrastructure

The SMM monitored adherence to the ceasefire to facilitate repairs to power lines near Artema (government-controlled, 26km north of Luhansk), an inspection of power lines and maintenance of water pipes ahead of the drilling of wells near Pankivka (non-government-controlled, 16km north of Luhansk) and repairs to power lines between Svitlodarsk and Luhanske (government-controlled, 59km east of Donetsk).

The Mission continued to facilitate the operation of the Donetsk Filtration Station (15km north of Donetsk) and monitor the security situation in the area of the pumping station near Vasylivka (non-government-controlled, 20km north of Donetsk).

Population survey in non-government-controlled areas of Donetsk and Luhansk region

On 14 October, 12 people from non-government-controlled areas of Donetsk region told the SMM that they had participated in a population survey. At a population survey centre located at an education facility in Horlivka, three women and two men conducting the survey told the Mission that the people collecting data for the survey were trained and instruction booklets had been distributed to them. Outside another such facility in Horlivka, four women told the Mission that the population survey was well advertised in the media and that the residents also received SMS notifications. On the same day, in Holubivka (formerly Kirovsk, non-government-controlled, 51km west of Luhansk) and Lozivskyi (non-government-controlled, 32km west of Luhansk), two residents (men, aged 35 and 75) told the SMM that those conducting the population survey had visited their residence and did not request any documents to collect data for the survey.

Border areas outside government control

On 13 October, while at a border crossing point near Izvaryne (52km south-east of Luhansk), the SMM saw a covered cargo truck with Ukrainian licence plates and eight pedestrians (four men and four women) entering Ukraine. The Mission also saw a car with Russian Federation licence plates, a covered cargo truck with Ukrainian licence plates and eight pedestrians (four men and four women) exiting Ukraine. After about ten minutes, a member of the armed formations told the SMM to leave the area.*

While at the pedestrian border crossing point near Sievernyi (50km south-east of Luhansk) for about 20 minutes, the Mission saw a man and three women entering and a man, three women and a child exiting Ukraine.

The SMM monitored events related to the Defender of Ukraine Day

On 14 October in Kyiv, the SMM saw about 5,000 people (men and women, mixed ages) gathered in Shevchenko Park on the occasion of the Defender of Ukraine Day. Later, the Mission saw around 15,000 people walk to *Maidan Nezhalezhnosti*. Throughout the gathering it heard participants express messages critical of recent political developments concerning certain areas of Donetsk and Luhansk regions. The SMM later saw about 8,000 people move to 11 Bankova Street, where some of the participants left stickers on the front wall of the Presidential Office building. The participants dispersed with no incidents.

The SMM also monitored events related to the Defender of Ukraine Day in Odessa, Kharkiv, Dnipro and Ivano-Frankivsk. During a public gathering in Kharkiv, the Mission saw smoke and heard the sound of an explosion of pyrotechnics on Sumska Street that were used by the people gathered.

The Mission continued monitoring in Kherson, Lviv, and Chernivtsi.

*Restrictions of the SMM's freedom of movement or other impediments to fulfilment of its mandate

The SMM's monitoring and freedom of movement are restricted by security hazards and threats, including risks posed by mines, unexploded ordnance (UXO) and other impediments — which vary from day to day. The SMM's mandate provides for safe and secure access throughout Ukraine. All signatories of the Package of Measures have agreed on the need for this safe and secure access, that restriction of the SMM's freedom of movement constitutes a violation, and on the need for rapid response to these violations. They have also agreed that the JCCC should contribute to such response and co-ordinate mine clearance. Nonetheless, the armed formations in parts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions frequently deny the SMM access to areas adjacent to Ukraine's border outside control of the Government (for example, see below). The SMM's operations in Donetsk and Luhansk regions remain restricted following the fatal incident of 23 April 2017 near Pryshyb; these restrictions continued to limit the Mission's observations.

<u>Denial of access</u>:

- At a checkpoint west of Bezimenne (non-government-controlled, 100km south of Donetsk), two armed members of the armed formations denied the SMM passage citing "orders from superiors". While at the checkpoint, the SMM did not see any vehicular traffic entering or exiting through the said checkpoint.
- At a checkpoint north of Zaichenko (non-government-controlled, 93km south of Donetsk), two armed members of the armed formations <u>again</u> prevented the SMM from proceeding towards Sakhanka (non-government-controlled, 97km south of Donetsk), citing "ongoing kinetic activities in the area and the safety of the patrol".

- At a checkpoint on the northern edge of Novoazovsk (non-government-controlled, 102km south-east of Donetsk), two armed members of the armed formations <u>again</u> denied the SMM access south towards Novoazovsk, citing "an ongoing operation in the area".
- At the border crossing point near Izvaryne (non-government-controlled, 52km southeast Luhansk), a member of the armed formations told the SMM to leave the area.

Delay:

- At a checkpoint on the northern edge of Petrivske (non-government-controlled, 41km south of Donetsk), a member of the armed formations allowed the SMM to proceed only after about 20 minutes of waiting.

Regular restrictions related to disengagement areas and mines/UXO:

- The sides continued to deny the SMM full access, as well as the ability to travel certain roads previously identified as important for effective monitoring by the Mission and for civilians' movement, through failure to conduct comprehensive clearance of mines, UXO and other obstacles.

Other impediments:

- On the night of 12 and 13 October, an SMM long-range UAV lost its GPS signal due to signal interference, assessed as caused by probable jamming, while flying between Kostiantynivka (government-controlled, 60km north of Donetsk) and Donetsk city's Petrovskyi district (non-government controlled, 15km south-west of Donetsk city centre). The same UAV also experienced dual GPS signal interference, assessed as caused by jamming, while flying over the Petrivske disengagement area.
- On the night of 13 and 14 October, an SMM long-range UAV lost its GPS signal due to signal interference, assessed as caused by probable jamming, while flying over the contact line, in both government- and non-government-controlled areas of central Donetsk region. The same UAV also experienced dual GPS signal interference, assessed as caused by jamming, while flying over non-government-controlled areas of both central Donetsk and Luhansk regions.
- On 14 October, on two separate occasions, SMM mini-UAVs lost GPS signal due to signal interference, assessed as caused by probable jamming while flying in the vicinity of Kostiantynivka (government-controlled, 60km north of Donetsk and Chermalyk (government-controlled, 77km south of Donetsk).
- While conducting a mini-UAV flight over areas near Novotroitske (government-controlled, 36km south-west of Donetsk), the SMM heard shots of small-arms fire about 800m north-north-east, assessed as aimed at the UAV, which it landed safely.
- While conducting a mini-UAV flight over areas near Berezove (government-controlled, 31km south-west of Donetsk), the SMM heard shots and bursts of small-arms fire about 1.2km east, assessed as aimed at the UAV, which it landed safely.
- On 14 October, at the Regional Clinical Kalinina Hospital in Donetsk city, a senior medical staff refused to provide the Mission with information about a civilian casualty and told the SMM that they were instructed not to talk with the Mission without a prior request to those in control.


