


# **Daily Report 261/2019**

4 November 2019<sup>1</sup>

## **Summary**

- Compared with the previous reporting period, between the evenings of 1 and 2 November, the SMM recorded fewer ceasefire violations in Donetsk region and a similar number of ceasefire violations in Luhansk region.
- Between the evenings of 2 and 3 November, the Mission recorded more ceasefire violations in both Donetsk and Luhansk regions, compared with the previous 24 hours
- The SMM saw damage to a house in non-government-controlled Yasynuvata.
- Inside the Stanytsia Luhanska disengagement area, the Mission continued to observe reconstruction works of the broken section of the bridge.
- The Mission observed deminers from government-controlled areas inside the disengagement area near Zolote.
- The SMM observed weapons in violation of withdrawal lines on both sides of the contact line.
- The SMM observed anti-tank mines, some for the first time, near non-government-controlled Pikuzy and government-controlled Vodiane.
- Restrictions of the Mission's freedom of movement continued, including at checkpoints near non-government-controlled Verkhnoshyrokivske, Zaichenko and Horlivka.\*



## Map of recorded ceasefire violations



In Donetsk region, between the evenings of 1 and 2 November, the SMM recorded fewer ceasefire violations, including fewer explosions (39), compared with the <u>previous reporting period</u> (about 130 explosions). The majority of the ceasefire violations were recorded at easterly directions of Hnutove (government-controlled, 90km south of Donetsk), in areas east-north-east and east of Maiorsk (government-controlled, 45km north-east of Donetsk) and in areas south and south-south-east of Pyshchevyk (government-controlled, 84km south of Donetsk).

Between the evenings of 2 and 3 November, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations, including more explosions (about 115), compared with the previous 24 hours. The majority of ceasefire violations were recorded in areas east-north-east and east of Hnutove, at southerly directions of Pyshchevyk, in areas east-north-east of Lomakyne (government-controlled, 93km south of Donetsk) and at southerly directions of Svitlodarsk (government-controlled, 57km north-east of Donetsk), where the majority of explosions occurred.

In Luhansk region, between the evenings of 1 and 2 November, the SMM recorded a similar number of ceasefire violations, all of them explosions (two), compared with the <u>previous reporting period</u> (two explosions). The explosions were recorded in areas north-north-west of Molodizhne (non-government-controlled, 63km west of Luhansk).

Between the evenings of 2 and 3 November, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations, including five explosions, compared with the previous 24 hours. All ceasefire violations were recorded outside the disengagement areas near Stanytsia Luhanska (government-controlled, 16km north-east of Luhansk) (see below) and near Zolote (government-controlled, 60km west of Luhansk), but within their 5km peripheries.

### Damage to a house in non-government-controlled Yasynuvata

On 3 November, at 175a Ordzhonikidze Street, in an apartment on the second floor of a five-storey residential building in Yasynuvata (non-government-controlled, 16km north-east of Donetsk), the SMM saw a hole in a balcony window, a corresponding hole in a window of a living room adjacent to the balcony, and a corresponding hole in a wooden cabinet located inside the living room, all facing west. The SMM assessed the damage as recent and caused by a round fired by an infantry fighting vehicle (BMP-2) from a west-north-westerly direction. A resident of the apartment told the SMM that she had not been at home, when the damage occurred.

### Disengagement areas near Stanytsia Luhanska, Zolote and Petrivske<sup>5</sup>

On 1 November, the SMM received a letter from the armed formations in non-government-controlled areas of Luhansk region notifying that they had completed the withdrawal of forces and hardware in the **disengagement area near Zolote** and notifying about their readiness to begin the removal of fortifications and other installations of military value from the disengagement area.

On 2 November, the SMM received two Notes Verbales from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Ukraine, notifying that they had completed the withdrawal of forces and hardware in the agreed disengagement area near Zolote and notifying about their readiness to begin the removal of fortifications and other installations of military value from the disengagement area (see SMM Spot Report 2 November 2019).

On 2 November, positioned at the checkpoint of the Ukrainian Armed Forces on the northern edge of the disengagement area, the SMM saw Ukrainian Armed Forces personnel in six cars, with no visible weapons, escorting a bus with about 20 persons with cameras, microphones, and notepads, assessed as journalists, into the disengagement area and further to Katerynivka (government-controlled, 64km west of Luhansk). About 30 minutes later, the SMM saw two of the vehicles and the bus returning to the said checkpoint.

On the same day, positioned at the checkpoint of the armed formations on the disengagement area's southern edge, the SMM also saw about nine unarmed persons, including three members of the armed formations (two wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) heading on foot into the disengagement area towards the SMM camera site in the southern part of the disengagement area, and then exiting the area through the same checkpoint and heading towards Zolote 5/Mykhailivika (non-government-controlled, 61km north-west of Luhansk).

On 3 November, positioned on the northern edge of the disengagement area, just west of road T-1316, the SMM saw ten deminers of the State Emergency Service of Ukraine with five vehicles entering the disengagement area, as well as five deminers and one unarmed Ukrainian Armed Forces personnel on the railway bridge on road T-1316, inside the disengagement area.

Outside the disengagement area, on the night of 1-2 November, an SMM long-range UAV spotted two infantry fighting vehicles (BMP-1) and four trucks about 150m east of the Ukrainian Armed Forces checkpoint about 300m north of the disengagement area's northern edge.

On 2 and 3 November, outside the disengagement area, the Mission also saw Ukrainian Armed Forces personnel reinforcing military positions about 300m north of the northern edge of the disengagement area up to 300m east and west of the checkpoint of the Ukrainian Armed Forces on the northern edge of the disengagement area.

On 2 and 3 November, outside the disengagement area, the SMM saw that a previously reported checkpoint of the armed formations on the road leading to Zolote-5/Mykhailivka, about 300m east of the area's eastern edge was manned by members of the armed formations. On 2 November, the SMM saw three members of the armed formations painting a metal traffic barrier that had been installed about 10m further east. On the same days, the SMM again saw two blue containers (with "JCCC" written on the side): about 30m east of the disengagement area's eastern edge and about 20m south of the checkpoint of the armed formations on the area's southern edge. On 2 November, the SMM saw an armed member of the armed formations exiting the blue container about 20m south of the checkpoint of the armed formations on the area's southern edge and on 3 November, the SMM saw three members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) near it.

On 3 November, the SMM observed five members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) at the checkpoint of the armed formations on the area's southern edge.

On the evening of 2 November, the SMM camera in Zolote recorded a projectile in flight at an assessed range of 1-3km east-north-east, assessed as outside the disengagement area but within its 5km periphery.

On 2 and 3 November, inside the **disengagement area near Stanytsia Luhanska**, the Mission saw 15 workers from government-controlled areas installing metal decks at the broken section of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge (15km north-east of Luhansk) covering almost all of its length. On 3 November, the Mission also saw the same workers covering the concrete structure on the northern edge of the bridge and the concrete section of its support pillar with tar.

On 2 November, the SMM saw two new radiation detectors installed at the entry-exit checkpoint (EECP) of the Ukrainian Armed Forces. A border guard at the EECP told the SMM that they will be used to detect radioactive material being carried by pedestrians in about a week.

On 2 and 3 November respectively, the SMM saw at least six and three members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) between the broken section of the bridge and the checkpoint of the armed formations.

On 3 November, the SMM observed 11 workers from non-government-controlled areas continuing laying asphalt and gravel at a parking lot 300m south of the bridge.

Outside the disengagement area, on 2 November, the SMM saw that the <u>previously reported</u> barbed wire placed around the SMM camera's mast in Stanytsia Luhanska (about 350m north-north-east of the disengagement area's northern edge) continues to impede the SMM's access to its camera.

On 3 November, positioned on the eastern edge of Stanytsia Luhanska, the SMM heard five undetermined explosions 4-6km west-south-west, assessed as outside the disengagement area but within its 5km periphery.

On 2 November, positioned about 2km north of **Petrivske** (non-government-controlled, 41km south of Donetsk), the SMM heard three undetermined explosions at an assessed range of 4-6km south-east. On 3 November, positioned in the same location, the SMM heard an undetermined explosion at an assessed range of 3-4km north-west. All ceasefire violations were assessed as outside the disengagement area but within its 5km periphery.

### Withdrawal of weapons

The SMM continued to monitor the withdrawal of weapons in implementation of the Memorandum and the Package of Measures and its Addendum.

The Mission observed 15 weapons in violation of withdrawal lines on both sides of the contact line, including some in a training area near Ternove (non-government-controlled, 57km east of Donetsk) and at the former Luhansk international airport, about 2km north of

Peremozhne (non-government-controlled, 19km south of Luhansk). It also observed 53 weapons beyond withdrawal lines but outside of designated storage sites in non-government-controlled areas of Donetsk and Luhansk regions (for further details, see the tables below).

## Indications of military and military-type presence in the security zone<sup>6</sup>

The SMM observed military and military-type presence in the security zone on both sides of the contact line, including infantry fighting vehicles, armoured combat vehicles, armoured personnel carriers and an anti-aircraft gun in government-controlled areas of Donetsk and Luhansk regions (for further details, see the table below).

On 1 November, an SMM mid-range UAV spotted ongoing reinforcement of military-type positions, assessed as belonging to the armed formations about 2km west-north-west of Uzhivka (formerly Leninske, non-government-controlled, 96km south of Donetsk).

On 2 November, the SMM saw four members of the armed formations, digging the ground with shovels, 6-8m north of a local road, about 3km south-east of Raivka (non-government-controlled, 16km north-west of Luhansk).

On 3 November, the SMM saw for the first time an about 20m-long trench and a mound assessed as fresh on the eastern side of a road about 2km west-north-west of Lyman (non-government-controlled, 12km north-west of Luhansk).

## Presence of anti-tank mines near Pikuzy and Vodiane as well as mine hazard signs in Raivka and near Pavlopil

On 1 November, an SMM mid-range UAV spotted at least 50 anti-tank mines in a field about 1km south of Pikuzy (formerly Kominternove, non-government-controlled, 92km south of Donetsk), and about 1.5km further north-west, at least 40 anti-tank mines, all seen for the first time and assessed as not recently laid and as belonging to the armed formations.

The same UAV also spotted <u>again</u> about 23 anti-tank mines laid across road T-0519 north of Vodiane (government-controlled, 94km south of Donetsk), assessed as belonging to the Ukrainian Armed Forces.

On 2 November, the SMM <u>again</u> saw a mine hazard sign on the northern side of a local road and a wooden roadblock placed in the middle of the same road in the south-western outskirts of Raivka (non-government-controlled, 16km north-west of Luhansk).

On 3 November, the SMM saw for the first time two mine hazard signs (red square plates with white sculls, on wooden sticks) on both sides of an unpaved road, about 500m west of Pavlopil (government-controlled, 84km south of Donetsk), about 25m south of electricity installations of the Pavlopil reservoir dam.

### SMM facilitation of operation of critical civilian infrastructure

On 2 and 3 November, the SMM continued to facilitate the operation of the Donetsk Filtration Station (15km north of Donetsk).

## SMM monitored the security situation in south-east Kherson region

On 1 November, the Mission observed a calm situation at an entry-exit checkpoint between Chonhar (163km south-east of Kherson) and Crimea.

The Mission continued monitoring in Odessa, Lviv, Ivano-Frankivsk, Kharkiv, Dnipro, Chernivtsi and Kyiv.

## \*Restrictions of the SMM's freedom of movement or other impediments to fulfilment of its mandate

The SMM's monitoring and freedom of movement are restricted by security hazards and threats, including risks posed by mines, unexploded ordnance (UXO) and other impediments — which vary from day to day. The SMM's mandate provides for safe and secure access throughout Ukraine. All signatories of the Package of Measures have agreed on the need for this safe and secure access, that restriction of the SMM's freedom of movement constitutes a violation, and on the need for rapid response to these violations. They have also agreed that the JCCC should contribute to such response and co-ordinate mine clearance. Nonetheless, the armed formations in parts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions frequently deny the SMM access to areas adjacent to Ukraine's border outside control of the Government (for example, see SMM Daily Report 26 October 2019). The SMM's operations in Donetsk and Luhansk regions remain restricted following the fatal incident of 23 April 2017 near Pryshyb; these restrictions continued to limit the Mission's observations.

### Denial of access:

- On 2 November, at a checkpoint north of Zaichenko (non-government-controlled, 93km south of Donetsk), two armed members of the armed formations again denied the SMM passage towards Sakhanka (non-government-controlled, 97km south of Donetsk), citing "ongoing demining activities". While at the checkpoint, the SMM saw vehicular traffic crossing through the said checkpoint.
- On 3 November, at a checkpoint west of Verkhnoshyrokivske (formerly Oktiabr, non-government-controlled, 85km south of Donetsk), a member of the armed formations again denied the SMM passage.

Regular restrictions related to disengagement areas and mines/UXO:

The sides continued to deny the SMM full access to disengagement areas near Zolote and Petrivske, as well as the ability to travel certain roads previously identified as important for effective monitoring by the Mission and for civilians' movement, through failure to conduct comprehensive clearance of mines and UXO.

### **Delayed**:

On 2 November, on two occasions, at a checkpoint west of Verkhnoshyrokivske (formerly Oktiabr, non-government-controlled, 85km south of Donetsk), four armed members of the armed formations allowed the SMM to proceed only after about 25 minutes of waiting.

- On 3 November, at a checkpoint near Horlivka (non-government-controlled, 39km north-east of Donetsk), three members of the armed formations allowed the SMM to proceed only after 35 minutes of waiting.

## Other impediments:

- On the night between 1 and 2 November, an SMM long-range UAV experienced GPS signal interference, assessed as probable jamming between Stepanivka (government-controlled, 54km north of Donetsk) and Bobrykivka (non-government-controlled, 57km south-east of Luhansk), as well as between Oleksandropillia (government-controlled, 71km west of Luhansk) and Bile (non-government-controlled, 22km west of Luhansk).


