Steps taken to implement the provisions of Article 3:

The clearance, removal and destruction of explosive remnants of war (ERW) within the territory of Hungary is the responsibility of the EOD unit of the Hungarian Defence Forces (HDF), according to the 142/1999 Government Regulation. In 2016, there were 2 077 EOD incidents registered at the EOD Regiment of the HDF, where 7 252 pieces of ERW's were destroyed. The total weight of the destroyed ERW's is 19796 kg. Most of these ERW's were remnants from World War II, while other unexploded ordnance (UXO's) were left behind in formerly used military training fields and shooting ranges by the Soviet Army.

Hungary records every available information about the ERW's found in the territory of the country according to the current regulations. This information is available at the EOD Regiment of the HDF and can be released to other organizations upon request, in accordance with the current regulations about public information.

Moreover, in the HDF there's a two-fold recording and retaining information in national bases, in homeland as well as in multinational environment:

- operational: each unit engaged in operations has to include in its reports all use of explosive munitions and, if applicable, all abandoned munitions.
- logistical: all use of munitions is recorded and reported.

During live firing exercises, a standby EOD team has to be present. In case of a misfire or a dud ammunition is reported, this EOD team has to respond immediately and has to take care of the unexploded ammunition.

Interpretation and implementation of disarmament and non-proliferation treaties, conventions and regimes etc. are discussed at courses at the University of National Public Administration organised for would be public servants.

At the level of military units the above-mentioned topics are addressed in practice so as to ensure that soldiers can successfully cope with all related tasks. There is a special emphasis on international treaties and obligations in the pre-deployment training of personnel including peacekeeping missions.

The Convention and its protocols were officially promulgated and hence incorporated into Hungarian law.
