Islamophobia

We would like to address “discrimination”, part of which includes the term “Islamophobia”: the report produced by SETA on the subject is a country by country litany of incidents against Muslims. Oddly enough, many of the incidents involved persons wearing Islamic garb. The time reference of the incidents was to horrific Islamic attacks such as the one in Paris. Can the Islamic community believe there is no connection?

Persons wearing Islamic garb are signifying Shari’a compliance. This means hatred of non-believers and acceptance of the Qur’anic mandate to participate in Jihad. Thus, in every sense, individuals in Islamic garb constitute a threat! Rather than being some vague and unwarranted “phobia”, the threat is real, validated almost daily by continuing Jihad attacks against the West.

The solution proposed by the Muslim groups is to demand that Western governments pass onerous laws against their own citizens that would establish Islamic supremacy and criminalize an individual’s instinct for self-survival. The Act 5280 Coalition believes such a solution is unworkable.

As an alternative, the Act 5280 Coalition suggests that the Muslim groups consider a re- examination of the Doctrine of Jihad against the Dar al-Harb, which is the root cause.

The language of the UDHR is precise and and is binding on OSCE members. The Act 5280 Coalition recommends that OSCE members familiarize themselves with this Shari’a and thus be able to judge its compatibility with OSCE values.
