Right of reply

With regard to the statement of the Armenian delegate, we would like to remind the Armenian delegation that the international community has consistently deplored, in the strongest terms, the use of **military force by Armenia against Azerbaijan and the resulting occupation of Azerbaijan's territories**. In 1993, the United Nations Security Council adopted resolutions 822 (1993), 853 (1993), 874 (1993) and 884 (1993), as well as UN General Assembly resolution 62/243 (2008), condemning the use of force against Azerbaijan and occupation of its territories and reaffirming the sovereignty and territorial integrity of Azerbaijan and the inviolability of its internationally recognized borders. In those resolutions, the Security Council reaffirmed that the **Nagorno-Karabakh region is part of Azerbaijan** and called for immediate, complete and unconditional withdrawal of the occupying forces from all occupied territories of Azerbaijan. Other international organizations have adopted a similar position.
