"Aarhus Convention" and "Sustainable Development" in the OSCE context

The 1990 Charter of Paris for a New Europe

Emphasized the "significant role of a well-informed society in enabling the public and individuals to take initiatives to improve the environment. To this end, we commit ourselves to promoting public awareness and education on the environment as well as the public reporting of the environmental impact of policies, projects and programmes."

The 1999 Istanbul Charter for European Security

the Heads of State or Government of the OSCE participating States, committed that "in the spirit of the 1998 Århus Convention on Access to Information, Public Participation in Decision Making and Access to Justice in Environmental Matters, we will in particular seek to ensure access to information, public participation in decision making and access to justice in environmental matters."



"Aarhus Convention" and "Sustainable Development" in the OSCE context

- 2003 Maastricht Strategy Document for the Economic and Environmental Dimension
 - 2.3 Ensuring sustainable development

"The OSCE is committed to the achievement of sustainable development, which aims at economic growth and poverty reduction and takes fully into account the impact of human activities on the environment. We support the global action foreseen in the Rio Declaration on Environment and Development, Agenda 21, the Monterrey Consensus, and the internationally agreed development goals, including those in the UN Millennium Declaration, and the Plan of Implementation adopted at the 2002 Johannesburg World Summit on Sustainable Development."


