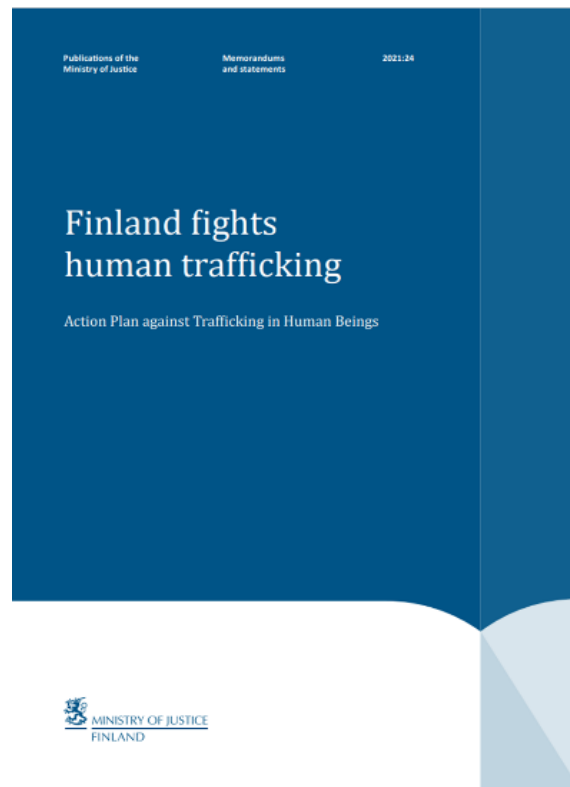

Victims' right to specialised services no longer dependent on the criminal proceedings
