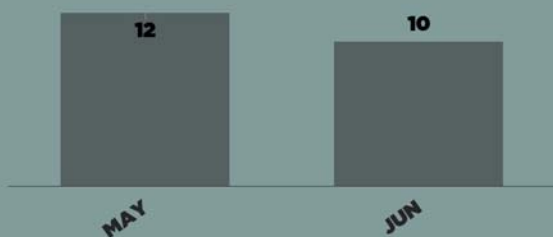

According to a survey conducted by the Coalition Against Hatred "Appreciation" in Livno in June, 89 per cent of respondents think bias-motivated incidents are a problem in their community and 76 per cent support the idea of preventive measures to be adopted by the municipality. The Coalition also developed and presented a set of recommendations for preventing hate crimes in Livno.

The Hate Monitor provides an update on all hate-motivated incidents and responses known to the OSCE Mission to BiH at the time of publishing the report each month.
