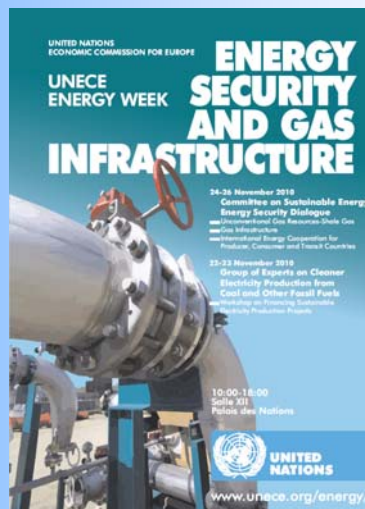
Future activities
