


# Daily Report 239/2019

9 October 2019<sup>1</sup>

#### **Summary**

- Compared with the previous reporting period, the SMM recorded fewer ceasefire violations in Donetsk region and more in Luhansk region.
- The SMM saw damage to civilian properties in non-government-controlled Staromykhailivka.
- Inside the Stanytsia Luhanska disengagement area, the SMM saw ongoing dismantling works at the broken section of the bridge.
- The Mission saw a vehicle with a mounted heavy-machine gun and military personnel inside the Zolote disengagement area.
- The Mission recorded ceasefire violations inside and near the Petrivske disengagement area.
- The SMM monitored adherence to the ceasefire to facilitate repairs and the operation of critical civilian infrastructure, including repairs to water pipelines between Zolote-3/Stakhanovets and Popasna, repairs to power lines near Artema, as well as the drilling of wells near Raivka.
- Restrictions of the Mission's freedom of movement continued, including at nongovernment-controlled checkpoints in Bezimenne and Staromykhailivka.\*



# Ceasefire violations observed by the SMM 8 October 2019



In Donetsk region, the SMM recorded fewer ceasefire violations including fewer explosions (about 140), compared with the previous reporting period (about 340 explosions). The majority of ceasefire violations were recorded in areas south-south-east and south of Pyshchevyk (government-controlled, 84km south of Donetsk), east-north-east and east of Maiorsk (government-controlled, 45km north-east of Donetsk) and at southerly directions of Svitlodarsk (government-controlled, 57km north-east of Donetsk).

In Luhansk region, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations, the majority of which were explosions (12), compared with the previous reporting period (seven explosions). The majority of ceasefire violations, all explosions, were recorded in areas south-west and west of Kadiivka (formerly Stakhanov, non-government-controlled, 50km west of Luhansk).

#### Disengagement areas near Petrivske and Zolote<sup>5</sup>

Following the meeting of the Trilateral Contact Group on 1 October, during which a renewal of withdrawal of forces and hardware from the disengagement areas near Petrivske (non-government-controlled, 41km south of Donetsk) and near Zolote (government-controlled, 60km west of Luhansk) and a timeline of activities was agreed upon, the SMM received from armed formations in non-government-controlled areas of Donetsk and Luhansk regions notifications with baseline information and of their willingness to start renewed activities to withdraw forces and hardware from the disengagement areas on 9 October.

The Mission also received a Note Verbale from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Ukraine containing baseline information regarding the renewed withdrawal of forces and hardware.

Outside the reporting period, on 9 October, the SMM observed white flares fired by the armed formations at both disengagement areas, indicating their willingness to disengage, but since there was no reciprocated action, the activities related to withdrawal of forces and hardware did not commence.

On 7 October, inside the disengagement area near Zolote (government-controlled, 60km west of Luhansk), an SMM mini-unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) spotted thick white smoke rising from around a military position of the Ukrainian Armed Forces in a field about 50m north-north-east of the railway bridge. Later on the same day and at the same location, the UAV spotted seven soldiers of the Ukrainian Armed Forces next to a destroyed shelter in the ground with burnt logs and water buckets around it. Within a 50m radius of the railway bridge, also inside the disengagement area, the same UAV spotted two soldiers of the Ukrainian Armed Forces and a military SUV.

On the same day, the same UAV <u>again</u> spotted stacks of about 280 anti-tank mines starting within the disengagement area and extending through the northern edge of the disengagement area. About 900m further east, it spotted three soldiers of the Ukrainian Armed Forces inside the disengagement area.

On 8 October, positioned on the northern edge of the disengagement area near Zolote, the SMM saw a military vehicle with a heavy-machine gun mounted on it enter the disengagement area. Inside the disengagement area, the SMM <u>again</u> saw a barbed wire with an attached sign on it about 90m north of the railway tracks and six obstacles on both sides of the road about 400m north of the railway bridge.

On the same day, outside the disengagement area near Zolote, about 10m north of its northern edge, in a field on the eastern side of the road, the SMM saw Ukrainian Armed Forces soldiers with a metal detector and demining tools clearing an area east of the road (for previous observation in this area see SMM Daily Report 8 October).

On the south-western edge of Zolote-4/Rodina (government-controlled, 59km west of Luhansk), the SMM saw for the first time a rectangular-shaped red coloured wooden sign (in Ukrainian language) in a field notifying the public about the prohibition to cross the area by foot or vehicles.

On 8 October, positioned about 2km north of the disengagement area near Petrivske (non-government-controlled, 41km south of Donetsk), the SMM heard and saw two undetermined explosions at an assessed range 3km south-west and heard three bursts of heavy-machine-gun fire at an assessed range of 3-4km south-west, all assessed as inside the disengagement area, as well as an undetermined explosion at an assessed range of 4-5km south-west (unable to assess whether inside or outside the disengagement area). Positioned in Bohdanivka (government-controlled, 41km south-west of Donetsk), the SMM heard an undetermined explosion at an undetermined distance south-south-east, assessed as outside the disengagement area.

On the same day, outside of the Petrivske disengagement area, the SMM saw for the first time two mine hazard signs in a field about 500m north-east of the road between Styla (non-government-controlled, 34km south of Donetsk) and Petrivske. The SMM also saw that a <u>previously observed</u> checkpoint on the northern edge of Petrivske was no longer present. The SMM was able to access its camera site near Petrivske for the first time since 1 September 2019.

#### Damage to civilian properties in non-government-controlled Staromykhailivka

The SMM followed up on reports of damage to civilian houses and a dental clinic in Staromykhailivka (non-government-controlled, 15km west of Donetsk). Accompanied by a member of the armed formations, at 7 Zhovtneva Street, the SMM saw a shattered window (covered by a plastic sheet and with shards of glass underneath it) and shrapnel marks next to the window, as well as a shrapnel mark with splinter grooves on the window's western side, all in the north-west facing wall of a single-storey dental clinic. Inside the building, the SMM saw shrapnel marks on the wall and furniture (opposite the aforementioned window). About 2.5m north-west of the clinic, the SMM saw two holes in a north-west-facing concrete fence and two craters in the tarmac of the road. Medical staff told the SMM that shelling had occurred on the evening of 6 October and that one staff member was in the clinic at the time (see SMM Daily Report 3 October 2019 for previous reports of damage at this site, including to the dental clinic).

About 200m north-east, the SMM saw a broken window and shrapnel marks in the south-west facing wall of a two-storey building of a kindergarten at 5A Kalinina Street. No further assessment was possible due to a restriction of SMM's freedom of movement.\*

About 380m west-south-west of the kindergarten, at 28 Zhovtneva Street, the SMM saw a hole in the roof of a single-storey house and debris on the tarmac underneath it and a hole in a west-facing window. About 3m west of the house, the SMM saw a hole in the roof of a summer kitchen. About 3m further west, the SMM saw a shattered window and a hole in a west-south-west-facing brick wall and a hole in the roof of a storage building.

About 10m west the SMM saw a hole and broken asbestos sheets in the roof of a single-storey house at 30 Zhovtneva Street. The SMM saw a man (aged 30-40) on the roof repairing it.

About 35m west, accompanied by a member of the armed formations, the SMM saw a hole and damaged asbestos sheets in the roof and a shattered north-facing attic window of a single-storey house at 34 Zhovtneva Street. The SMM assessed the latter as caused by the blast wave of an explosion. In an adjacent single-storey storage shed, the SMM saw a hole and missing bricks in the roof, as well as splinters of its wooden support struts scattered on the roof.

About 650m south-west, accompanied by a member of the armed formations, the SMM saw a crater about 5m south-west of a single-storey residential building (containing two apartments). In one apartment, at 9.1 Haharina Street, the SMM saw a hole in each of the two south-south-west-facing windows. In another apartment, at 9.2 Haharina Street, the SMM saw cracks in the glass of a south-south-west-facing window. In the same residential building, the SMM saw shrapnel marks assessed as recent in a door of a storage shed (see <a href="SMM Daily Report 5 October 2019">SMM Daily Report 5 October 2019</a> for injuries to a resident of one of the apartments in this residential building).

The SMM assessed all the observed damage as recent, but could not assess the type of weapon used or direction of fire. Residents of the houses and staff of the dental clinic told the SMM that the shelling had occurred on 6 October.

#### Stanytsia Luhanska disengagement area

Inside the disengagement area, on the morning of 8 October, on the road about 200m north of the broken section of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge (15km north-east of Luhansk), the SMM saw a truck crane removing logs from the side of the road. During the day, the SMM saw two mobile generators, a mobile crane, a vehicle with an elevator and a pickup truck in the area of the broken section of the bridge. It also observed nine workers from government-controlled areas cutting and removing metal parts from the broken section of the bridge and two others breaking the asphalt of the broken section of the bridge. The SMM also observed seven personnel of the State Emergency Service of Ukraine (SES) with a crane and a truck cutting and removing wood about 200m east of the broken section of the bridge. Throughout the day, the Mission saw a steady flow of pedestrians walking across the temporary bypass bridge in both directions.

#### Withdrawal of weapons

The SMM continued to monitor the withdrawal of weapons in implementation of the Memorandum and the Package of Measures and its Addendum.

The Mission observed no weapons in violation of withdrawal lines. It observed a weapon beyond the withdrawal lines but outside storage sites (for more details, see the table below).

#### Indications of military presence in the security zone<sup>6</sup>

The SMM observed military presence in the security zone in government-controlled areas, including armoured personnel carriers, an infantry fighting vehicle, a recent trench, and a trench extension (for more details, see the table below).

#### Mine hazard signs in Orikhove-Donetske

On 7 October, the SMM observed for the first time a mine hazard sign (reading "Caution, Mines" in Ukrainian language) attached to a tree on the southern edge of the main road on the western outskirts of Orikhove-Donetske (government-controlled, 44km north-west of Luhansk).

#### SMM facilitation of operation of and repair works to civilian infrastructure

The SMM monitored adherence to the ceasefire to facilitate the drilling of wells near Raivka (non-government-controlled, 16km north-west of Luhansk); to enable inspection and repair works on a water pipeline between Zolote-3/Stakhanovets (government-controlled, 61km north-west of Luhansk) and Popasna (government-controlled, 69km west of Luhansk); and to enable assessment and repair works on power lines near Artema (government-controlled, 26km north of Luhansk).

The Mission continued to facilitate the operation of the Donetsk Filtration Station (15km north of Donetsk) and monitored the security situation in the area of the pumping station near Vasylivka (non-government-controlled, 20km north of Donetsk).

#### Population survey in non-government-controlled areas of Donetsk region

On 8 October, in Donetsk city (non-government-controlled) and Horlivka (non-government-controlled, 39km north-east of Donetsk), 13 people (mixed gender and ages) told the Mission that they had received information that a population survey was being conducted in non-government-controlled areas, with some of them having already participated in it. In Dokuchaievsk (non-government-controlled, 30km south-west of Donetsk) and Yasynuvata (non-government-controlled, 16km north-east of Donetsk), three women (mixed ages) told the SMM that they are conducting the survey by going house to house in their respective settlements.

#### Border areas not under government control

While at a border crossing point near Marynivka (78km east of Donetsk) for about an hour, the SMM saw 19 cars (two with Ukrainian and nine with Russian Federation licence plates and seven with "DPR" and one with "LPR" plates), two buses (with "DPR" plates) entering Ukraine. During the same time, the Mission saw 16 cars (three with Ukrainian and seven with Russian Federation licence plates, and five with "DPR" and one with "LPR" plates), three covered-cargo trucks (one with Ukrainian licence plates and two with "DPR" plates), three buses (with "DPR" plates) and three pedestrians (a man and two women) exiting Ukraine.

The Mission continued monitoring in Kharkiv, Kherson, Odessa, Lviv, Ivano-Frankivsk, Dnipro, Chernivtsi and Kyiv.

# \*Restrictions of the SMM's freedom of movement or other impediments to fulfilment of its mandate

The SMM's monitoring and freedom of movement are restricted by security hazards and threats, including risks posed by mines, unexploded ordnance (UXO) and other impediments — which vary from day to day. The SMM's mandate provides for safe and secure access throughout Ukraine. All signatories of the Package of Measures have agreed on the need for this safe and secure access, that restriction of the SMM's freedom of movement constitutes a violation, and on the need for rapid response to these violations. They have also agreed that the JCCC should contribute to such response and co-ordinate mine clearance. Nonetheless, the armed formations in parts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions frequently deny the SMM access to areas adjacent to Ukraine's border outside control of the Government (for example, see SMM Daily Report 5 October 2019). The SMM's operations in Donetsk and Luhansk regions remain restricted following the fatal incident of 23 April 2017 near Pryshyb; these restrictions continued to limit the Mission's observations.

#### Denials of access:

- At a checkpoint about 2.5km west of Bezimenne (non-government-controlled, 100km south of Donetsk), a member of the armed formations <u>again</u> denied the SMM passage citing "an order from superiors".

#### Conditional access:

- At a checkpoint in Staromykhailivka (non-government-controlled, 15km west of Donetsk), four armed members of the armed formations allowed the SMM to pass with an escort car from the armed formations for the duration of its presence in Staromykhailivka.

Regular restrictions related to disengagement areas and mines/UXO:

- The sides continued to deny the SMM full access, as well as the ability to travel certain roads previously identified as important for effective monitoring by the Mission and for civilians' movement, through failure to conduct comprehensive clearance of mines, UXO and other obstacles.

#### Other impediments:

- On 5 October, an SMM long-range UAV lost its GPS signal due to signal interference assessed as caused by probable jamming while flying near Petrivske (non-government-controlled, 41km south of Donetsk), Pervomaiske (government-controlled, 17km north-west of Donetsk) and Novhorodske (government-controlled, 35km north of Donetsk). The same SMM long-range UAV lost its dual GPS signal due to signal interference assessed as caused by jamming while flying near Marinka (government-controlled, 23km south-west of Donetsk).
- On 8 October, four SMM mini-UAVs lost their GPS signal due to signal interference assessed as caused by probable jamming while flying near Petrivske and Bohdanivka (government-controlled, 41km south-west of Donetsk).
- A staff member of a kindergarten in Staromykhailivka (non-government-controlled, 15km west of Donetsk) told the SMM that it could not conduct an impact site assessment (see above) in the premises of the facility without permission from those in control.


