

Summary

- Compared with the previous 24 hours, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations in Donetsk region and no ceasefire violations in Luhansk region.
- Outside the disengagement area near Petrivske, the SMM saw that some anti-tank mines previously laid across a road had been removed and trenches had been partially filled, while others remained present both on the road and inside the area.
- In the Stanytsia Luhanska disengagement area, workers from non-government-controlled areas dismantled railings on the metal section of the bridge and cleared vegetation.
- The SMM monitored adherence to a localized ceasefire to facilitate the drilling of water wells near Pankivka.
- The SMM's freedom of movement continued to be restricted, including at a checkpoint of the armed formations near Verkhnoshyrokivske.*



Ceasefire violations observed by the SMM 2 December 2019



In Donetsk region, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations, including more explosions (about 85), compared with the previous 24 hours (25 explosions). The highest number of ceasefire violations were recorded at northerly directions of Shyrokyne (government-controlled, 100km south of Donetsk) and at southerly and westerly directions of Yasynuvata (non-government-controlled, 16km north-east of Donetsk).

In Luhansk region, the Mission did not record any ceasefire violations. During the previous 24 hours, it recorded six ceasefire violations, however, no explosions.

Disengagement areas near Petrivske, Zolote and Stanytsia Luhanska 5

On 28 November, inside the **disengagement area near Petrivske** (non-government-controlled, 41km south of Donetsk), an SMM mini unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) <u>again</u> spotted about 200 anti-tank mines (TM-62) laid in two rows running north to south, about 900m east of the area's western edge. About 100m further east, the UAV <u>again</u> spotted about 200 anti-tank mines (TM-62) running north to south, starting at about 650m north of the area's northern edge and continuing 350m south of it (70 of which are inside the disengagement area). All mines were assessed as belonging to the Ukrainian Armed Forces.

On the same day, outside the disengagement area, on the road between Bohdanivka (government-controlled, 41km south-west of Donetsk) and Viktorivka (non-government-controlled, 42km south-west of Donetsk), which runs along the northern edge of the Petrivske disengagement area, the UAV <u>again</u> spotted at least nine anti-tank mines which form part of a previously reported minefield, assessed as belonging to the Ukrainian Armed Forces.

On 2 December, the SMM saw that two trenches running across the same road had been covered with dirt (for similar observations in the area, see <u>SMM Daily Report 27 November 2019</u>). About 600m east of the trenches, the Mission saw that <u>previously observed 38 anti-tank</u> mines were no longer present, whereas a barely visible obstacle (MPZ wire) was placed for the first time in the same area.

On the same day, positioned east of Bohdanivka, outside the disengagement area, the SMM saw up to 24 State Emergency Service of Ukraine (SES) personnel on board vehicles, driving east towards Viktorivka and entering the disengagement area.

On 2 December, the SMM saw an excavator working on trenches about 20m east of road T-1316 on the northern edge of the **disengagement area near Zolote** (government-controlled, 60km west of Luhansk). At the area's southern edge, the Mission saw 20 workers and two deminers from non-government-controlled areas entering the disengagement area, accompanied by two members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" (Joint Centre for Control and Co-ordination) written on them). At least six other members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) were present at the checkpoint of the armed formations on the southern edge of the disengagement area.

On 2 December, inside the **disengagement area near Stanytsia Luhanska** (government-controlled, 16km north-east of Luhansk), the SMM saw workers from non-government-controlled areas dismantling railings of the metal span on the eastern side of the Stanytsia

Luhanska bridge (15km north-east of Luhansk) and clearing vegetation east of the shelter of an international humanitarian organization. The Mission also saw at least five members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them), between the southern edge of the newly constructed section of the bridge and the checkpoint of the armed formations.

Indications of military and military-type presence in the security zone⁶

The SMM observed military and military-type presence inside the security zone on both sides of the contact line in Donetsk and Luhansk regions (for further details, see the table below).

Presence of a remnant of a rocket-propelled grenade round near non-government-controlled Verkhnoshyrokivske

On 2 December, the SMM saw for the first time (not seen on 1 December) a remnant, assessed as a rocket-propelled grenade round (tailfin) embedded on the ground on a local road between Verkhnoshyrokivske (formerly Oktiabr, non-government-controlled, 85km south of Donetsk) and Pyshchevyk (government-controlled, 84km south of Donetsk). This road is used by civilians on a daily basis to cross the contact line and, while driving, the Mission saw cars driving past it (for previous observations in the same area, see SMM Daily Report 19 November 2019).

SMM facilitation of the operation of critical civilian infrastructure

The SMM monitored adherence to a localized ceasefire to facilitate the drilling of water wells near Pankivka (non-government-controlled, 16km north of Luhansk). It continued to facilitate the operation of the Donetsk Filtration Station (15km north of Donetsk).

Border areas not under government control

On 2 December, while at the border crossing point near Novoazovsk (102km south-east of Donetsk) for about 25 minutes, the SMM saw four cars (two with Ukrainian and one with Russian Federation licence plates, as well as one with "DPR" plates) entering Ukraine. It also saw two cars with Ukrainian licence plates, a covered cargo truck with Russian Federation licence plates, and a man exiting Ukraine.

The Mission continued monitoring in Kherson, Odessa, Lviv, Ivano-Frankivsk, Kharkiv, Dnipro, Chernivtsi and Kyiv.

*Restrictions of the SMM's freedom of movement or other impediments to fulfilment of its mandate

The SMM's monitoring and freedom of movement are restricted by security hazards and threats, including risks posed by mines, UXO and other impediments – which vary from day to day. The SMM's mandate provides for safe and secure access throughout Ukraine. All signatories of the Package of Measures have agreed on the need for this safe and secure access, that restriction of the SMM's freedom of movement constitutes a violation, and on the need for rapid response to these violations. They have also agreed that the JCCC should contribute to such response and co-ordinate mine clearance.

Nonetheless, the armed formations in parts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions frequently deny the SMM access to areas adjacent to Ukraine's border outside control of the Government (for example, see <u>SMM Daily Report of 19 November 2019</u>). The SMM's operations in Donetsk and Luhansk regions remain restricted following the fatal incident of 23 April 2017 near Pryshyb; these restrictions continued to limit the Mission's observations.

Denial of access:

- On 2 December, at a checkpoint near Verkhnoshyrokivske (formerly Oktiabr, non-government-controlled, 85km south of Donetsk), members of the armed formations again denied the SMM passage on two separate occasions to non-government-controlled areas, once citing "demining activities near Sakhanka and Pikuzy".

Regular restrictions related to disengagement areas and mines/UXO:

- The sides continued to deny the SMM full access, as well as the ability to travel certain roads previously identified as important for effective monitoring by the Mission and for civilians' movement, through failure to conduct comprehensive clearance of mines, UXO and other obstacles.

Other impediments:

- On 1 December, an SMM long-range UAV experienced GPS signal interference, assessed as caused by probable jamming, while flying over areas near Paraskoviivka (government-controlled, 31km south-west of Donetsk), Berezove (government-controlled, 31km south-west of Donetsk), and Petrivske (non-government-controlled, 41km south of Donetsk).⁷


