


Daily Report 290/2019

7 December 2019¹

Summary

- Compared with the previous reporting period, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations in both Donetsk and Luhansk regions.
- The SMM observed craters in a residential area of Zaitseve.
- The Mission received a Note Verbale from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Ukraine and a letter from the armed formations in Donetsk region on the dismantling of fortifications and other installations of military value in the Petrivske disengagement area.
- Inside the Zolote disengagement area, the SMM observed workers conducting vegetation clearance.
- The Mission saw workers installing lights on the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge.
- The SMM saw armoured combat vehicles in residential areas.
- The Mission monitored adherence to localized ceasefires to facilitate repairs to gas supply lines between Pavlopil and Verkhnoshyrokivske and to power lines in Marinka.
- The SMM's freedom of movement continued to be restricted, including at a checkpoint of the armed formations near Verkhnoshyrokivske and at a heavy weapons holding area in non-government-controlled areas of Donetsk region.*

Ceasefire violations²





In Donetsk region, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations, including more explosions (about 150), compared with the <u>previous reporting period</u> (about 90 explosions). The majority of the ceasefire violations were recorded at westerly directions of Horlivka (non-government-controlled, 39km north-east of Donetsk), in areas west, north-west and north-north-west of Donetsk city (non-government-controlled), including one third of explosions, and at northerly and westerly directions of Yasynuvata (non-government-controlled, 16km north-east of Donetsk).

In Luhansk region, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations, including three explosions, compared with the <u>previous reporting period</u> (one explosion). All but one of the ceasefire violations were recorded in areas south-south-west of Kriakivka (government-controlled, 38km north-west of Luhansk).

Craters near Zaitseve

On 4 December, an SMM mid-range unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) spotted at least 75 impact craters, assessed as not recent, about 100m north-east, about 150m south-east and about 50m south of the trenches of the armed formations, and about 10m away from residential houses on the northern outskirts of Zaitseve (50km north-east of Donetsk). About 350m north-north-west of said trenches and about 350m north-east of forward positions of the Ukrainian Armed Forces, the same UAV spotted a collapsed power line pylon. About 1km south-south-east of the trenches, it also spotted a house with a recently placed tarpaulin cover on its roof and at least six houses within a 50m radius with various damage to their roofs, including two missing their entire roofs. The UAV did not spot any impact craters around these houses.

Disengagement areas near Petrivske, Zolote and Stanytsia Luhanska⁵

On 4 December, outside the **disengagement area near Petrivske** (non-government-controlled, 41km south of Donetsk), an SMM long-range UAV spotted three infantry fighting vehicles (BMP variants) about 600m south of its southern edge, near forward positions of the Ukrainian Armed Forces.

On 5 December, on the road between Bohdanivka (government-controlled, 41km south-west of Donetsk) and Viktorivka (non-government-controlled, 42km south-west of Donetsk), running along the northern edge of the disengagement area, an SMM mini-UAV again spotted 12 anti-tank mines (TM-62) which form part of a previously reported minefield, assessed as belonging to the Ukrainian Armed Forces. About 350m from the mines, the UAV also spotted four vehicles and five deminers of the State Emergency Services (SES) of Ukraine. On 6 December, the SMM saw that no mines were present on the road, but it saw about 30 concrete obstacles placed around the areas where the mines had been removed. On the same road, it also noted that two <u>previously reported</u> trenches covered with dirt, had been filled with gravel and covered with concrete plates. Just south of the road, the Mission saw a mine hazard sign (for previous observations in the area, see <u>SMM Daily Report 6 December 2019</u>).

Also outside the disengagement area, the SMM saw for the first time a mine hazard sign in the middle of the road between Petrivske and Viktorivka about 200m east of the disengagement area's north-eastern edge.

On 6 December, the SMM received a Note Verbale from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Ukraine on completion of removal of fortifications, installations of military value and non-explosive obstacles in the disengagement area near Petrivske. On 5 December, the SMM received a letter from the armed formations in Donetsk region informing on completion of dismantling of fortifications and other facilities of military value in the Petrivske disengagement area. The SMM will continue to monitor and report on developments in the disengagement area.

On 4 December, inside **the disengagement area near Zolote** (government-controlled, 60km west of Luhansk), an SMM mini-UAV spotted about 15 workers clearing vegetation along road T-1316 about 580m north of the area's southern edge.

On 6 December, the SMM saw 15 workers and four deminers from non-government-controlled areas, as well as six members of the armed formations (including six wearing armbands with "JCCC" [Joint Centre for Control and Co-ordination] written on them) entering the disengagement area. The SMM camera in the southern part of the disengagement area recorded workers conducting vegetation clearance about 600m north of the area's southern edge. Throughout the day, the SMM saw at least six members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) on the southern edge of the disengagement area.

On the same day, inside the **disengagement area near Stanytsia Luhanska** (government-controlled, 16km north-east of Luhansk), the SMM saw two trucks and a grader machine laying gravel on the eastern side of the road between the checkpoint of the armed formations and the shelter of an international organization south of the bridge. On the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge (15km north-east of Luhansk), the SMM saw a white van and four workers from non-government-controlled areas connecting electric cables to a switchboard. The SMM saw 20 new LED lights installed on the hand railing of the metal span of the bridge and three more on a metal pole between the metal span and the newly constructed section of the bridge.

Throughout the day, the SMM saw at least six members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) between the checkpoint and the bridge.

The Mission also saw seven workers from non-government-controlled areas with a truck and a crane dismantling a guard rail on the road, east of the parking lot adjacent to the checkpoint, and placing 20 concrete blocks.

Withdrawal of weapons

The SMM continued to monitor the withdrawal of weapons in implementation of the Memorandum and the Package of Measures and its Addendum.

The Mission observed no weapons in violation of the withdrawal lines. It observed a weapon beyond withdrawal lines but outside of designated storage sites in a non-government-controlled area of Donetsk region (for further details, see the tables below).

Weapons that the SMM could not verify as withdrawn⁶

At heavy weapons holding areas in government-controlled areas of Luhansk region 6 December

The SMM noted that:

- four multiple launch rocket systems (BM-27 *Uragan*, 220mm) and six towed howitzers (D-30 *Lyagushka*, 122mm) were present and three anti-tank guns (MT-12 *Rapira*, 100mm) were present for the first time; and that
- four anti-tank guns (MT-12) and 12 self-propelled howitzers (2S1 *Gvozdika*, 122mm) continued to be missing.

Indications of military and military-type presence in the security zone⁷

The SMM observed armoured combat vehicles and an anti-aircraft gun inside the security zone on both sides of the contact line, including in residential areas (for further details, see the table below).

The Mission saw a mid-range UAV flying in the area near Chernenko (government-controlled, 86km south of Donetsk). It also saw a truck, under a camouflage net, with a large antenna, assessed as an electronic warfare system (probable RB-636 *Svet-KU*), in Styla (non-government-controlled, 34km south of Donetsk). The SMM launched a mini-UAV in the area which experienced signal interference assessed as caused by probable jamming (see below).

SMM facilitation of repairs to and operation of critical civilian infrastructure

The SMM monitored adherence to localized ceasefires to facilitate repair works to gas supply lines between Verkhnoshyrokivske (formerly Oktiabr, non-government-controlled, 85km south of Donetsk) and Pavlopil (government-controlled, 84km south of Donetsk) and to power lines in Marinka (government-controlled, 23km south-west of Donetsk).

The Mission continued to facilitate the operation of the Donetsk Filtration Station (15km north of Donetsk) and monitored the security situation in areas around the pumping station near Vasylivka (non-government-controlled, 20km north of Donetsk).

The Mission continued monitoring in Odessa, Lviv, Ivano-Frankivsk, Kharkiv, Kherson, Dnipro, Chernivtsi and Kyiv.

*Restrictions of the SMM's freedom of movement or other impediments to fulfilment of its mandate

The SMM's monitoring and freedom of movement are restricted by security hazards and threats, including risks posed by mines, unexploded ordnance (UXO) and other impediments – which vary from day to day. The SMM's mandate provides for safe and secure access throughout Ukraine. All signatories of the Package of Measures have agreed on the need for this safe and secure access, that restriction of the SMM's freedom of movement constitutes a violation, and on the need for rapid response to these violations. They have also agreed that the Joint Centre for Control and Coordination should contribute to such response and co-ordinate mine clearance. Nonetheless, the armed formations in parts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions frequently deny the SMM access to areas adjacent to Ukraine's border outside control of the Government (for example, see SMM Daily Report of 19 November 2019).

The SMM's operations in Donetsk and Luhansk regions remain restricted following the fatal incident of 23 April 2017 near Pryshyb; these restrictions continued to limit the Mission's observations.

Denial of access:

- At a checkpoint near Verkhnoshyrokivske (formerly Oktiabr, non-government-controlled, 85km south of Donetsk), on two occasions, an armed member of the armed formations <u>again</u> denied the SMM passage citing ongoing special operations in the area and "the SMM's safety". At the same time, the Mission saw civilian vehicles crossing the checkpoint.
- An armed member of the armed formations did not allow the Mission to access a heavy weapons holding area in a non-government-controlled area of Donetsk region, citing "a requirement for a written permission".

Regular restrictions related to disengagement areas and mines/UXO:

- The sides continued to deny the SMM full access, as well as the ability to travel certain roads previously identified as important for effective monitoring by the Mission and for civilians' movement, through failure to conduct comprehensive clearance of mines, UXO and other obstacles.

Other impediments:

- On 4 December, an SMM long-range UAV experienced GPS signal interference, assessed as caused by probable jamming, while flying over between Illinivka (formerly Illicha, government-controlled, 56km north of Donetsk) and Stepanivka (government-controlled, 54km north of Donetsk).⁸
- On 6 December, two SMM mini-UAVs experienced signal interference assessed as caused by probable jamming: one while flying near Bohdanivka (government-controlled, 41km south-west of Donetsk) on six occasions and the second while flying near Styla (non-government-controlled, 34km south of Donetsk) on one occasion.⁹
