


Daily Report 302/2019

21 December 2019¹

Summary

- Compared with the previous reporting period, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations in both Donetsk and Luhansk regions.
- Inside the Zolote disengagement area, the SMM saw workers and deminers from non-government-controlled areas clearing vegetation.
- Inside the Stanytsia Luhanska disengagement area, the Mission saw two ambulances from government- and non-government-controlled areas testing driving across the bridge.
- The Mission monitored adherence to localized ceasefires to facilitate damage assessment to water pipelines in non-government-controlled Olenivka. It continued to facilitate the operation of the Donetsk Filtration Station.
- The SMM's freedom of movement continued to be restricted, including at a checkpoint of the armed formations near Verkhnoshyrokivske, Donetsk region and at a railway station in Voznesenivka, Luhansk region.*





In Donetsk region, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations, including, however, fewer explosions (about 120), compared with the <u>previous reporting period</u> (about 140 explosions). The highest number of the ceasefire violations were recorded at south-westerly directions of Svitlodarsk (government-controlled, 57km north-east of Donetsk), at northerly and south-easterly directions of Chermalyk (government-controlled, 77km south of Donetsk) and at northerly directions of Horlivka (non-government-controlled, 39km north-east of Donetsk).

In Luhansk region, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations, including more explosions (about 330), compared with the <u>previous reporting period</u> (nine explosions). More than two third of the ceasefire violations, including the majority of explosions, were recorded in areas west of Kalynove (non-government-controlled, 60km west of Luhansk), at westerly directions of Holubivka (formerly Kirovsk, non-government-controlled, 51km west of Luhansk) and in areas north-north-east of Zolote (government-controlled, 60km west of Luhansk) (see below).

Disengagement areas near Petrivske, Zolote and Stanytsia Luhanska⁵

On 20 December, positioned about 700m north-west of Petrivske (non-government-controlled, 41km south of Donetsk), the SMM heard seven shots of small-arms fire at an assessed distance of 1km south-south-west, assessed as inside **the disengagement area near Petrivske**. Positioned about 2km north of Petrivske, the Mission heard an undetermined explosion about 3-5km north-west and a shot of small-arms fire 2-3km west-south-west, both assessed as outside the disengagement area, but within its 5km periphery. The Mission also saw about five objects, assessed as possible mine hazard signs inside the disengagement area, about 520m south of its northern edge and about 2km east of its western edge.

Outside the disengagement area, about 80m south of the said road between Petrivske and Viktorivka (non-government-controlled, 42km south-west of Donetsk) and about 40m north of the disengagement area's northern edge, the SMM also saw a member of the armed formations and grey smoke near a previously reported trench.

On the same day, inside **the disengagement area near Zolote**, the SMM saw two vehicles, 20 workers and five deminers from non-government-controlled areas clearing vegetation on the western side of road T-1316, about 100-800m north of the area's southern edge. Positioned on the southern edge of the disengagement area, the SMM heard 20 explosions (15 undetermined and five assessed as outgoing with subsequent impacts) and 25 bursts of small-arms fire, all at an assessed range of 3-5km north-north-east, assessed as outside the disengagement area, but within its 5km periphery.

On 19 December, outside the **disengagement area near Stanytsia Luhanska** (government-controlled, 16km north-east of Luhansk), an SMM mini-unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) <u>again</u> spotted an infantry fighting vehicle (probable BTR-3DA) under camouflage net, about 50m north of the area's northern edge, assessed as belonging to the Ukrainian Armed Forces.

On 20 December, the SMM observed two ambulances crossing the new section of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge (15km north-east of Luhansk), reportedly for testing purposes: one from non-government-controlled areas towards government-controlled areas and then back, another from government-controlled areas towards non-government-controlled areas and back. During the

testing, the Mission saw two Ukrainian Armed Forces officers to the Joint Centre for Control and Co-ordination (JCCC) north of the new section of the bridge and four members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) south of it. Throughout the day, the SMM also saw nine members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) between the new section of the bridge and the checkpoint of the armed formations south of it.

Withdrawal of weapons

The SMM continued to monitor the withdrawal of weapons in implementation of the Memorandum and the Package of Measures and its Addendum.

The Mission observed two weapons in violation of withdrawal lines in a government-controlled area of Donetsk region. It also saw 27 weapons beyond withdrawal lines but outside of designated storage sites in a government-controlled area of Luhansk region (for further details, see table below).

Indications of military and military-type presence in the security zone⁶

The SMM observed military and military-type presence inside the security zone on both sides of the contact line in Donetsk region, including one in a residential area in a non-government-controlled area (for further details, see the table below).

The Mission also saw for the first time at least four trenches and at least four pieces of equipment under camouflage nets in a field south-west of Vozdvyzhenka (formerly Krasnyi Pakhar, government-controlled, 66km north-east of Donetsk).

Presence of anti-tank mines near government-controlled Pavlopil and Shyrokyne and non-government-controlled Verkhnoshyrokivske

On 18 December, an SMM mid-range UAV <u>again</u> spotted 11 anti-tank mines, assessed as part of a larger minefield, about 3km east-north-east of Pavlopil (government-controlled, 84km south of Donetsk), assessed as belonging to the Ukrainian Armed Forces. About 2.5km further east-north-east and about 4km north of Verkhnoshyrokivske (formerly Oktiabr, non-government-controlled, 85km south of Donetsk), the same UAV <u>again</u> spotted about 150 anti-tank mines, assessed as belonging to the armed formations.

On 19 December, an SMM mid-range UAV <u>again</u> spotted about 60 anti-tank mines laid in two rows across a field on the north-eastern edge of Shyrokyne (government-controlled, 100km south of Donetsk), assessed as belonging to Ukrainian Armed Forces. About 500m north-west, the UAV <u>again</u> spotted seven anti-tank mines laid across road M14 (including one on the southern shoulder of the road).

Long queues at checkpoints along the contact line

On the morning of 20 December for about 2.5 hours at a checkpoint of the armed formations near Olenivka (non-government-controlled, 23km south-west of Donetsk), the SMM <u>again</u> saw

a long queue: at least 300 cars, about 15 full buses and at least 250 people on foot queuing to travel towards government-controlled areas. Two women and a man (mixed ages) told the Mission that they had been waiting for at least three and five hours respectively, noting that waiting in the cold was especially difficult for elderly people. On the same afternoon, the Mission saw again about 300 cars queuing to travel towards government-controlled areas and about 150 cars queuing in the opposite direction. At a checkpoint of the armed formations near Kreminets (non-government-controlled, 16km south-west of Donetsk), the SMM again observed at least 150 vehicles queuing to travel to government-controlled areas.

Border areas outside government control

While at a border crossing point near Voznesenivka (formerly Chervonopartyzansk, 65km south-east of Luhansk) for about 80 minutes, the SMM saw a gas transporting truck with Ukrainian licence plates entering Ukraine and four cars exiting Ukraine.

While at the Chervona Mohyla railway station in Voznesenivka for about five minutes, the SMM saw no traffic in either direction. Thereafter, an armed member of the armed formations told the SMM to leave the area.*

SMM facilitation of repairs to and operation of critical civilian infrastructure

The SMM monitored adherence to a localized ceasefire to facilitate the assessment of damage to water pipeline in Olenivka. The Mission continued to facilitate the operation of the Donetsk Filtration Station (15km north of Donetsk) and monitor the security situation around the pumping station near Vasylivka (non-government-controlled, 20km north of Donetsk).

The Mission continued monitoring in Kherson, Odessa, Lviv, Ivano-Frankivsk, Kharkiv, Dnipro, Chernivtsi and Kyiv.

*Restrictions of the SMM's freedom of movement or other impediments to fulfilment of its mandate

The SMM's monitoring and freedom of movement are restricted by security hazards and threats, including risks posed by mines, unexploded ordnance (UXO) and other impediments – which vary from day to day. The SMM's mandate provides for safe and secure access throughout Ukraine. All signatories of the Package of Measures have agreed on the need for this safe and secure access, that restriction of the SMM's freedom of movement constitutes a violation, and on the need for rapid response to these violations. They have also agreed that the JCCC should contribute to such response and co-ordinate mine clearance. Nonetheless, the armed formations in parts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions frequently deny the SMM access to areas adjacent to Ukraine's border outside control of the Government (for example, see below). The SMM's operations in Donetsk and Luhansk regions remain restricted following the fatal incident of 23 April 2017 near Pryshyb; these restrictions continued to limit the Mission's observations.

Denial of access:

- At a checkpoint west of Verkhnoshyrokivske (formerly Oktiabr, non-government-controlled, 85km south of Donetsk), on two occasions, members of the armed

- formations, denied the SMM passage, including towards a border area outside government control, once citing "demining activities in the area".
- At the Chervona Mohyla railway station in Voznesenivka (formerly Chervonopartyzansk, non-government-controlled, 65km south-east of Luhansk), an armed member of the armed formations told the SMM to leave the area.

Regular restrictions related to disengagement areas and mines/UXO:

- The sides continued to deny the SMM full access, as well as the ability to travel certain roads previously identified as important for effective monitoring by the Mission and for civilians' movement, through failure to conduct comprehensive clearance of mines, UXO and other obstacles.


