
30 December 2019¹

Summary

- Compared with the previous reporting period, between the evenings of 27 and 28 December, the Mission recorded more ceasefire violations in both Donetsk and Luhansk regions.
- Between the evenings of 28 and 29 December, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations in Donetsk region and fewer ceasefire violations in Luhansk region, compared with the previous 24 hours.
- The Mission monitored and facilitated on the ground an exchange of detainees between Ukraine and certain areas of Donetsk and Luhansk regions.
- The SMM saw that the bypass bridge inside the Stanytsia Luhanska disengagement area had been dismantled.
- The Mission continued monitoring the situation at the disengagement areas near Petrivske and Zolote.
- It monitored and facilitated adherence to localized ceasefires to enable the drilling of water wells near Pankivka as well as repairs to a water intake pipe near Slovianoserbsk, and continued to facilitate the operation of the Donetsk Filtration Station.
- The SMM's freedom of movement continued to be restricted, including at a checkpoint of the armed formations near Zaichenko.*

Ceasefire violations²




² For a complete breakdown of ceasefire violations, please see the annexed table. On 28 and 29 December, the SMM camera in the parking lot south of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge was not operational. On 29 December, the SMM camera east of Lomakyne was not operational. Dense fog limited the observations of SMM cameras in Kriakivka, in Zolote-3/Stakhanovets, in Popasna, as well as in and near Stanytsia Luhanska.

Map of recorded ceasefire violations



In Donetsk region, between the evenings of 27 and 28 December, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations, including, however, fewer explosions (15), compared with the <u>previous reporting period</u> (22). The majority of ceasefire violations were recorded in areas south-southeast of Chermalyk (government-controlled, 77km north of Donetsk).

Between the evenings of 28 and 29 December, the Mission recorded more ceasefire violations, including more explosions (20), compared with the previous 24 hours. The majority of ceasefire violations were recorded in areas north-east of Krasnohorivka (government-controlled, 21km west of Donetsk) and at easterly directions of Hranitne (government-controlled, 60km south of Donetsk).

In Luhansk region, between the evenings of 27 and 28 December, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations, including more explosions (six), compared with the <u>previous reporting period</u> (no explosions). The majority of ceasefire violations were recorded in an area southwest of Molodizhne (non-government-controlled, 63km north-west of Luhansk).

Between the evenings of 28 and 29 December, the Mission recorded fewer ceasefire violations, including fewer explosions (two), compared with the previous 24 hours. All ceasefire violations were recorded in areas north of Obozne (non-government-controlled, 18km north of Luhansk), south-west of Peredilske (government-controlled, 24km north-west of Luhansk) and south-east of Kalynove (non-government-controlled, 60km west of Luhansk).

SMM monitoring and facilitation of an exchange of detainees between Ukraine and certain areas of Donetsk and Luhansk region

On 29 December, the SMM monitored, with mirror patrols on both sides of the contact line, and facilitated, on the ground, an exchange of detainees between Ukraine and certain areas of Donetsk and Luhansk regions at the entry-exit checkpoint in Maiorsk (government-controlled, 45km north-east of Donetsk) and at the corresponding checkpoint of the armed formations in Horlivka (non-government-controlled, 39km north-east of Donetsk). Ukrainian officials, the Co-ordinator of the Working Group on Humanitarian Issues of the Trilateral Contact Group and representatives of international organizations were also present.

Disengagement areas near Petrivske, Zolote and Stanytsia Luhanska⁵

On 27 December, outside the **disengagement area near Petrivske** (non-government-controlled, 41km south of Donetsk), an SMM mini-unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) <u>again</u> spotted an infantry fighting vehicle (IFV) (BMP variant) about 400m south of the area's south-western edge, as well as three other IFVs (BMP-2) about 1km further east, all assessed as belonging to the Ukrainian Armed Forces.

On the same day, an SMM mini-UAV spotted for the first time about 100 anti-tank mines (TM-62) laid in an area starting 1.6km east-north-east of Bohdanivka (government-controlled, 41km south-west of Donetsk) and running about 150m south inside the disengagement area (the SMM was not able to assess if the aforesaid mines were laid recently). On the same day, an SMM mini-UAV <u>again</u> spotted at least 100 anti-tank mines, starting from the northern edge of the disengagement area and running about 450m south inside the area. The same UAV <u>again</u>

spotted about 200 anti-tank mines (TM-62) laid in two rows running north to south, about 900m east of the area's western edge. All of the aforesaid mines were assessed as belonging to the Ukrainian Armed Forces.

On 28 December, positioned east of Bohdanivka, the SMM saw a State Emergency Service of Ukraine (SES) vehicle and four SES members move towards the SMM camera site on the road to Viktorivka (non-government-controlled, 42km south-west of Donetsk).

On the same day, positioned on the western edge of Petrivske, the SMM heard six shots of small-arms fire at an assessed range of 1-3km south-west, assessed as inside the disengagement area. Positioned in Petrivske and about 2km east-north-east of Bohdanivka on the same day, the Mission heard 16 bursts and shots of heavy-machine-gun and small-arms fire at an assessed range of 1-3km north-west and south-east, all assessed as outside the disengagement area but within 5km of its periphery. On 29 December, positioned in Petrivske, the SMM heard 16 shots of small-arms fire 2km east-north-east assessed as outside the disengagement area but within 5km of its periphery.

On 28 December, the SMM camera in Zolote (government-controlled, 60km west of Luhansk) recorded two undetermined explosions at an assessed range of 2-4km east, assessed as outside the **disengagement area near Zolote** but within 5km of its periphery.

On 29 December, the Mission saw three members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) on the area's southern edge.

On 28 December, inside the **disengagement area near Stanytsia Luhanska** (government-controlled, 16km north-east of Luhansk), between the container of an international organization and the checkpoint of the armed formations south of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge (15km north of Luhansk), the Mission saw four workers from non-government-controlled areas attaching fences to metal poles.

On 28 December, the SMM saw 11 workers from government-controlled areas dismantling the bypass bridge. On 29 December, the Mission saw that the dismantling was completed. On the same day, the SMM saw that a shelter had been constructed at the shuttle bus stop, about 1.8km south of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge.

On 28 and 29 December, throughout the day, the SMM saw up to six members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) between the new section of the bridge and the checkpoint of the armed formations south of it.

Withdrawal of weapons

The SMM continued to monitor the withdrawal of weapons in implementation of the Memorandum and the Package of Measures and its Addendum.

The Mission observed a tank beyond withdrawal lines in a government-controlled area of Donetsk region (for further details, see the table below).

Indications of military presence in the security zone⁶

The SMM observed three armoured combat vehicles inside the security zone in government-controlled areas of Donetsk region (for further details, see the table below).

Presence of anti-tank mines, unexploded ordnance (UXO) and mine hazard signs

On 26 December, an SMM mid-range UAV <u>again</u> spotted 11 anti-tank mines across a local road about 600m east of Krasnohoriva. About 2km further south-east, the same UAV spotted for the first time about 40 anti-tank mines (probable TM-62) adjacent to railway tracks. All of the aforesaid mines were located near positions of the Ukrainian Armed Forces.

On the same day, an SMM mid-range UAV <u>again</u> spotted 16 and six anti-tank mines (TM-62) laid out 500m from each other on the northern edge of Marinka (government-controlled, 23km south-west of Donetsk), all located 30-50m away from the nearest residential houses.

On 28 December, the Mission <u>again</u> saw parts of an unexploded rocket-propelled grenade on road T-0504, about 1km west-north-west of the checkpoint of the armed formations located about 1.8km south-west of Molodizhne.

On 29 December, the SMM saw for the first time two yellow and red rectangular mine hazard signs with "Stop mines!" written in Russian placed on each side of a road on the south-western outskirts of Raivka (non-government-controlled, 16km north-west of Luhansk).

Border areas outside government control

On 29 December, while at a border crossing point near Uspenka (73km south-east of Donetsk) for about an hour, the SMM saw 30 cars (three with Ukrainian and 21 with Russian Federation licence plates, as well as six with "DPR" plates), a covered cargo truck with "DPR" plates, a bus with Russian Federation licence plates, and 57 pedestrians (mixed genders and ages) entering Ukraine. It also saw 18 cars (four with Ukrainian, ten with Russian Federation and one with Georgian licence plates, as well as three with "DPR" plates), a covered cargo truck with Russian Federation licence plates, two buses with "DPR" plates, and 16 pedestrians (mixed genders and ages) exiting Ukraine.

On the same day, while at a border crossing point near Ulianivske (61km south-east of Donetsk) for about an hour, the SMM saw two women (mixed ages), but no vehicles, entering Ukraine. It also saw three pedestrians (two men and a woman, mixed ages), but no vehicles, exiting Ukraine.

Water shortages affecting civilians along the contact line

On 28 December, the SMM saw 20 persons (mixed ages and genders) queuing to collect water from a water container at a distribution point in Pervomaisk (non-government-controlled, 58km west of Luhansk). Five residents raised concerns over the lack of water supply and told the SMM that they had been queuing in line for about forty minutes to collect water. On 29 December, four residents of Pervomaisk and Zolote-5/Mykhailivka (non-government-

controlled, 58km west of Luhansk) told the Mission that the water supply had been gradually improving in their respective settlements.

SMM facilitation of repairs to and operation of critical civilian infrastructure

On 28 December, the SMM monitored and facilitated adherence to localized ceasefires to facilitate the drilling of water wells near Pankivka (non-government-controlled, 16km north of Luhansk), as well as repairs to a water intake pipe near Slovianoserbsk (non-government-controlled, 28km north-west of Luhansk).

On 28 and 29 December, the Mission continued to facilitate the operation of the Donetsk Filtration Station (15km north of Donetsk). On 29 December, it also monitored the security situation around the pumping station near Vasylivka (non-government-controlled, 20km north of Donetsk).

The SMM continued monitoring in Kherson, Odessa, Lviv, Ivano-Frankivsk, Kharkiv, Dnipro, Chernivtsi and Kyiv.

*Restrictions of the SMM's freedom of movement or other impediments to fulfilment of its mandate

The SMM's monitoring and freedom of movement are restricted by security hazards and threats, including risks posed by mines, UXO and other impediments — which vary from day to day. The SMM's mandate provides for safe and secure access throughout Ukraine. All signatories of the Package of Measures have agreed on the need for this safe and secure access, that restriction of the SMM's freedom of movement constitutes a violation, and on the need for rapid response to these violations. They have also agreed that the Joint Centre for Control and Co-ordination should contribute to such response and co-ordinate mine clearance. Nonetheless, the armed formations in parts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions frequently deny the SMM access to areas adjacent to Ukraine's border outside control of the Government (for example, see SMM Daily Report of 27 December 2019). The SMM's operations in Donetsk and Luhansk regions remain restricted following the fatal incident of 23 April 2017 near Pryshyb; these restrictions continued to limit the Mission's observations.

Denial of access:

- On 29 December, at a checkpoint north of Zaichenko (non-government-controlled, 93km south of Donetsk), two armed members of the armed formations <u>again</u> denied the SMM passage towards Sakhanka (non-government-controlled, 97km south of Donetsk) and Pikuzy (formerly Kominternove, non-government-controlled, 92km south of Donetsk), citing "ongoing demining activities in the area". The Mission saw a civilian car going through the checkpoint toward Sakhanka.

Regular restrictions related to disengagement areas and mines/UXO:

The sides continued to deny the SMM full access, as well as the ability to travel certain roads previously identified as important for effective monitoring by the Mission and for civilians' movement, through failure to conduct comprehensive clearance of mines, UXO and other obstacles.

Other impediments:

- On 29 December, on two occasions, an SMM mini-UAV experienced GPS signal interference, assessed as caused by probable jamming, while flying over areas near Petrivske (non-government-controlled, 41km south of Donetsk).⁷
- On the same day, an SMM mini-UAV experienced GPS signal interference, assessed as caused by probable jamming, while flying over areas near Olenivka (non-government-controlled, 23km south-west of Donetsk).⁷


