
Summary

- Compared with the previous reporting period, the SMM recorded more ceasefire • violations in both Donetsk and Luhansk regions.
- Small-arms fire was assessed as directed at an SMM mini-unmanned aerial vehicle near • non-government-controlled Zaichenko, Donetsk region.
- The Mission continued monitoring the situation at the disengagement areas near • Stanytsia Luhanska, Zolote and Petrivske.
- The SMM saw weapons in violation of withdrawal lines, most of which were in a nongovernment-controlled area in Luhansk region.
- The Mission monitored adherence to localized ceasefires to facilitate maintenance and repairs to critical civilian water infrastructure.
- The SMM's freedom of movement continued to be restricted, including at a checkpoint of the armed formations near Zaichenko.*



Ceasefire violations observed by the SMM 15 January 2020



In Donetsk region, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations, including more explosions (about 35), compared with the <u>previous reporting period</u> (about 25 explosions). The highest number of ceasefire violations were recorded in areas north and north-north-east of Shyrokyne (government-controlled, 100km south of Donetsk).

In Luhansk region, the Mission recorded more ceasefire violations, including more explosions (about 245), compared with the <u>previous reporting period</u> (about 115 explosions). More than half of the ceasefire violations, including more than half of the explosions, were recorded near the disengagement area near Zolote (government-controlled, 60km west of Luhansk) (see below).

Small-arms fire assessed as directed at SMM mini-unmanned aerial vehicle near Zaichenko

Positioned about 2km north-east of Zaichenko (non-government-controlled, 93km south of Donetsk), while conducting an SMM mini-unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) flight, the SMM heard two shots and two bursts of small-arms fire about 1km west-south-west, assessed as directed at the UAV, which was flying about 1km south-west. The SMM landed its UAV safely and left the area.*

Disengagement areas near Stanytsia Luhanska, Zolote and Petrivske⁵

On the morning of 15 January, inside the **disengagement area near Stanytsia Luhanska** (government-controlled, 16km north-east of Luhansk), the SMM saw workers from nongovernment-controlled areas installing a 2m-high fence along the eastern edge of the checkpoint of the armed formations, and, about 20m south, filling holes in the tarmac road with gravel, all south of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge (15km north-east of Luhansk).

Throughout the same day, the SMM saw six members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) between the new span of the bridge and their checkpoint south of the bridge.

On 15 January, positioned in seven locations near the **disengagement area near Zolote**, the SMM heard about 110 undetermined explosions and about 150 bursts and shots of small-arms and heavy-machine-gun fire, all assessed as outside the disengagement area but within 5km of its periphery.

On 13 January, at the eastern edge of the **disengagement area near Petrivske** (non-government-controlled, 41km south of Donetsk) an SMM mini-unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) spotted for the first time at least 12 anti-personnel mines (PMN-2) assessed as not recent (some of which had their fuse facing down, indicating demining activities) and again three anti-tank mines (for previous observations, see <u>SMM Daily Report 23 November 2019</u>). All of the abovementioned mines were assessed as belonging to the armed formations. The same UAV also spotted five persons in camouflage clothing near a former position of the armed formations at the area's south-eastern corner.

On 15 January, positioned near the SMM camera in Petrivske, the SMM saw two people about 500-600m west-south-west inside the disengagement area, assessed as near a probable positions of the armed formations.

Withdrawal of weapons

The SMM continued to monitor the withdrawal of weapons in implementation of the Memorandum and the Package of Measures and its Addendum.

It saw six weapons in violation of their respective withdrawal lines in Luhansk region, five of which in a non-government-controlled area (for further details, see the table below).

Indications of military and military-type presence inside the security zone⁶

The SMM observed armoured combat vehicles, including an anti-aircraft gun and armoured reconnaissance vehicles, parked by a non-functioning school in government-controlled areas of Luhansk region (for further details, see the table below).

Presence of mines and unexploded ordnance

On 13 January, an SMM mid-range UAV again spotted 19 anti-tank mines placed about 15m north of the road used daily by civilians between Pyshchevyk (government-controlled, 84km south of Donetsk) and Verkhnoshyrokivske (formerly Oktiabr, non-government-controlled, 85km south of Donetsk) (for previous observations in the area, see <u>SMM Daily Report 13 May</u> 2019). On 15 January, about 35m south of the previously mentioned anti-tank mines, the SMM saw for the first time an anti-tank mine and <u>again</u> three other anti-tank mines (all TM-62M) (for previous observations in the area, see <u>SMM Daily Report 15 November 2019</u>).

On 15 January, the SMM again saw an anti-personnel mine (MON-50) (without its fuse) lying on the edge of a road 5.6km south-east of Pryvitne (non-government-controlled, 11km north of Luhansk). On the same day, the SMM <u>again</u> saw a piece of unexploded ordnance (UXO), assessed as a projectile from a rocket of a multiple launch rocket system, in a local road on the northern outskirts of Raivka (non-government-controlled, 16km north-west of Luhansk). About 1km south-west of the UXO, the SMM saw two mine hazard signs with "Stop, Mines" written in Cyrillic, one alongside a local road and the other in a treeline nearby.

SMM facilitation of repairs to and operation of critical civilian infrastructure

The SMM facilitated and monitored adherence to a localized ceasefire to enable the drilling of water wells near Pankivka (non-government-controlled, 16km north of Luhansk) and repairs to water pipelines in Zolote-5/Mykhailivka (non-government-controlled, 58km west of Luhansk).

The Mission continued to facilitate the operation of the Donetsk Filtration Station (15km north of Donetsk) and monitor the security situation in the area of the pumping station near Vasylivka (non-government-controlled, 20km north of Donetsk).

The Mission continued monitoring in Kherson, Odessa, Lviv, Ivano-Frankivsk, Kharkiv, Dnipro, Chernivtsi and Kyiv.

*Restrictions of the SMM's freedom of movement or other impediments to fulfilment of its mandate

The SMM's monitoring and freedom of movement are restricted by security hazards and threats, including risks posed by mines, UXO and other impediments – which vary from day to day. The SMM's mandate provides for safe and secure access throughout Ukraine. All signatories of the Package of Measures have agreed on the need for this safe and secure access, that restriction of the SMM's freedom of movement constitutes a violation, and on the need for rapid response to these violations. They have also agreed that the Joint Centre for Control and Coordination should contribute to such response and co-ordinate mine clearance. Nonetheless, the armed formations in parts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions frequently deny the SMM access to areas adjacent to Ukraine's border outside control of the Government (for example, see <u>SMM Daily Report 15 January 2020</u>). The SMM's operations in Donetsk and Luhansk regions remain restricted following <u>the fatal incident of 23 April 2017 near Pryshyb</u>; these restrictions continued to limit the Mission's observations.

Denial of access:

- At a checkpoint north of Zaichenko (non-government-controlled, 93km south of Donetsk), an armed member of the armed formations <u>again</u> denied the SMM passage towards Pikuzy (formerly Kominternove, non-government-controlled, 92km south of Donetsk) and Sakhanka (non-government-controlled, 97km south of Donetsk), citing "ongoing demining activities in the area".

Regular restrictions related to disengagement areas and mines/UXO:

- The sides continued to deny the SMM full access, as well as the ability to travel certain roads previously identified as important for effective monitoring by the Mission and for civilians' movement, through failure to conduct comprehensive clearance of mines, UXO and other obstacles.

Other impediments:

- Positioned about 2km north-east of Zaichenko, the SMM heard two shots and two bursts of small-arms fire, assessed as directed at its UAV (see above).



When information is not known (indicated with an "N/K"), the SMM was unable to ascertain such information due to distance, weather conditions, technical limitations and/or other considerations. Ceasefire violations recorded by more than one patrol/camera and assessed to be the same are entered only once.

This map of eastern Ukraine is meant for illustrative purposes and indicates locations mentioned in the report, as well as those where the SMM has offices (monitoring teams, patrol hubs, and forward patrol bases) in Donetsk and Luhansk regions. (In red: a forward patrol base from which SMM staff has temporarily relocated based on recommendations of security experts from participating States as well as SMM security considerations. The SMM uses the premises during daylight hours and patrols in this settlement during daylight hours, as well).
