


# Daily Report 14/2020

18 January 2020<sup>1</sup>

### **Summary**

- Compared with the previous reporting period, the SMM recorded fewer ceasefire violations in both Donetsk and Luhansk regions.
- Small-arms fire was assessed as directed at an SMM mini-unmanned aerial vehicle flying over areas on the north-eastern outskirts of Luhansk city.
- The SMM saw weapons in violation of withdrawal lines, mostly in non-government-controlled areas in Luhansk region.
- The Mission continued monitoring the security situation at the disengagement areas near Stanytsia Luhanska, Zolote and Petrivske.
- It saw for the first time anti-tank mines near government-controlled Zolote-4/Rodina.
- The SMM monitored adherence to localized ceasefires to enable the operation of and repairs to critical civilian infrastructure.
- The SMM's freedom of movement continued to be restricted, including at checkpoints of the armed formations in southern Donetsk region.\*

### Ceasefire violations<sup>2</sup>





In Donetsk region, the SMM recorded fewer ceasefire violations, including fewer explosions (40), compared with the <u>previous reporting period</u> (about 260 explosions). The majority of ceasefire violations, including the majority of explosions, were recorded in areas south-west of Svitlodarsk (government-controlled, 57km north-east of Donetsk) and in areas north-north-east of Shyrokyne (government-controlled, 100km south of Donetsk).

In Luhansk region, the SMM recorded fewer ceasefire violations, including fewer explosions (about 30), compared with the <u>previous reporting period</u> (about 430 explosions). The majority of ceasefire violations were recorded at northerly directions of Holubivske (non-government-controlled, 51km west of Luhansk).

### Small-arms fire assessed as directed at SMM mini-unmanned aerial vehicle on the northeastern outskirts of Luhansk city

On 17 January, while conducting an SMM mini-unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) flight over areas on the north-eastern outskirts of Luhansk city (non-government-controlled), the SMM heard 25 shots of small-arms fire at an assessed range of 0.8-1.5km north, assessed as directed at the UAV, which was flying about 1.2km north of its position. The SMM landed its UAV safely and left the area.\*

### Disengagement areas near Stanytsia Luhanska, Zolote and Petrivske<sup>5</sup>

On 17 January, inside the **disengagement area near Stanytsia Luhanska** (government-controlled, 16km north-east of Luhansk), the SMM saw six members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) between the new span of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge and their checkpoint south of it.

On 16 January, an SMM mid-range UAV again spotted at least 650 anti-tank mines in fields south of the railway line and east and west of road T-1316 inside **the disengagement area near Zolote** (government-controlled, 60km west of Luhansk), assessed as belonging to the armed formations. The same day, an SMM long-range UAV spotted two infantry fighting vehicles (IFV) (BMP variants) about 100m east of the checkpoint of the Ukrainian Armed Forces 300m north of the disengagement area.

On 17 January, positioned at two locations near the Zolote disengagement area, the SMM heard ten undetermined explosions and 11 shots and bursts of small-arms and heavy-machine-gun fire, assessed as outside the disengagement area but within 5km of its periphery.

On 16 January, an SMM long-range UAV spotted two probable armoured personnel carriers (BTR variants) and two IFVs (BMP variants) at two locations about 450m north-west and about 700m south-west outside the **disengagement area near Petrivske** (non-government-controlled, 41km south of Donetsk), assessed as belonging to the Ukrainian Armed Forces.

#### Withdrawal of weapons

The SMM continued to monitor the withdrawal of weapons in implementation of the Memorandum and the Package of Measures and its Addendum.

The SMM saw weapons in violation of the withdrawal lines, mostly in non-government-controlled areas in Luhansk region and weapons beyond withdrawal lines but outside designated storage sites in non-government-controlled areas in Luhansk region (for further details, see the table below).

### Indications of military and military-type presence in the security zone<sup>6</sup>

The SMM observed military and military-type presence on both sides of the contact line, including armoured combat vehicles and anti-aircraft guns (for further details, see the table below).

On 15 January, an SMM mini-UAV spotted a new position of the Ukrainian Armed Forces north of a local road east of Zolote-4/Rodina (government-controlled, 59km west of Luhansk) (not seen in imagery from 21 November 2019) about 500m west of previously observed positions. About 600m further east of the abovementioned new position, and about 1.7km north-east of Zolote-5/Mykhailivka (non-government-controlled, 58km west of Luhansk), the UAV spotted two trenches (respectively 20m and 30m-long) on both sides of the same local road, assessed as belonging to the armed formations (not seen in imagery from October 2019). The same UAV also spotted about 30 craters in the same area (not visible in imagery from 12 November 2019).

# Presence of anti-tank mines near Zolote-4/Rodina and mine hazard sign between Raivka and Kruta Hora

On 15 January, an SMM mini-UAV spotted for the first time seven anti-tank mines laid in a single row across a local road about 1.7km east-north-east of Zolote-4/Rodina, assessed as belonging to the Ukrainian Armed Forces (for more observations in the same area, see *Indications of military and military-type presence in the security zone* above).

On 17 January, the SMM saw for the first time a mine hazard sign on wooden stakes reading "Stop, Mines" in Russian and an improvised roadblock made of branches across the road between Raivka (non-government-controlled, 16km north-west of Luhansk) and Kruta Hora (non-government-controlled, 17km north of Luhansk).

### SMM facilitation of repairs to and operation of critical civilian infrastructure

The SMM facilitated and monitored adherence to localized ceasefires to enable maintenance works at the phenol sludge reservoir near Zalizne (formerly Artemove, government-controlled, 42km north-east of Donetsk), repair works to power lines in Shevchenko (non-government-controlled, 69km south of Donetsk) and an assessment and repairs of a water distribution conduit between Nyzhnie (government-controlled, 56km north-west of Luhansk) and Novotoshkivske (government-controlled, 53km west of Luhansk), and in Novotoshkivske. The Mission continued to facilitate the operation of the Donetsk Filtration Station (15km north of Donetsk).

The Mission continued monitoring in Kherson, Odessa, Lviv, Ivano-Frankivsk, Kharkiv, Dnipro, Chernivtsi and Kyiv.

# \*Restrictions of the SMM's freedom of movement or other impediments to fulfilment of its mandate

The SMM's monitoring and freedom of movement are restricted by security hazards and threats, including risks posed by mines, unexploded ordnance (UXO) and other impediments – which vary from day to day. The SMM's mandate provides for safe and secure access throughout Ukraine. All signatories of the Package of Measures have agreed on the need for this safe and secure access, that restriction of the SMM's freedom of movement constitutes a violation, and on the need for rapid response to these violations. They have also agreed that the Joint Centre for Control and Co-ordination (JCCC) should contribute to such response and co-ordinate mine clearance. Nonetheless, the armed formations in parts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions frequently deny the SMM access to areas adjacent to Ukraine's border outside control of the Government (for example, see SMM Daily Report 15 January 2020). The SMM's operations in Donetsk and Luhansk regions remain restricted following the fatal incident of 23 April 2017 near Pryshyb; these restrictions continued to limit the Mission's observations.

### Denial of access:

- At a checkpoint near Prymorske (non-government-controlled, 76km south of Donetsk), two armed members of the armed formations <u>again</u> denied the SMM passage towards Naberezhne (non-government-controlled, 77km south of Donetsk) citing "ongoing demining activities in the area".
- At a checkpoint north of Zaichenko (non-government-controlled, 93km south of Donetsk), an armed member of the armed formations <u>again</u> denied the SMM passage towards Pikuzy (formerly Kominternove, non-government-controlled, 92km south of Donetsk) and Sakhanka (non-government-controlled, 97km south of Donetsk), citing "ongoing demining activities". While positioned at the checkpoint, the SMM saw two civilian cars passing through the checkpoint.
- At a checkpoint north of Novoazovsk (non-government-controlled, 102km south-east of Donetsk), two armed members of the armed formations <u>again</u> denied the SMM passage towards Novoazovsk citing "ongoing anti-terrorist operations in the area".

### Delay:

- At a checkpoint west of Verkhnoshyrokivske (formerly Oktiabr, non-government-controlled, 85km south of Donetsk), a member of the armed formations allowed the SMM passage after about 30 minutes of waiting.

Regular restrictions related to disengagement areas and mines/UXO:

- The sides continued to deny the SMM full access, as well as the ability to travel certain roads previously identified as important for effective monitoring by the Mission and for civilians' movement, through failure to conduct comprehensive clearance of mines, UXO and other obstacles.

### Other impediments:

- An SMM mini-UAV experienced GPS signal interference, assessed as caused by probable jamming, while flying over areas near Hnutove (government-controlled, 90km south of Donetsk).<sup>7</sup>

- On the north-eastern outskirts of Luhansk city (non-government-controlled), the SMM heard 25 shots of small-arms fire, assessed as directed at its UAV (see above).


