

Daily Report 15/2020

20 January 2020¹

Summary

- Compared with the previous reporting period, between the evenings of 17 and 18 January, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations in both Donetsk and Luhansk regions.
- Between the evenings of 18 and 19 January, the Mission recorded fewer ceasefire ٠ violations in both Donetsk and Luhansk regions, compared with the previous 24 hours.
- The SMM followed up on reports that a man had been injured by an explosive device • near government-controlled Vozdvyzhenka, Donetsk region.
- The Mission continued monitoring the security situation at the disengagement areas ٠ near Stanytsia Luhanska, Zolote and Petrivske.
- The SMM saw weapons in violation of withdrawal lines in non-government-controlled • and government-controlled areas of Donetsk region, including in residential areas.
- It saw anti-tank mines in government-controlled and non-government-controlled areas • of Donetsk region, some for the first time, as well as unexploded ordnance near government-controlled Lebedynske.
- It observed a gathering related to a commemoration event in Kyiv. •
- The SMM's freedom of movement continued to be restricted, including at checkpoints • of the armed formations in southern Donetsk region and near border areas outside of government control.*

Ceasefire violations²




Number of recorded ceasefire violations³

In Donetsk region, between the evenings of 17 and 18 January, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations, including more explosions (about 50), compared with the <u>previous</u> reporting period (40 explosions). The majority of ceasefire violations, including the majority of explosions, were recorded in areas north and north-north-east of Shyrokyne (government-controlled, 100km south of Donetsk), east of Krasnohorivka (government-controlled, 21km west of Donetsk) and south-east and south-west of Svitlodarsk (government-controlled, 57km north-east of Donetsk).

Between the evenings of 18 and 19 January, the Mission recorded fewer ceasefire violations, including, however, more explosions (about 60), compared with the previous 24 hours. The majority of ceasefire violations were recorded in areas east-south-east of Hnutove (government-controlled, 90km south of Donetsk) and at northerly directions of Shyrokyne.

In Luhansk region, between the evenings of 17 and 18 January, the Mission recorded more ceasefire violations, including more explosions (about 350), compared with the <u>previous</u> reporting period (about 30 explosions). The majority of ceasefire violations, including the majority of explosions, were recorded at northerly directions of Berezivske (non-government-controlled, 53km north-west of Luhansk).

Between the evenings of 18 and 19 January, the SMM recorded fewer ceasefire violations, including fewer explosions (about 290), compared with the previous 24 hours. The majority of ceasefire violations, were recorded in areas north-north-east of Holubivske (non-government-controlled, 51km west of Luhansk) and in the vicinity of the disengagement area near Zolote (government-controlled, 60km west of Luhansk) (see below).

Man injured by explosive device near government-controlled Vozdvyzhenka

On 18 January, the SMM followed up on reports that a man had been injured when an explosive device he had brought home detonated on 13 January near Vozdvyzhenka (government-controlled, 40km north-west of Donetsk). Medical staff at a hospital in Myrnohrad (formerly Dymytrov, government-controlled, 52km north-west of Donetsk) told the Mission that a man (22 years old) had been admitted on 13 January with injuries to his arms, head, face, abdomen and legs, consistent with shrapnel injuries caused by an explosive device. On the same day, police officers told the SMM that an investigation had been opened into the case.

Disengagement areas near Stanytsia Luhanska, Zolote and Petrivske⁵

On 18 January, inside the **disengagement area near Stanytsia Luhanska** (governmentcontrolled, 16km north-east of Luhansk), the SMM saw workers from non-governmentcontrolled areas painting panels of the checkpoint of the armed formations south of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge (15km north-east of Luhansk). On 18 and 19 January, it saw six members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) between the new span of the bridge and their checkpoint south of it.

During the day on 18 January, positioned 1.7km south-west of Molodizhne (non-governmentcontrolled, 63km west of Luhansk), the SMM heard 16 undetermined explosions at an assessed range of 7-10km north-east, assessed as near the **disengagement area near Zolote**. On the same day, the SMM camera in Zolote recorded four projectiles in flight, four undetermined explosions and a muzzle flash, all at an assessed range of 1-4km north, north-east, east-north-

east and east, assessed as outside the disengagement area but within 5km of its periphery. On 19 January, inside the disengagement area, the Mission saw for the first time a tailfin of a mortar round and one of a rocket-propelled grenade both just east of road T-1316 and 1km north of the area's southern edge, assessed as not recent. On the same day, while positioned in four locations around the disengagement area, the Mission heard about 130 undetermined explosions and about 60 bursts and shots of heavy-machine-gun and small-arms fire, all assessed as outside the disengagement area.

On 18 January, on the western outskirts of Bohdanivka (government-controlled, 41km southwest of Donetsk), outside the **disengagement area near Petrivske** (non-governmentcontrolled, 41km south of Donetsk), the SMM saw five deminers of the State Emergency Service of Ukraine (SES) and five workers of an electric company clearing shrubs and branches around an electrical line. On 19 January, the Mission observed three SES deminers carrying out demining activities about 1.7km east of Bohdanivka.

Withdrawal of weapons

The SMM continued to monitor the withdrawal of weapons in implementation of the Memorandum and the Package of Measures and its Addendum.

The SMM saw weapons in violation of the withdrawal lines, in non-government-controlled and government-controlled areas of Donetsk region, including in residential areas, and ten tanks beyond withdrawal lines but outside designated storage sites in a training area near Ternove (non-government-controlled, 57km east of Donetsk) (for further details, see the table below).

Weapons that the SMM could not verify as withdrawn⁶

At two heavy weapons holding areas in non-government-controlled areas of Donetsk region 19 January

The SMM noted that six self-propelled howitzers (2S1 *Gvozdika*, 122mm), 11 towed mortars (PM-38, 120mm), a mortar (2B11 *Sani*, 120mm) and six multiple launch rocket systems (BM-21 *Grad*, 122mm) continued to be missing.

Indications of military presence in the security zone⁷

The SMM observed armoured combat vehicles in government-controlled areas of Donetsk and Luhansk regions (for further details, see the table below).

Presence of anti-tank mines in Donetsk region, some seen for the first time, as well as unexploded ordnance near government-controlled Lebedynske

On 16 January, about 5km south-east of Luhanske (government-controlled, 59km north-east of Donetsk), an SMM mid-range UAV again spotted 33 anti-tank mines (TM-62) laid out in two rows extending 30m on each side of road M-03 and 15 anti-tank mines (TM-62) laid out in two rows across the same road. In a field about 400m further north-west, the UAV spotted, all for

the first time, at least 50 anti-tank mines (TM-62) and at least 70 more anti-tank mines (more than half of which were TM-62 and the rest probable TM-62) about 2.6km south-west of the aforementioned ones. All of the above mines were assessed as belonging to the Ukrainian Armed Forces.

The same UAV <u>again</u> spotted at least 107 anti-tank mines (TM-62) near and across road M-03, about 4km north-west of Lohvynove (non-government-controlled, 59km north-east of Donetsk), and 30 anti-tank mines (TM-62) laid out in three rows across the same road about 1.2km further south-east. About 7km further west and 1.3km north-west of Lozove (non-government-controlled, 52km north-east of Donetsk), the same UAV spotted for the first time 16 anti-tank mines (TM-62) laid out in a single row across a local road and at least 17 anti-tank mines (TM-62) in an adjacent field. All of the above mines were assessed as belonging to the armed formations.

On 19 January, on the north-eastern outskirts of Lebedynske (government-controlled, 99km south of Donetsk), the Mission saw a piece of unexploded ordnance (UXO), assessed as a 23mm round and not recent.

SMM facilitation of operation of critical civilian infrastructure

On 18 and 19 January, the Mission continued to facilitate the operation of the Donetsk Filtration Station (15km north of Donetsk). On 19 January, it monitored the security situation in areas around the pumping station near Vasylivka (non-government-controlled, 20km north of Donetsk).

Border areas outside government control

On 18 January, while at a border crossing point near Voznesenivka (formerly Chervonopartyzansk, 65km south-east of Luhansk), the SMM saw six cars (three with Ukrainian and two with Russian Federation licence plates, as well as one with "LPR" plates), five cargo trucks (one with Ukrainian licence plates, as well as four with "LPR" plates) and a bus with Ukrainian licence plates queuing to exit Ukraine. After about ten minutes, a member of the armed formations told the SMM to leave the area.*

While at the Chervona Mohyla railway station near Voznesenivka for about 15 minutes, the SMM saw at least 20 cisterns and 70 stationary railway cars but could not determine their contents.

While at a border crossing point near Uspenka (73km south-east of Donetsk) for about an hour, the SMM saw 35 cars (four with Ukrainian, nine with Russian Federation and two with Georgian licence plates, as well as 20 with "DPR" plates), three trucks (one with Ukrainian and two with Russian Federation licence plates) and 25 pedestrians (14 men, ten women and one child) entering Ukraine. It also saw 13 cars (two with Ukrainian, seven with Russian Federation and two with Lithuanian licence plates, as well as two with "DPR" plates), a bus with Russian Federation licence plates, four covered cargo trucks (two with Ukrainian licence plates, as well as two with "DPR" plates) and 16 pedestrians (nine women and seven men) exiting Ukraine.

While at a border crossing point near Ulianivske (61km south-east of Donetsk) for about 35 minutes, the Mission did not observe any cross-border traffic.

On 19 January, while at a border crossing point near Marynivka (78km east of Donetsk), for about an hour, the SMM observed 13 cars (one with Ukrainian, six with Russian Federation and one with Lithuanian licence plates, as well as five with "DPR" plates), a bus with "DPR" plates and two pedestrians (men) entering Ukraine. It also saw 12 cars (four with Ukrainian and four with Russian Federation licence plates, as well as four with "DPR" plates), seven covered cargo trucks (five with Ukrainian licence plates, as well as two with "DPR" plates) and two buses with "DPR" plates exiting Ukraine.

SMM observed a gathering related to a commemoration event in Kyiv

On 19 January, the SMM saw a group of about 25 people (20 men, 5 women) gathered at an event commemorating the death of two journalists in the Russian Federation at Mykhailivska Square in Kyiv. The Mission saw another group of about 50 young men gathered nearby, some of whom threw eggs and shouted critical remarks at the participants in the other group. There were about 150 National Guard and 80 police officers around the square. The SMM saw law enforcement officers arresting members of the latter group and escorting participants of the former group away from the site.

SMM monitored the security situation in south-east Kherson region

On 17 and 18 January, the SMM observed a calm situation at the checkpoint between Chonhar (163km south-east of Kherson) and Crimea, and in coastal areas near Henichesk (178km south-east of Kherson).

The Mission continued monitoring in Odessa, Lviv, Ivano-Frankivsk, Kharkiv, Dnipro, and Chernivtsi.

*Restrictions of the SMM's freedom of movement or other impediments to fulfilment of its mandate

The SMM's monitoring and freedom of movement are restricted by security hazards and threats, including risks posed by mines, UXO and other impediments – which vary from day to day. The SMM's mandate provides for safe and secure access throughout Ukraine. All signatories of the Package of Measures have agreed on the need for this safe and secure access, that restriction of the SMM's freedom of movement constitutes a violation, and on the need for rapid response to these violations. They have also agreed that the Joint Centre for Control and Co-ordination (JCCC) should contribute to such response and co-ordinate mine clearance. Nonetheless, the armed formations in parts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions frequently deny the SMM access to areas adjacent to Ukraine's border outside control of the Government (for example, see below). The SMM's operations in Donetsk and Luhansk regions remain restricted following the fatal incident of 23 April 2017 near Pryshyb; these restrictions continued to limit the Mission's observations.

Denial of access:

- On 18 January, while at a border crossing point near Voznesenivka (formerly Chervonopartyzansk, non-government-controlled, 65km south-east of Luhansk), a member of the armed formations told the SMM to leave the area.
- On 18 January, at a checkpoint north of Zaichenko (non-government-controlled, 93km south of Donetsk), two armed members of the armed formations <u>again</u> denied the SMM passage towards Pikuzy (formerly Kominternove, non-government-controlled, 92km

south of Donetsk) and Sakhanka (non-government-controlled, 97km south of Donetsk), citing "ongoing demining activities".

- On 18 January, at a checkpoint north-west of Siedove (non-government-controlled, 106km south of Donetsk), seven armed members of the armed formations denied the SMM access to the village, citing "an ongoing armed operation in the area".
- On 19 January, at a checkpoint west of Verkhnoshyrokivske (formerly Oktiabr, nongovernment-controlled, 85km south of Donetsk), an armed member of the armed formations allowed the SMM passage only on the condition that it did not proceed to Pikuzy (formerly Kominternove, non-government-controlled, 92km south of Donetsk) and Sakhanka (non-government-controlled, 97km south of Donetsk).
- On 19 January, at a checkpoint at a junction on road M-14 leading south towards Siedove, a member of the armed formations stopped the SMM and denied it access to the village, citing "orders from superiors".
- On 19 January, at a checkpoint north of Novoazovsk (non-government-controlled, 102km south-east of Donetsk), an armed member of the armed formations <u>again</u> denied the SMM passage towards Novoazovsk citing "orders from superiors".

Regular restrictions related to disengagement areas and mines/UXO:

- The sides continued to deny the SMM full access, as well as the ability to travel certain roads previously identified as important for effective monitoring by the Mission and for civilians' movement, through failure to conduct comprehensive clearance of mines, UXO and other obstacles.

Other impediments:

- On the evening and night of 17-18 January, an SMM long-range UAV experienced GPS signal interference, assessed as caused by jamming, while flying over areas between Oleksandro-Shultyne (government-controlled, 54km north of Donetsk) and Hirske (government-controlled, 63km west of Luhansk), as well as between Mykolaivka (government-controlled, 57km north of Donetsk) and Stepanivka (government-controlled, 54km north of Donetsk).
- On 18 January, an SMM mini-UAV experienced GPS signal interference, assessed as caused by probable jamming, while flying over areas near Sopyne (government-controlled, 101km south of Donetsk).
- On 19 January, an SMM mini-UAV experienced GPS signal interference on two occasions, assessed as caused by probable jamming, while flying over areas near Rodnykove (non-government-controlled, 36km south of Donetsk).
- On 19 January, an SMM mini-UAV experienced GPS signal interference on two occasions, assessed as caused by probable jamming, while flying in the vicinity of the disengagement area near Petrivske (non-government-controlled, 41km south of Donetsk).


