

Daily Report 36/2020

13 February 2020¹

Summary

- Compared with the previous reporting period, the SMM recorded fewer ceasefire • violations in Donetsk region and more in Luhansk region.
- The Mission continued monitoring the security situation at the disengagement areas near • Stanytsia Luhanska, Zolote and Petrivske.
- The Mission saw weapons in violations of withdrawal lines on both sides of the contact line, including near a residential area.
- The Mission saw traffic delays and people crossing on foot an icy road between a checkpoint of the armed formations near Kreminets and an entry-exit checkpoint of the Ukrainian Armed Forces near Marinka, in Donetsk region.
- The SMM's freedom of movement continued to be restricted, including at a checkpoint • near non-government-controlled Verkhnoshyrokivske in southern Donetsk region.*


Number of recorded ceasefire violations²

In Donetsk region, the SMM recorded fewer ceasefire violations, including, however, a similar number of explosions (about 25), compared with the <u>previous reporting period</u> (30 explosions). The majority of ceasefire violations, including the majority of explosions, were recorded in areas north-north-east and north of Shyrokyne (government-controlled, 100km south of Donetsk), as well as in south-east of Svitlodarsk (government-controlled, 57km north-east of Donetsk).

In Luhansk region, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations, including more explosions (about 205), compared with the <u>previous reporting period</u> (five explosions). While positioned in Trokhizbenka (government-controlled, 32km north-west of Luhansk), the SMM heard more than 90 per cent of ceasefire violations (including 200 explosions assessed as outgoing mortar and artillery rounds) at an assessed range of 5-10km south-west.

Disengagement areas near Stanytsia Luhanska, Zolote and Petrivske⁴

On the early evening of 11 February, while on the eastern edge of Stanytsia Luhanska (government-controlled, 16km north-east of Luhansk), the SMM heard six shots of small-arms fire at an assessed range of 1-2km south and south-west and assessed as outside the disengagement area but within 5km of its periphery. Inside the disengagement area near Stanytsia Luhanska, on 12 February, the SMM saw a truck from government-controlled areas clearing snow and pouring a defrosting mixture between the northern edge of the new span of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge (15km north-east of Luhansk) and the entry-exit checkpoint of the Ukrainian Armed Forces north of it. On the same day, the Mission saw nine members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) between the new span of the bridge and their checkpoint south of it.

On 12 February, while positioned near Berezivske (non-government-controlled, 53km northwest of Luhansk), the Mission heard an undetermined explosion at an assessed range of 2-3km north-north-west, assessed as outside the **disengagement area near Zolote** (governmentcontrolled, 60km west of Luhansk) but within 5km of its periphery.

On 12 February, while positioned in Styla (non-government-controlled, 34km south of Donetsk), the SMM observed a calm situation near the **disengagement area near Petrivske** (non-government-controlled, 41km south of Donetsk).

Withdrawal of weapons

The SMM continued to monitor the withdrawal of weapons in implementation of the Memorandum and the Package of Measures and its Addendum.

The Mission saw 28 weapons in violation of withdrawal lines on both sides of the contact line, including near a residential area (for further details, see table below).

Weapons permanent storage sites

At a heavy weapons permanent storage site in a non-government-controlled area of Luhansk region 12 February The SMM noted that all weapons were present.

Indications of military and military-type presence in the security zone⁵

The SMM observed armoured combat vehicles on both sides of the contact line, including in a residential area in a government-controlled area of Donetsk region, as well as an anti-aircraft gun near a residential area in a non-government-controlled area of Donetsk region (for further details, see the table below).

Demining activities near Lomakyne

The SMM saw about 30 members of an international demining organization digging in the ground with shovels in three fields about 2.5km south-south-east of Lomakyne (government-controlled, 93km south of Donetsk), all within a 1.5km radius of road T-0519.

SMM facilitation of maintenance to and operation of critical civilian infrastructure

The Mission continued to facilitate the maintenance and operation of the Donetsk Filtration Station (15km north of Donetsk).

Situation of civilians at checkpoints along the contact line

While between a checkpoint of the armed formations east of Kreminets (non-governmentcontrolled, 16km south-west of Donetsk) and the entry-exit checkpoint (EECP) of the Ukrainian Armed Forces near Marinka (government-controlled, 23km south-west of Donetsk) for about 180 minutes, the SMM saw that vehicular traffic was moving only from the direction of nongovernment- to government-controlled areas. The Mission also saw that about 700 people were crossing on foot (in both directions) an icy road between the aforementioned checkpoint of the armed formations and the EECP.

The Mission continued monitoring in Kherson, Odessa, Lviv, Ivano-Frankivsk, Kharkiv, Dnipro, Chernivtsi and Kyiv.

*Restrictions of the SMM's freedom of movement or other impediments to fulfilment of its mandate

The SMM's monitoring and freedom of movement are restricted by security hazards and threats, including risks posed by mines, unexploded ordnance (UXO) and other impediments – which vary from day to day. The SMM's mandate provides for safe and secure access throughout Ukraine. All signatories of the Package of Measures have agreed on the need for this safe and secure access, that restriction of the SMM's freedom of movement constitutes a violation, and on the need for rapid response to these violations. They have also agreed that the Joint Centre for Control and Co-ordination (JCCC) should contribute to such response and co-ordinate mine clearance. Nonetheless, the armed formations in parts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions frequently deny the SMM access to areas adjacent to Ukraine's border outside control of the Government (for example, <u>SMM Daily Report 11 February 2020</u>). The SMM's

operations in Donetsk and Luhansk regions remain restricted following <u>the fatal incident of 23 April 2017</u> <u>near Pryshyb</u>; these restrictions continued to limit the Mission's observations.

Denials of access:

- On two occasions, at a checkpoint west of Verkhnoshyrokivske (formerly Oktiabr, nongovernment controlled, 85km south of Donetsk), armed members of the armed formations <u>again</u> denied the SMM passage towards Pikuzy (formerly Kominternove, non-government-controlled, 92km south of Donetsk) and Sakhanka (non-governmentcontrolled, 97km south of Donetsk), citing "ongoing operations" in the area. While present, the SMM saw civilian traffic proceeding in both directions.

Regular restrictions related to disengagement areas and mines/UXO:

- The sides continued to deny the SMM full access, as well as the ability to travel certain roads previously identified as important for effective monitoring by the Mission and for civilians' movement, through failure to conduct comprehensive clearance of mines, UXO and other obstacles.

Conditional access:

- At a checkpoint west of Verkhnoshyrokivske, an armed member of the armed formations allowed the SMM to pass through on condition that the patrol not proceed further than Boikivske (formerly Telmanove, non-government-controlled, 67km south-east of Donetsk).


