


# Daily Report 52/2020

# 3 March 2020<sup>1</sup>

#### **Summary**

- Compared with the previous 24 hours, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations in both Donetsk and Luhansk regions.
- The Mission observed a calm situation in the Stanytsia Luhanska disengagement area. It saw de-miners of the State Emergency Service of Ukraine entering the Zolote disengagement area to reportedly conduct demining activities and recorded ceasefire violations inside the Petrivske disengagement area.
- The SMM observed mines on both sides of the contact line, including near roads ٠ used by civilians daily.
- The SMM facilitated localized ceasefires to enable repairs to power lines near Azov • and to enable demining activities in Krasnyi Yar.
- The Mission's freedom of movement continued to be restricted, including at • checkpoints of the armed formations near Verkhnoshyrokivske and Zaichenko in southern Donetsk region, and at a border crossing point in non-governmentcontrolled Voznesenivka in Luhansk region.




#### Map of recorded ceasefire violations

In Donetsk region, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations, including more explosions (about 170), compared with the previous 24 hours (about 120 explosions). The majority of the ceasefire violations, including the majority of explosions, were recorded at easterly and south-westerly directions of Svitlodarsk (government-controlled, 57km north-east of Donetsk), in areas north of Shyrokyne (government-controlled, 100km south of Donetsk) and in areas south-east of Styla (non-government-controlled, 34km south-west of Donetsk).

In Luhansk region, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations, including more explosions (190), compared with the <u>previous 24 hours</u> (about 90 explosions). About 80 per cent of ceasefire violations, including almost all explosions, were recorded in areas east and southeast of Zolote (government-controlled, 60km west of Luhansk) (see below).

#### Disengagement areas near Stanytsia Luhanska, Zolote and Petrivske<sup>5</sup>

On 2 March, inside the **disengagement area near Stanytsia Luhanska** (governmentcontrolled, 16km north-east of Luhansk), the SMM saw five members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) between the new span of the bridge and the checkpoint of the armed formations south of the bridge.

On 1 March, inside **the disengagement area near Zolote**, about 30m south of its northern edge and about 125m west of its eastern edge, an SMM long-range unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) spotted a person in camouflage clothing. The same UAV also spotted a probable armoured reconnaissance vehicle (BRDM-2) parked on the western edge of the area, assessed as belonging to the armed formations.

Between the evenings of 1 and 2 March, the SMM camera in Zolote recorded 20 undetermined explosions, 16 projectiles in flight and an illumination flare, all at an assessed range of 0.7-4km east and east-south-east and assessed as outside the disengagement area but within 5km of its periphery.

On 2 March, while positioned in three other locations, the SMM heard 130 undetermined explosions and about 225 bursts of small-arms and heavy-machine-gun fire, all assessed as outside the disengagement area but within 5km of its periphery. On the same day, the SMM saw two members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) near the southern edge of the disengagement area.

On the same day, the SMM facilitated and monitored adherence to a localized ceasefire to enable demining activities inside the disengagement area in Katerynivka (government-controlled, 64km west of Luhansk). It saw a vehicle with five de-miners of the State Emergency Service of Ukraine arriving at the checkpoint of the Ukrainian Armed Forces on the northern edge of the disengagement area and walking with metal detectors towards Katerynivka.

The Mission <u>again</u> saw an anti-personnel mine (MON-50) and a piece of unexploded ordnance (UXO), assessed as a round from a rocket-propelled grenade launcher (RPG-18 *Mukha*, 64mm), both about 1km north of the area's southern edge and about 20m west of road T-1316.

In the evening of 28 February, the SMM camera in Petrivske (non-government-controlled, 41km south of Donetsk) recorded eight projectiles in flight at an assessed range of 0.7-2km south-south-west and south-west, all assessed as inside **the disengagement area near Petrivske**.<sup>6</sup>

On 2 March, the SMM camera 2km east of Bohdanivka (government-controlled, 41km south-west of Donetsk) recorded four projectiles in flight at an assessed range of 1-3km east-south-east, assessed as inside the Petrivske disengagement area. On the same day, while positioned 2km east of Bohdanivka, the SMM heard an undetermined explosion and 15 shots and bursts of small-arms and heavy-machine-gun fire, all at an assessed distance of 5km south and assessed as outside the area but within 5km of its periphery. While positioned in the same location, the SMM saw an armoured personnel carrier (MT-LB) moving from south to north about 250m west of its position, and also heard the sound of a piston engine, assessed as a small air-craft, flying at an assessed range of 5-7km south of its location.

#### Withdrawal of weapons

The SMM continued to monitor the withdrawal of weapons in implementation of the Memorandum and the Package of Measures and its Addendum.

The SMM saw two weapons beyond withdrawal lines in a government-controlled area of Donetsk region (for further details, see the table below).

#### Indications of military and military-type presence in the security zone<sup>7</sup>

The Mission observed infantry fighting vehicles and armoured personnel carriers on both sides of the contact line, including in residential areas (for further details, see the table below).

In areas where it has previously recorded a spike in ceasefire violations on 18 and 23 February, the SMM UAVs spotted armoured combat vehicles near government-controlled Orikhove (57km north-west of Luhansk), Novotoshkivske (53km north-west of Luhansk) and Krymske (42km north-west of Luhansk) on 29 February and 1 March. On 2 March, about 1.5km south-east of Zolote-5/Mykhailivka (non-government-controlled, 58km west of Luhansk), the SMM saw a military truck with at least ten members of the armed formations heading east towards Berezivske (non-government-controlled, 53km west of Luhansk). In a residential area west of Holubivske (non-government-controlled, 51km west of Luhansk), the SMM saw six members of the armed formations near the entrance of a civilian house, assessed as used by the members of the armed formations, unloading construction materials, including metal rods and door panels.

Mines near Vodiane, Novosleivka, Rozsadky and on the roads between Popasna and Molodizhne, and between Pyshchevyk and Verkhnoshyrokivske

On 29 February, an SMM mini-UAV spotted about 30 anti-tank mines, of about 50 previously seen, in fields approximately 1km south-east of Vodiane (government-controlled, 94km south of Donetsk), and another 15 anti-tank mines (a part of a larger minefield) about

450m further east, all assessed as belonging to the Ukrainian Armed Forces (for previous observations, see <u>SMM Daily Report 13 January 2020</u>).

On 29 February, an SMM mid-range UAV spotted 50 anti-tank mines in Novoselivka (government-controlled, 31km north of Donetsk), assessed as belonging to the Ukrainian Armed Forces (for previous observations, see <u>SMM Daily Report 14 March 2019</u>).

On 1 March, an SMM mid-range UAV <u>again</u> spotted eight anti-tank mines (TM-62) laid across a road running from Luhanske (government-controlled, 59km north-east of Donetsk) to Rozsadky (62km north-east of Donetsk), about 150m from uninhabited houses, assessed as belonging to the Ukrainian Armed Forces.

On 2 March, about 2km south-west of Molodizhne (non-government-controlled, 63km north-west of Luhansk), the Mission saw for the first time at least five anti-tank mines (TM-62)within 10-20m south of road T-0504 and about 240-290m west of a checkpoint of the armed formations. About 10m east of the same road and about 1km north-west of the same checkpoint, the SMM <u>again</u> saw an anti-personnel mine (MON-200). About 100m south-west of this mine, it <u>again</u> saw remnants of ammunition, assessed an artillery shell (122mm).

About 3m north of the road between Pyshchevyk (government-controlled, 84km south of Donetsk) and Verkhnoshyrokivske (formerly Oktiabr, non-government-controlled, 85km south of Donetsk), which is used by civilians on a daily basis, the Mission <u>again</u> saw four anti-tank mines placed in a field near positions of the armed formations.

#### SMM facilitation of demining and maintenance of critical civilian infrastructure

The SMM facilitated and monitored adherence to localized ceasefires to enable repairs to power lines near Azov (formerly Dzerzhynske, non-government-controlled, 96km south of Donetsk) and to enable demining in Krasnyi Yar (non-government-controlled, 12km northeast of Luhansk) and in Katerynivka (see above). In Krasnyi Yar, the Mission saw five deminers from non-government-controlled areas conducting demining activities on both sides of a local road on the eastern edge of the settlement and a member of the armed formations carrying about 40 mine hazard signs.

It continued to facilitate the operation of the Donetsk Filtration Station (15km north of Donetsk) and to monitor the security situation in the area of the pumping station near Vasylivka (non-government-controlled, 20km north of Donetsk).

#### Border areas outside government control

During the day on 29 February, an SMM long-range UAV spotted recent vehicle tracks on dirt paths leading towards the border with the Russian Federation in four different areas where there are no border crossing facilities: about 2.5km east-south-east of Novooleksandrivka (75km south-east of Donetsk), about 3.5km east of Shevchenko (65km south-east of Donetsk), about 550m south of Kozhevnia (85km east of Donetsk), and about 3.5km east of Cheremshyne (59km south-east of Luhansk).

While at a border crossing point near Marynivka (78km east of Donetsk) for about 40 minutes, the SMM saw eight cars (one with Ukrainian, four with Russian Federation and one with Polish licence plates, and two with "DPR" plates) entering Ukraine. During the same period, the Mission saw nine cars (two with Ukrainian and six with Russian Federation

licence plates, and one with "DPR" plates) and a covered cargo truck with Ukrainian licence plates exiting Ukraine.

About ten minutes after arriving at a border crossing point near Voznesenivka (formerly Chernonopartyzansk, 65km south-east of Luhansk), a member of the armed formations told the SMM to leave the area. While present, the SMM saw no traffic in either direction.\*

While at the Chervona Mohyla railway station near Voznesenivka for about ten minutes, the SMM saw a stationary train with about 35 covered cargo cars.

The Mission continued monitoring in Kherson, Odessa, Lviv, Ivano-Frankivsk, Kharkiv, Dnipro, Chernivtsi and Kyiv.

# \*Restrictions of the SMM's freedom of movement or other impediments to fulfilment of its mandate

The SMM's monitoring and freedom of movement are restricted by security hazards and threats, including risks posed by mines, UXO and other impediments – which vary from day to day. The SMM's mandate provides for safe and secure access throughout Ukraine. All signatories of the Package of Measures have agreed on the need for this safe and secure access, that restriction of the SMM's freedom of movement constitutes a violation, and on the need for rapid response to these violations. They have also agreed that the Joint Centre for Control and Co-ordination should contribute to such response and co-ordinate mine clearance. Nonetheless, the armed formations in parts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions frequently deny the SMM access to areas adjacent to Ukraine's border outside control of the Government (for example, see below). The SMM's operations in Donetsk and Luhansk regions remain restricted following the fatal incident of 23 April 2017 near Pryshyb; these restrictions continued to limit the Mission's observations.

#### Denial of access:

- At a checkpoint west of Verkhnoshyrokivske (formerly Oktiabr, non-governmentcontrolled, 85km south of Donetsk), an armed member of the armed formations <u>again</u> denied the SMM passage, citing "an ongoing operation in the area". While at the checkpoint, the SMM saw civilian traffic proceeding in both directions.
- At a checkpoint north of Zaichenko (non-government-controlled, 93km south of Donetsk), an armed member of the armed formations <u>again</u> denied the SMM passage towards Azov (formerly Dzerzhynske, non-government-controlled, 96km south of Donetsk). While at the checkpoint, the SMM saw civilians crossing in both directions.
- At a border crossing point near Voznesenivka (formerly Chernonopartyzansk, nongovernment-controlled, 65km south-east of Luhansk), a member of the armed formations told the SMM to leave the area.

#### Regular restrictions related to disengagement areas and mines/UXO:

- The sides continued to deny the SMM full access, as well as the ability to travel certain roads previously identified as important for effective monitoring by the Mission and for civilians' movement, through failure to conduct comprehensive clearance of mines, UXO and other obstacles.

#### Delay:

- At a checkpoint west of Verkhnoshyrokivske, an armed member of the armed formations <u>again</u> allowed the SMM to proceed only after approximately 25 minutes of waiting.

#### Other impediments:

- On 1 March, an SMM long-range UAV experienced dual GPS signal interference, assessed as caused by jamming, while flying over areas between Sofiivka (formerly Karlo-Marksove, government-controlled, 40km north-east of Donetsk) and Krymske (government-controlled, 42km north-west of Luhansk).<sup>8</sup>
- On 2 March, an SMM mini-UAV <u>again</u> experienced GPS signal interference, assessed as caused by probable jamming, while flying near Lebedynske (government-controlled, 99km south of Donetsk).


