
6 March 2020¹

Summary

- Compared with the previous reporting period, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations in both Donetsk and Luhansk regions.
- A man died reportedly from injuries caused by an explosive device in nongovernment-controlled Pionerske.
- The Mission observed a calm situation in the disengagement area near Stanytsia Luhanska and recorded ceasefire violations inside the disengagement areas near Petrivske and Zolote.
- It spotted recent trenches near government-controlled Novotoshkivske and non-government-controlled Holubivske.
- The SMM observed anti-tank mines near non-government-controlled Sentianivka and government-controlled Luhanske and Vodiane.
- The SMM continued to facilitate localized ceasefires to enable repairs to power lines near Spartak and demining activities near Krasnyi Yar.
- The Mission's freedom of movement continued to be restricted, including at a checkpoint of the armed formations in Bezimenne and near a border crossing point close to non-government-controlled Dovzhanske.



Ceasefire violations observed by the SMM 5 March 2020



In Donetsk region, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations, including more explosions (about 315), compared with the <u>previous reporting period</u> (about 210 explosions). The majority of ceasefire violations were recorded at northerly directions of Shyrokyne (government-controlled, 100km south of Donetsk), at easterly and westerly directions of Svitlodarsk (government-controlled, 57km north-east of Donetsk), and in areas south-southeast of Pisky (government-controlled, 11km north-west of Donetsk).

In Luhansk region, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations, including more explosions (125), compared with the <u>previous reporting period</u> (70 explosions). The majority of ceasefire violations were recorded in areas south-east of Popasna (government-controlled, 69km west of Luhansk) and in areas east of the disengagement area near Zolote (government-controlled, 60km west of Luhansk) (see below).

A man died reportedly from an explosive device in non-government-controlled Pionerske

The SMM followed up on reports of a 57-year-old man who reportedly stepped on an antipersonnel mine in Pionerske (non-government-controlled, 19km east of Luhansk) on 27 February. On 29 February, the man's neighbour told the Mission that he had found the man in his house on the morning of 28 February injured after he had called for help and had called for an ambulance; however, the man had passed away from heavy bleeding before the ambulance arrived. On 5 March, a woman who introduced herself as the man's wife told the Mission over the phone that at the time of the incident she had been in Luhansk city, whereas her husband had died on 28 February after stepping on an anti-personnel mine while at their summer house in Pionerske.

On 29 February, while in Pionerske, the SMM saw that the man's house could be found at the end of a local street, about 50m away from visible mine hazard signs.

Disengagement areas near Stanytsia Luhanska, Zolote and Petrivske⁵

During the day on 5 March, the SMM observed a calm situation in the **Stanytsia Luhanska disengagement area** (government-controlled, 16km north-east of Luhansk). Throughout the day, the SMM saw members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) between the new span of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge (15km north-east of Luhansk) and their checkpoint south of it.

On 1 March, aerial imagery available to the SMM revealed the presence of two armoured combat vehicles at a checkpoint about 300m north of the northern edge of the **disengagement area near Zolote** (government-controlled, 60km west of Luhansk).

On the night between 4 and 5 March, the SMM camera in Zolote recorded an illumination flare at an assessed range of 4-6km south-east, which the Mission was unable to assess as inside or outside the disengagement area, and two undetermined explosions and a projectile in flight at an assessed range of 2-4km east (assessed as outside the area but within 5km of its periphery).

On 5 March, while positioned 400m north of the northern edge of the Zolote disengagement area, the SMM heard 14 undetermined explosions at an assessed range of 3-4km south-east, which were unable to be determined as inside or outside the disengagement area. During the same day, while positioned in six locations close to the disengagement area, the SMM heard about 65 undetermined explosions and 25 shots and bursts of small-arms and heavy-machine-gun fire, all assessed as outside the area but within 5km of its periphery. Throughout the day, the SMM saw a member of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) on the southern edge of the disengagement area.

On the night between 4 and 5 March, the SMM camera 2km east of Bohdanivka (government-controlled, 41km south-west of Donetsk) recorded two projectiles in flight from north-north-east to south-south-west, at an assessed range of 2-4km east-south-east, assessed as inside the **disengagement area near Petrivske** (non-government-controlled, 41km south of Donetsk). The same camera also recorded 24 projectiles in flight at an assessed range of 2-4km east and south-east, which were unable to be assessed as inside or outside the disengagement area.

Withdrawal of weapons

The SMM continued to monitor the withdrawal of weapons in implementation of the Memorandum and the Package of Measures and its Addendum.

The SMM observed four weapons in violation of withdrawal lines and 48 weapons beyond withdrawal lines but outside designated storage sites, on both sides of the contact line (for more information, see the table below).

Indications of military and military-type presence in the security zone⁶

The Mission observed armoured combat vehicles on both sides of the contact line in both Donetsk and Luhansk regions, some in residential areas (for further details, see the table below).

On 1 March, aerial imagery available to the SMM revealed the presence of a recent 80m trench running from east to west in fields west-north-west of Holubivske (non-government-controlled, 51km west of Luhansk), two recent trenches running for 50m north to south and 70m east to west in fields east of Novotoshkivske (government-controlled, 53km west of Luhansk), and two recent trenches running for about 10m eat to west and 50m north to south in fields south west of Krymske (government-controlled, 42km north-west of Luhansk) (all not visible in imagery from 24 November 2019).

Mines near Sentianivka, Luhanske and Vodiane

On 4 March, an SMM long-range unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) spotted for the first time three rows of at least 37 anti-tank mines laid across a road close to forward positions of the armed formations near Sentianivka (formerly Frunze, non-government-controlled, 44km west of Luhansk).

On the same day, an SMM mid-range UAV <u>again</u> spotted eight anti-tank mines laid across a road between Luhanske (government-controlled, 59km north-east of Donetsk) and Rozsadky (62km north-east of Donetsk) and at least 120 anti-tank mines (part of a larger minefield) in a field north of Vodiane (government-controlled, 94km south of Donetsk) and about 24 additional anti-tank mines laid across road T-0519 near Vodiane.⁷ All these mines were assessed as belonging to the Ukrainian Armed Forces.

SMM facilitation of repairs, demining and operation of critical civilian infrastructure

The SMM continued to facilitate and monitor adherence to localized ceasefires to enable repairs to the power lines near Spartak (non-government-controlled, 9km north of Donetsk) and demining in non-government-controlled Krasnyi Yar (non-government-controlled, 12km north-east of Luhansk). In Krasnyi Yar, the Mission saw five de-miners from non-government-controlled areas conducting demining activities on both sides of a local road and heard one explosion, assessed as a controlled detonation of unexploded ordnance (UXO) about 900m east of its position.

It continued to facilitate the operation of the Donetsk Filtration Station (DFS) (15km north of Donetsk) and to monitor the security situation in the area of the pumping station near Vasylivka (non-government-controlled, 20km north of Donetsk). While in the area of the DFS, the SMM recorded 30 explosions within a 5km radius of the DFS.

Distribution of humanitarian aid in Verkhnotoretske

In Verkhnotoretske (government-controlled, 23km north-east of Donetsk), the SMM saw about 70 civilians (mixed genders and ages) queuing in front of a local administrative building to receive food packages and financial assistance distributed by a humanitarian organization.

Border areas outside government control

While at the pedestrian border crossing point near Novoborovytsi (79km south of Luhansk) for about 20 minutes, the Mission did not see any pedestrians exiting or entering Ukraine. Members of the armed formations told the Mission to leave after its arrival at a border crossing point near Dovzhanske (84km south-east of Luhansk).*

The Mission continued monitoring in Kherson, Odessa, Lviv, Ivano-Frankivsk, Kharkiv, Dnipro, Chernivtsi, and Kyiv.

*Restrictions of the SMM's freedom of movement or other impediments to fulfilment of its mandate

The SMM's monitoring and freedom of movement are restricted by security hazards and threats, including risks posed by mines, UXO and other impediments – which vary from day to day. The SMM's mandate provides for safe and secure access throughout Ukraine. All signatories of the Package of Measures have agreed on the need for this safe and secure access, that restriction of the SMM's freedom of movement constitutes a violation, and on the need for rapid response to these violations. They have also agreed that the Joint Centre for Control and Co-ordination should contribute to such response and co-ordinate mine clearance. Nonetheless, the armed formations in

parts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions frequently deny the SMM access to areas adjacent to Ukraine's border outside control of the Government (for example, see below). The SMM's operations in Donetsk and Luhansk regions remain restricted following the fatal incident of 23 April 2017 near Pryshyb; these restrictions continued to limit the Mission's observations.

Denial of access:

- At a checkpoint west of Bezimenne (non-government-controlled, 100km south of Donetsk), a member of the armed formations <u>again</u> denied the SMM passage westwards, citing "risk of shelling in the area". While at the checkpoint, the Mission saw vehicular traffic proceeding through both ways.

Regular restrictions related to disengagement areas and mines/UXO:

- The sides continued to deny the SMM full access, as well as the ability to travel certain roads previously identified as important for effective monitoring by the Mission and for civilians' movement, through failure to conduct comprehensive clearance of mines, UXO and other obstacles.

Other impediments:

 On 4 March, an SMM long-range UAV experienced signal interference, assessed as probable jamming, while flying over non-government-controlled areas between Vasylivka (65km south-east of Donetsk) and Hlynka (60km south-east of Donetsk).


