
Daily Report 74/2020

28 March 2020¹

Summary

- Compared with the previous reporting period, the SMM recorded fewer ceasefire violations in Donetsk region and more in Luhansk region.
- The Mission continued monitoring the disengagement areas near Stanytsia Luhanska, Zolote and Petrivske.
- The SMM saw that the entry-exit checkpoints near Maiorsk, Marinka and Stanytsia Luhanska and several checkpoints of the armed formations in both Donetsk and Luhansk regions remained closed.
- The Mission facilitated and monitored adherence to localized ceasefires to enable demining activities near Krasnyi Yar, as well as construction of a power line near Maiorsk.
- The SMM received information that the Donetsk Filtration Station had resumed its operations on 28 March.
- Restrictions of the SMM's freedom of movement continued, including at a checkpoint of the armed formations south of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge and another one near Marynivka, close to a border area outside government control.*

Ceasefire violations²





In Donetsk region, the SMM recorded fewer ceasefire violations, including fewer explosions (13), compared with the <u>previous reporting period</u> (about 50 explosions). The majority of the ceasefire violations, including the majority of explosions, were recorded at westerly and northerly directions of non-government-controlled Donetsk city and at northerly directions of Shyrokyne (government-controlled, 100km south of Donetsk).

In Luhansk region, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations, however fewer explosions (about 25), compared with the <u>previous reporting period</u> (about 60 explosions). The majority of ceasefire violations were recorded at southerly directions of Kriakivka (government-controlled, 38km north-west of Luhansk) and in areas north-east of the disengagement area near Zolote (government-controlled, 60km west of Luhansk).

Disengagement areas near Stanytsia Luhanska, Zolote and Petrivske⁵

On the morning of 27 March, while on the eastern edge of Stanytsia Luhanska (government-controlled, 16km north-east of Luhansk), the SMM heard an undetermined explosion at an assessed range of 4km south, assessed as outside the **disengagement area near Stanytsia Luhanska** but within 5km of its periphery. Throughout the day on 27 March, inside the disengagement area, the SMM saw five members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) between the new span of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge (15km north-east of Luhansk) and their checkpoint south of it.

On 26 March, an SMM mid-range unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) spotted two infantry fighting vehicles (IFV) (BMP-2) about 200m north of the **disengagement area near Zolote**. On the evening and night of 26-27 March, the SMM camera in Zolote recorded six undetermined explosions and nine projectiles in flight, all at an assessed range of 1-6km east and east-north-east. On the morning of 27 March, at two locations near the disengagement area, the SMM heard two undetermined explosions and about 90 bursts of heavy-machinegun and 30mm cannon fire. All of the above ceasefire violations were assessed as outside the disengagement area near Zolote but within 5km of its periphery. Throughout the day on 27 March, the SMM saw three members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) near the southern edge of the disengagement area.

On 27 March, positioned close to the **disengagement area near Petrivske** (non-government-controlled, 41km south of Donetsk), the Mission observed a calm situation.

Withdrawal of weapons

The SMM continued to monitor the withdrawal of weapons in implementation of the Memorandum and the Package of Measures and its Addendum.

Indications of military and military-type presence in the security zone⁶

The Mission observed armoured combat vehicles on both sides of the contact line, some of which placed near residential areas (for further details, see the table below).

About 3km south-east of Dovhe (non-government-controlled, 22km north-west of Luhansk), the SMM saw nine members of the armed formations reinforcing a previously observed military-type position, about 25m south of road P-66.

Anti-personnel mine near Molodizhne

About 2.5km south-west of Molodizhne (non-government-controlled, 63km west of Luhansk), about 10m north of road T-0504, the SMM <u>again</u> saw an anti-personnel mine (MON-200), assessed as belonging to the armed formations.

Preventive measures against COVID-19 outbreak

The SMM noted that the entry-exit checkpoints (EECP) near Maiorsk (government-controlled, 45km north-east of Donetsk), Marinka (government-controlled, 23km south-west of Donetsk) and Stanytsia Luhanska, as well as the checkpoints of the armed formations 200m south of Stanytsia Luhanska bridge and east of Kreminets (non-government-controlled, 16km south-west of Donetsk) remained closed.

At a checkpoint north of the border crossing point near Marynivka (non-government-controlled, 78km east of Donetsk), two members of the armed formations denied the SMM passage, citing "quarantine-related measures" (see below).* At the same checkpoint, a member of the armed formations told the SMM that medical checks were being conducted at the border crossing point.

At a checkpoint 200m south of Stanytsia Luhanska bridge, a member of the armed formations denied the SMM passage towards non-government-controlled areas, citing "orders from superiors".*

At a border crossing point near Uspenka (non-government-controlled, 73km south-east of Donetsk), the SMM saw members of the armed formation wearing personal protection equipment, such as medical masks, to cover their faces.

SMM facilitation of repairs to critical civilian infrastructure and demining activities

The Mission facilitated and monitored adherence to localized ceasefires to enable the construction of new power lines near Maiorsk, as well as demining activities near Krasnyi Yar (non-government-controlled, 12km north-east of Luhansk).

On 27 March, positioned in Yasynuvata (non-government-controlled, 16km north-east of Donetsk), at around 9:00, the SMM monitored the transit of *Voda Donbassa* water company employees from Yasynuvata towards the pumping station near Vasylivka (non-government-controlled, 20km north of Donetsk). The same day, at 9:20, the Mission received information about the safe return from the pumping station to Yasynuvata of other *Voda Donbassa* employees who had been covering the night shift during the previous night. Outside the reporting period, on 28 March, the SMM received information that the Donetsk Filtration Station had resumed its operations the same day, after their suspension on 25 March (see SMM Daily Report 72/2020 for additional information).

Border areas outside government control

On 25 March, aerial imagery available to the SMM revealed the presence of four probable military-type trucks near Oleksiivske (non-government-controlled, 74km east of Donetsk), in an area about 3.5km west of the border where there are no border crossing facilities.

On 27 March, while at a border crossing point near Uspenka for about 35 minutes, the SMM saw six cars (two with Ukrainian and two with Russian Federation licence plates, as well as two with "DPR" plates), one bus with "DPR" plates, and 13 pedestrians (mixed ages and genders) entering Ukraine. The SMM also saw three cars (one with Ukrainian and one with Russian Federation licence plates, as well as one with "DPR" plates), six covered cargo trucks (one with Ukrainian licence plates and five with "DPR" plates) and six pedestrians (mixed ages and genders) exiting Ukraine.

The Mission continued monitoring in Kherson, Odessa, Lviv, Ivano-Frankivsk, Kharkiv, Dnipro, Chernivtsi and Kyiv.

*Restrictions of the SMM's freedom of movement or other impediments to fulfilment of its mandate

The SMM's monitoring and freedom of movement are restricted by security hazards and threats, including risks posed by mines, unexploded ordnance (UXO) and other impediments — which vary from day to day. The SMM's mandate provides for safe and secure access throughout Ukraine. All signatories of the Package of Measures have agreed on the need for this safe and secure access, that restriction of the SMM's freedom of movement constitutes a violation, and on the need for rapid response to these violations. They have also agreed that the Joint Centre for Control and Coordination (JCCC) should contribute to such response and co-ordinate mine clearance. Nonetheless, the armed formations in parts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions frequently deny the SMM access to areas adjacent to Ukraine's border outside control of the Government (for example see below). The SMM's operations in Donetsk and Luhansk regions remain restricted following the fatal incident of 23 April 2017 near Pryshyb; these restrictions continued to limit the Mission's observations.

Denial of access:

- At a checkpoint north of a border crossing point near Marynivka (non-government-controlled, 78km east of Donetsk), two members of the armed formations denied the SMM passage, citing "quarantine measures".
- At a checkpoint 200m south of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge (15km north-east of Luhansk), a member of the armed formations denied the SMM passage towards government-controlled areas, citing "orders from superiors".

Regular restrictions related to disengagement areas and mines/UXO:

- The sides continued to deny the SMM full access, as well as the ability to travel certain roads previously identified as important for effective monitoring by the Mission and for civilians' movement, through failure to conduct comprehensive clearance of mines, UXO and other obstacles.



When information is not known (indicated with an "N/K"), the SMM was unable to ascertain such information due to distance, weather conditions technical limitations and/or other considerations. Ceasefire violations recorded by more than one patrol/camera and assessed to be the same are entered only once.
