

Daily Report 105/2020

4 May 2020¹

Summary


- Compared with the previous reporting period, between the evenings of 1 and 2 May, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations in both Donetsk and Luhansk regions.
- Between the evenings of 2 and 3 May, the Mission recorded fewer ceasefire violations in both Donetsk and Luhansk regions, compared with the previous 24 hours.
- Explosions occurred near the SMM in Zolote-5/Mykhailivka and Sentianivka, Luhansk region.
- Gunfire was assessed as aimed at SMM mini-unmanned aerial vehicles flying near Donetsk city and Popasna.
- In Donetsk region, the Mission followed up on reports of a woman who was killed by gunfire in Spartak and saw damage to civilian properties in Holmivskyi.
- Members of the armed formations continued to deny the SMM passage at checkpoints along official crossing routes in Donetsk and Luhansk regions.*
- The Mission continued monitoring the disengagement areas near Stanytsia Luhanska, Zolote and Petrivske.
- The SMM continued following up on the situation of civilians amid the COVID-19 outbreak, including at entry-exit checkpoints and their corresponding checkpoints in Donetsk and Luhansk regions.
- The SMM's freedom of movement continued to be restricted in both Donetsk and Luhansk regions, including at checkpoints of the armed formations near Bessarabka and Novoazovsk.*



Number of recorded explosions⁴







In Donetsk region, between the evenings of 1 and 2 May, the SMM recorded more than a four-fold increase in the number of ceasefire violations, including more explosions (about 415), compared with the <u>previous reporting period</u> (about 160 explosions). Most ceasefire violations, including most explosions, were recorded in areas north-west of Horlivka (non-government-controlled, 39km north-east of Donetsk).

Between the evenings of 2 and 3 May, the Mission recorded fewer ceasefire violations, including fewer explosions (about 40), compared with the previous 24 hours. The majority of ceasefire violations were recorded at northerly directions of Shyrokyne (government-controlled, 100km south of Donetsk) and in areas south-east of Avdiivka (government-controlled, 17km north of Donetsk).

In Luhansk region, between the evenings of 1 and 2 May, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations, including about twice the amount of explosions (about 375), compared with the <u>previous reporting period</u> (about 190 explosions). Most ceasefire violations, including most explosions, were recorded at northerly and easterly directions of Popasna (government-controlled, 69km west of Luhansk) and close to the disengagement area near Zolote (government-controlled, 60km west of Luhansk) (see below).

Between the evenings of 2 and 3 May, the Mission recorded fewer ceasefire violations, including fewer explosions (60), compared with the previous 24 hours. The majority of ceasefire violations were recorded in areas south-west of Kriakivka (government-controlled, 38km north-west of Luhansk) and at easterly directions of the disengagement area near Zolote (see below).

Woman killed by gunfire in non-government-controlled Spartak

On 2 May, staff of a morgue in non-government-controlled Donetsk city told the SMM that on 1 May, the body of a 67-year-old woman with a fatal bullet injury to her chest had been brought to the facility. A man (in his sixties), who introduced himself as the husband of the deceased woman, told the Mission that on 1 May, his wife had sustained fatal injuries from gunfire while she was in the garden of their house at 18 Chapaieva Street in Spartak (non-government-controlled, 9km north of Donetsk). A local resident (woman in her fifties) said that on 1 May, she had been at her house in Spartak, about 150m from the victim, when she heard bursts of gunfire and saw the woman get hit, after which she had called for an ambulance that had transported the victim to a hospital in Donetsk city.

Damage to civilian properties in non-government-controlled Holmivskyi

On 2 May, at 24 Arenskoho Street in Holmivskyi (non-government-controlled, 49km northeast of Donetsk), the SMM saw a hole in the east-facing side of the roof of a one-storey annex of an inhabited house. About 10m north, the Mission saw damage to slates on the eastern side of the asbestos roof of a one-storey inhabited house. The SMM was unable to assess the cause of damage or if it was recent. A man and a woman (in their sixties) told the Mission that their house and an annex to the house had sustained damage from shelling that occurred on 1 May.

At 28 Antonova Street, the Mission saw two holes in a minivan parked inside the courtyard of an inhabited house. A resident of the house (woman in her sixties) told the SMM that the vehicle had been hit by an unknown object in the early morning of 1 May. The SMM was unable to assess the cause of the damage or if it was recent.

Gunfire assessed as directed at SMM mini-UAVs in Donetsk city and Popasna, and explosions near the SMM in Zolote-5/Mykhailiyka and Sentianiyka

On 2 May, while positioned on the northern edge of Donetsk city's Kuibyshevskyi district (non-government-controlled, 5km west of Donetsk city centre) to conduct a mini-unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) flight, the SMM heard nine rounds of heavy-machine-gun fire at an assessed distance of 500m north, assessed as targeting its UAV, which was flying about 500m north-north-west.

On the same day, while positioned on the north-eastern edge of Popasna to conduct a mini-UAV flight, the Mission heard 40 shots of small-arms fire at an assessed distance of about 1.5km south-east, assessed as targeting its UAV, which was flying about 1.5km south-east. On both occasions, the SMM safely recovered its UAVs and left the area.*

On 2 May, while positioned on the southern edge of Zolote-5/Mykhailivka (non-government-controlled, 58km west of Luhansk), the SMM heard an undetermined explosion at an assessed range of 300-400m north-west. The SMM immediately left the area.*

On 3 May, while positioned at the same location to facilitate infrastructural repairs, the SMM heard an undetermined explosion at an assessed distance of 300m north-east. The SMM immediately left the area.*

On 3 May, while positioned in Sentianivka (formerly Frunze, non-government-controlled, 44km west of Luhansk), the Mission saw an impact from an undetermined weapon system at an assessed range of 1-2km north. Shortly after, it heard an outgoing explosion at an assessed distance of 50m north and felt a successive shockwave coming from the same direction. The SMM immediately left the area.*

Members of the armed formations continued to deny the SMM passage at checkpoints along the contact line in Donetsk and Luhansk regions

Members of the armed formations continued to deny the SMM passage at checkpoints in both Donetsk and Luhansk regions along official crossing routes. These restrictions constitute an impediment to the implementation of the Mission's mandate.⁵

In Donetsk region, on 2 May, at a checkpoint near Horlivka, an SMM patrol <u>again</u> waited unsuccessfully for members of the armed formations to remove a road barrier to allow the SMM passage towards non-government-controlled areas. On the same day, at a checkpoint west of Verkhnoshyrokivske (formerly Oktiabr, non-government-controlled, 85km south of Donetsk), an SMM patrol travelling from government-controlled areas <u>again</u> saw three antitank mines on a wooden plank near the checkpoint, in the middle of the road leading towards Verkhnoshyrokivske. Members of the armed formations declined to speak to the SMM. On 3 May, on two occasions at a checkpoint near Olenivka (non-government-controlled, 23km south-west of Donetsk), members of the armed formations denied the SMM passage towards government- and non-government-controlled areas, respectively, stating that "the SMM did not have permission to pass" and referring to the closure of the checkpoint due to COVID-19.*

In Luhansk region, at a checkpoint south of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge (15km north-east of Luhansk), a member of the armed formations denied the SMM passage towards government-controlled areas on 2 May and towards non-government-controlled areas on 3 May, referring to the closure of the checkpoint due to COVID-19. A member of the armed formations added that the Mission would also not be allowed passage in the opposite direction.*

Disengagement areas near Stanytsia Luhanska, Zolote and Petrivske⁶

On 2 and 3 May, inside the **disengagement area near Stanytsia Luhanska** (government-controlled, 16km north-east of Luhansk), the SMM saw members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) near their checkpoint south of the new span of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge. During the day on 2 May, while positioned in Stanytsia Luhanska, the Mission heard an undetermined explosion at an assessed range of 3-5km east-south-east, assessed as outside the area but within 5km of its periphery.

On the evening of 1 May, inside the **disengagement area near Zolote**, an SMM long-range UAV spotted a person near a former position of the armed formations about 200m south of the railway tracks and 2km west of road T-1316.

On the night between 1 and 2 May, the SMM camera in Zolote recorded about 40 undetermined explosions, about 30 projectiles in flight and an illumination flare, all at an assessed range of 4-6km east. During the day on 2 May, while positioned in four locations close to the disengagement area, the SMM heard about 270 undetermined explosions and about 85 shots and bursts of small-arms and heavy-machine-gun fire. On the night between 2 and 3 May, the SMM camera in Zolote recorded about 20 undetermined explosions, about 30 projectiles in flight and a muzzle flash, all at an assessed range of 2-4km east. On 3 May, while positioned at six locations close to the disengagement area, the SMM heard 16 undetermined explosions and three bursts of heavy-machine-gun fire. All these ceasefire violations were assessed as outside the disengagement area but within 5km of its periphery.

On 2 and 3 May, the SMM saw members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) near the southern edge of the disengagement area.

On 2 May, while positioned about 2km east of Bohdanivka (government-controlled, 41km south-west of Donetsk), the SMM heard nine undetermined explosions at an assessed range of 2-4km north-east and north-west, all assessed as outside **the disengagement area near Petrivske** (non-government-controlled, 41km south of Donetsk) but within 5km of its periphery.

On the night between 2 and 3 May, the SMM camera in Bohdanivka recorded an undetermined explosion at an assessed range of 4-6km south-east and assessed as outside the disengagement area but within 5km of its periphery.

On 3 May, while positioned at three locations close to the disengagement area, the Mission observed a calm situation.

Withdrawal of weapons

The SMM continued to monitor the withdrawal of weapons in implementation of the Memorandum and the Package of Measures and its Addendum. In Luhansk region, it saw a surface-to-air missile system within a government-controlled residential area and probable towed howitzers in a non-government-controlled area, all in violation of withdrawal lines.

It also saw self-propelled howitzers beyond withdrawal lines but outside designated storage sites at a railway station in a government-controlled area of Donetsk region (for details, see the tables below).

Indications of military and military-type presence inside the security zone⁷

The SMM observed armoured combat vehicles in the security zone in government-controlled areas of Donetsk and Luhansk regions, including in residential areas (for further details, see the table below).

SMM facilitation of operation of critical civilian infrastructure

On 2 and 3 May, the SMM continued to facilitate the operation of the Donetsk Filtration Station (DFS) (15km north of Donetsk). On 2 May, while positioned at two locations near the station, the Mission heard three undetermined explosions and shots of small-arms fire. On 3 May, positioned at two locations near the station, the SMM heard three undetermined explosions and shots of small-arms fire. All these ceasefire violations were assessed as within a 5km radius of the DFS (see the table below).

Measures taken at entry-exit checkpoints and corresponding checkpoints to counter COVID-19 outbreak

In Donetsk region, on 2 May, the SMM noted that the entry-exit checkpoints (EECP) near Maiorsk (government-controlled, 45km north-east of Donetsk) and Hnutove (government-controlled, 90km south of Donetsk), as well as the corresponding checkpoints of the armed formations near Horlivka and near Verkhnoshyrokivske, remained closed. On 3 May, the Mission noted that the EECP near Novotroitske (government-controlled, 36km south-west of Donetsk) and the corresponding checkpoint near Olenivka remained closed.*

On 2 May, at the EECP near Hnutove, the SMM saw a man (in his thirties) on a bicycle who was prevented from travelling towards non-government-controlled areas by representatives of the Border Guard Service of Ukraine. He told the SMM that he had been attempting to travel to non-government-controlled areas, where he had left his two children with his parents.

In Luhansk region, on 2 and 3 May, the SMM saw that the EECP in Stanytsia Luhanska and the corresponding checkpoint of the armed formations south of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge remained closed.*

On 2 May, the SMM saw a coffin being transported on a small trailer by funeral service representatives through the EECP in Stanytsia Luhanska towards non-government-controlled areas and, shortly after, it saw the same individuals travelling back with another

coffin from non-government-controlled areas. The Mission also saw two boys (aged seven and eight) travelling towards government-controlled areas, where family members had been waiting for them.

Border areas outside government control

On 2 May, while at a border crossing point near Novoazovsk (102km south-east of Donetsk) for about 25 minutes, the SMM observed no cross-border traffic.

Commemoration events for those who lost their lives during the events of 2 May 2014

On 2 May, at Kulykove Pole Square in Odessa, the SMM saw about 100 people (mixed ages and genders) attending a ceremony to commemorate those who lost their lives during the events of 2 May 2014. After the hour-long ceremony, the Mission saw that the square was closed-off for disinfection. About 500 police officers were present throughout the day securing the event.

On the same day, the SMM saw about ten members of the "Right Sector" (men, aged 20-50) gathered near Soborna Square in Odessa to commemorate the death of two activists during the events of 2 May 2014. About 30 police officers secured the gathering, which dispersed peacefully.

The Mission continued monitoring in Kherson, Lviv, Ivano-Frankivsk, Kharkiv, Dnipro, Chernivtsi and Kyiv.

*Restrictions of the SMM's freedom of movement or other impediments to fulfilment of its mandate

The SMM's monitoring and freedom of movement are restricted by security hazards and threats, including risks posed by mines and unexploded ordnance (UXO) and other impediments — which vary from day to day. The SMM's mandate provides for safe and secure access throughout Ukraine. All signatories of the Package of Measures have agreed on the need for this safe and secure access, that restriction of the SMM's freedom of movement constitutes a violation, and on the need for rapid response to these violations. They have also agreed that the Joint Centre for Control and Coordination (JCCC) should contribute to such response and co-ordinate mine clearance. Nonetheless, the armed formations in parts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions frequently deny the SMM access to areas adjacent to Ukraine's border outside control of the Government (for example, see SMM Daily Report 28 March 2020). The SMM's operations in Donetsk and Luhansk regions remain restricted following the fatal incident of 23 April 2017 near Pryshyb; these restrictions continued to limit the Mission's observations.

Denial of access:

- On 2 and 3 May, at a checkpoint south of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge (15km northeast of Luhansk), a member of the armed formations <u>again</u> denied the SMM passage towards government- and non-government-controlled areas, respectively, referring to the closure of the checkpoint due to COVID-19.
- On 2 May, at a checkpoint near Horlivka (non-government-controlled, 39km southwest of Donetsk), an SMM patrol <u>again</u> waited unsuccessfully for about 20 minutes

- for members of the armed formations to remove a road barrier to allow the SMM passage towards non-government-controlled areas.
- On 2 May, at a checkpoint west of Verkhnoshyrokivske (formerly Oktiabr, non-government-controlled, 85km south of Donetsk), an SMM patrol travelling from government-controlled areas again saw three anti-tank mines on a wooden plank near the checkpoint, in the middle of the road leading towards Verkhnoshyrokivske. Members of the armed formations declined to speak to the SMM. On 3 May, on two occasions at a checkpoint near Olenivka (non-government-controlled, 23km south-west of Donetsk), members of the armed formations again denied the SMM passage towards government- and non-government-controlled areas, respectively, stating that "the SMM did not have permission to pass" and referring to the closure of the checkpoint due to COVID-19.

Regular restrictions related to disengagement areas and mines/UXO:

- The sides continued to deny the SMM full access, as well as the ability to travel certain roads previously identified as important for effective monitoring by the Mission and for civilians' movement, through failure to conduct comprehensive clearance of mines, UXO and other obstacles.

Delay:

- On 2 May, at a checkpoint north-west of Bessarabka (non-government-controlled, 85km south of Donetsk), two armed members of the armed formations allowed the SMM to proceed after about 30 minutes of waiting.

Conditional access:

- On 2 May, at a checkpoint north-east of Novoazovsk (non-government-controlled, 102km south-east of Donetsk), two members of the armed formations escorted the SMM to the hospital and back to the checkpoint.

Other impediments:

- On 1 May, an SMM long-range UAV experienced GPS signal interference, assessed as caused by probable jamming, while flying over areas between Zolote-4/Rodina (government-controlled, 57km west of Luhansk) and Fashchivka (non-government-controlled, 60km south-west of Luhansk).8
- On 2 May, while conducting a mini-UAV flight over areas north of Donetsk city's Kuibyshevskyi district (non-government-controlled, 5km west of Donetsk city centre) and north-east of Popasna (government-controlled, 69km west of Luhansk), the SMM heard heavy-machine-gun rounds and shots of small-arms fire assessed as aimed at its UAVs (see above).
- On 2 and 3 May, while positioned south of Zolote-5/Mykhailivka (non-government-controlled, 58km west of Luhansk), the SMM heard undetermined explosions about 300-400m north-west and 300m north-east of its position, respectively, after which it left the area (see above).
- On 3 May, while positioned in Sentianivka (formerly Frunze, non-government-controlled, 44km west of Luhansk), the Mission saw an explosion at an assessed

- range of 1-2km north and heard an explosion 50m north of its position, after which it left the area (see above).
- On 3 May, an SMM mini-UAV experienced GPS signal interference, assessed as caused by probable jamming, while flying over areas near Lebedynske (government-controlled, 99km south of Donetsk).


