
6 May 2020¹

Summary

- Compared with the previous reporting period, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations in Donetsk region, including a spike in areas west of Donetsk city, and fewer in Luhansk region.
- An SMM patrol heard five explosions assessed as mortar rounds while positioned close to a checkpoint of the armed formations near Olenivka, Donetsk region.*
- The SMM saw shelling damage to three residential houses in Oleksandrivka.
- Members of the armed formations continued to deny the SMM passage at checkpoints along official crossing routes in Donetsk and Luhansk regions.*
- The Mission continued monitoring the disengagement areas near Stanytsia Luhanska, Zolote and Petrivske.
- It monitored and facilitated adherence to localised ceasefires to enable repairs to critical civilian infrastructure in non-government-controlled areas of Donetsk region.
- The SMM continued following up on measures taken amid the COVID-19 outbreak, including at entry-exit checkpoints and their corresponding checkpoints in Donetsk and Luhansk regions.
- The SMM's freedom of movement continued to be restricted in both Donetsk and Luhansk regions.*

Number of recorded ceasefire violations³ Number of recorded explosions⁴





In Donetsk region, the SMM recorded more ceasefire violations, including, however, fewer explosions (about 70), compared with the <u>previous reporting period</u> (about 100 explosions). The majority of ceasefire violations were recorded at westerly directions of Donetsk city, including over 2,100 projectiles recorded at westerly directions of the Oktiabr mine (non-government-controlled, 9km north-west of Donetsk city centre).

In Luhansk region, the SMM recorded fewer ceasefire violations, including fewer explosions (about 40), compared with the <u>previous reporting period</u> (about 70 explosions). More than two-thirds of ceasefire violations, including the majority of explosions (some of which were artillery rounds), were recorded in areas west of the disengagement area near Zolote (government-controlled, 60km west of Luhansk).

Explosions assessed as caused by mortar rounds near SMM patrol close to a checkpoint near Olenivka

On 5 May, while positioned at a checkpoint of the armed formations in Olenivka (non-government-controlled, 23km south-west of Donetsk), an SMM patrol comprising four members, tasked to transfer one member to government-controlled areas, heard five outgoing artillery rounds assessed as caused by a mortar at an undetermined distance nearby and heard the subsequent explosions (and felt the shockwaves) at an assessed distance of 300-400m west-north-west of its position. The patrol immediately left the area.*

Damage from shelling to three residential houses in Oleksandrivka

The SMM followed up on reports of damage from shelling to residential houses in the south-eastern part of Oleksandrivka (non-government-controlled, 20km south-west of Donetsk).

At 368A Horkoho Street, the Mission saw that a window in the south-west facing outer brick wall of an inhabited one-storey house was partially shattered and that the window frame had split and there was a hole (about 40cm in diameter) next to the window. It also saw that another west-facing window was shattered and that there were several holes in a plastic roof above the windows. A woman (in her sixties), who introduced herself as a relative of the house, owner told the Mission that on the afternoon of 4 May, an explosion had occurred in front of the house.

About 30m south of the previous house, at 305A Shevchenka Street, the Mission saw a hole (about 3cm in diameter) in a south-west facing window of a one-storey inhabited house about 30m south of the abovementioned house. A man (in his twenties), who introduced himself as the owner of the house, told the SMM that on 4 May at around 4:30 pm he had been inside the house with a friend when they heard five loud explosions.

About 30m west of the previous house, at 303B Shevchenka Street, the Mission saw a hole (about 5cm in diameter) in the south-facing side and another hole (about 35cm in diameter) in the north-facing side of the roof of a one-storey inhabited house. A woman (in her late sixties), who introduced herself as the owner of the house, told the SMM that on 4 May at around 4:30 pm she had been at home and heard three or four loud explosions.

The SMM assessed all of the abovementioned damage as fresh but could not determine the type of weapons used.

Members of the armed formations continued to deny the SMM passage at checkpoints along the contact line in Donetsk and Luhansk regions

Members of the armed formations continued to deny the SMM passage at checkpoints in both Donetsk and Luhansk regions along official crossing routes. These restrictions constitute an impediment to the implementation of the Mission's mandate.⁵

In Donetsk region, on 5 May, at a checkpoint near Verkhnoshyrokivske (formerly Oktiabr, non-government-controlled, 85km south of Donetsk), a member of the armed formations denied the SMM passage towards non-government-controlled areas, referring to quarantine measures *

At a checkpoint south-west of Olenivka, two armed members of the armed formations prevented an SMM patrol member from proceeding towards government-controlled areas, referring to notification requirements.*

In Luhansk region, at a checkpoint south of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge (15km north-east of Luhansk), a member of the armed formations denied the SMM passage towards non-government-controlled areas, referring to the closure of the checkpoint due to COVID-19. He added that the Mission would also not be allowed passage in the opposite direction.*

Disengagement areas near Stanytsia Luhanska, Zolote and Petrivske⁶

During the day on 5 May, the SMM noted a calm situation in the **disengagement area near Stanytsia Luhanska** (government-controlled, 16km north-east of Luhansk) and saw two members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) near their checkpoint south of the new span of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge.

On the evening and night between 4 and 5 May, the SMM camera in Zolote recorded four undetermined explosions at an assessed range of 4-8km east and east-south-east, assessed as outside **the disengagement area near Zolote** but within 5km of its periphery.

On 5 May, while positioned at one location inside and two locations near the disengagement area, the SMM recorded 18 undetermined explosions, all of which were assessed as outside the disengagement area but within 5km of its periphery. On the same day, the SMM saw seven members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) near the southern edge of the disengagement area.

On 5 May, while positioned about 2km east of Bohdanivka (government-controlled, 41km south-west of Donetsk), the SMM heard five shots and bursts of small-arms fire at an assessed distance of 3km south-east, assessed as outside **the disengagement area near Petrivske** (non-government-controlled, 41km south of Donetsk) but within 5km of its periphery.

On 4 May, inside the disengagement area, about 800m south of its northern edge, an SMM mini-unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) again spotted about 40 anti-tank mines (probable TM-62) (for previous observations in the area, see SMM Daily Report 7 February 2020). Outside the disengagement area, on the southern edge of Petrivske, the same UAV spotted about 40 previously reported anti-tank mines (probable TM-62). All of these mines were assessed as belonging to the armed formations.

Withdrawal of weapons

The SMM continued to monitor the withdrawal of weapons in implementation of the Memorandum and the Package of Measures and its Addendum.

Presence of anti-tank mines and mine hazard signs

On 2 May, an SMM mini-UAV <u>again</u> spotted ten anti-tank mines, assessed as belonging to the armed formations, on a road between Holmivskyi (non-government-controlled, 49km north-east of Donetsk) and Travneve (government-controlled, 51km north-east of Donetsk).

On the same day, on the north-eastern edge of Popasna (government-controlled, 69km west of Luhansk), an SMM mini-UAV spotted about 300 anti-tank mines (probable TM-62) in a field about 25m south of road T-0504, all of which were assessed as belonging to the Ukrainian Armed Forces and not recently laid (for previous observations in the area, see SMM Daily Reports of 5 April 2018 and 20 April 2020).

On 4 May, an SMM mini-UAV <u>again</u> spotted an anti-tank mine (TM-83) in a field about 25m east of road C-051532, between Styla (non-government-controlled, 34km south of Donetsk) and Petrivske.

On 4 May, about 2km south-west of Travneve, an SMM mini-UAV spotted for the first time a probable mine hazard sign next to a local road.

On 5 May, at a checkpoint of the armed formations west of Verkhnoshyrokivske, the SMM <u>again</u> saw three anti-tank mines attached to a board and laid across a road leading to Pyshchevyk (government-controlled, 84km south of Donetsk).

On a road leading to a cemetery on the south-eastern edge of Chermalyk (government-controlled, 77km south of Donetsk), the Mission <u>again</u> saw wooden planks with a mine hazard sign attached to them blocking passage.

SMM facilitation of repairs to and operation of critical civilian infrastructure

The SMM facilitated and monitored adherence to localised ceasefires to enable repairs to water pipelines near Holmivskyi and Horlivka (non-government-controlled, 39km northeast of Donetsk).

The SMM continued to facilitate the operation of the Donetsk Filtration Station (DFS). On 5 May, while positioned near the station, the Mission recorded an explosion and about 25 shots and bursts of small-arms and heavy-machine-gun fire. All these ceasefire violations were assessed as within a 5km radius of the DFS (see the table below).

Border areas outside government control

While at a border crossing point near Uspenka (73km south-east of Donetsk) for about 30 minutes, the Mission saw 20 pedestrians (mixed genders and ages) entering Ukraine.

The SMM noted that the border crossing point near Ulianivske (61km south-east of Donetsk) was closed and that there were no members of the armed formations on-site.

Measures taken at entry-exit checkpoints and corresponding checkpoints to counter COVID-19 outbreak

In Donetsk region, the Mission noted that the entry-exit checkpoint (EECP) near Hnutove (government-controlled, 90km south of Donetsk), as well the corresponding checkpoint of the armed formations near Verkhnoshyrokivske, remained closed.*

In Luhansk region, the SMM saw that the EECP in Stanytsia Luhanska and the corresponding checkpoint of the armed formations south of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge remained closed.*

On the southern outskirts of Kadiivka (formerly Stakhanov, non-government-controlled, 50km west of Luhansk), on the western outskirts of Brianka (non-government-controlled, 46km south-west of Luhansk) and about 7km north-west of Alchevsk (non-government-controlled, 40km west of Luhansk), the Mission saw new checkpoints of the armed formations, assessed as having been set up as part of COVID-19 countermeasures, which the Mission was able to pass through without delay.

The Mission continued monitoring in Kherson, Odessa, Lviv, Ivano-Frankivsk, Kharkiv, Chernivtsi, Dnipro and Kyiv.

*Restrictions of the SMM's freedom of movement or other impediments to fulfilment of its mandate

The SMM's monitoring and freedom of movement are restricted by security hazards and threats, including risks posed by mines and unexploded ordnance (UXO) and other impediments — which vary from day to day. The SMM's mandate provides for safe and secure access throughout Ukraine. All signatories of the Package of Measures have agreed on the need for this safe and secure access, that restriction of the SMM's freedom of movement constitutes a violation, and on the need for rapid response to these violations. They have also agreed that the Joint Centre for Control and Coordination (JCCC) should contribute to such response and co-ordinate mine clearance. Nonetheless, the armed formations in parts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions frequently deny the SMM access to areas adjacent to Ukraine's border outside control of the Government (for example, see SMM Daily Report 28 March 2020). The SMM's operations in Donetsk and Luhansk regions remain restricted following the fatal incident of 23 April 2017 near Pryshyb; these restrictions continued to limit the Mission's observations.

Denial of access:

- At a checkpoint south of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge (15km north-east of Luhansk), a member of the armed formations again denied the SMM passage towards non-government-controlled areas, referring to the closure of the checkpoint due to COVID-19 and saying that the Mission would also be denied passage in the opposite direction.
- At a checkpoint near Verkhnoshyrokivske (formerly Oktiabr, non-government-controlled, 85km south of Donetsk), a member of the armed formations denied the SMM passage towards non-government-controlled areas, referring to quarantine restrictions due to COVID-19.
- At a checkpoint south-west of Olenivka (non-government-controlled, 23km south-west of Donetsk), two armed members of the armed formations denied an SMM patrol member passage towards government-controlled areas, referring to notification requirements.*

Regular restrictions related to disengagement areas and mines/UXO:

- The sides continued to deny the SMM full access, as well as the ability to travel certain roads previously identified as important for effective monitoring by the Mission and for civilians' movement, through failure to conduct comprehensive clearance of mines, UXO and other obstacles.

Other impediments:

- An SMM mini-UAV experienced GPS signal interference, assessed as caused by probable jamming, while flying over areas near Bohdanivka (government-controlled, 41km south-west of Donetsk), close to the disengagement area near Petrivske.⁷
- An SMM mini-UAV experienced GPS signal interference, assessed as caused by probable jamming, while flying over areas near Oleksandropillia (government-controlled, 71km west of Luhansk).8


