
25 May 2020¹

Summary

- Compared with the previous reporting period, between the evenings of 22 and 23 May, the Mission recorded a similar number of ceasefire violations in Donetsk region and fewer in Luhansk region.
- Between the evenings of 23 and 24 May, the Mission recorded a similar number of ceasefire violations in Donetsk region and more in Luhansk region, compared with the previous 24 hours.
- The SMM followed up on reports of a woman who sustained shrapnel injuries on 7 April in Marinka, Donetsk region.
- Members of the armed formations continued to deny the Mission passage at checkpoints along official crossing routes in Donetsk and Luhansk regions.*
- The Mission continued monitoring the disengagement areas near Stanytsia Luhanska, Zolote and Petrivske. Inside the disengagement area near Petrivske, it recorded ceasefire violations and spotted during evening hours persons inside a former position of the armed formations.
- The SMM saw weapons in violation of withdrawal lines, including in training areas in non-government-controlled areas of Donetsk region.
- The Mission continued following up on measures taken amid the COVID-19 outbreak, including at entry-exit checkpoints and their corresponding checkpoints in Donetsk and Luhansk regions.
- The Mission monitored a peaceful gathering in Odessa during which participants were expressing messages critical of the Government.
- The Mission's freedom of movement continued to be restricted, including at checkpoints of the armed formations in Prymorske and near Shevchenko and Bessarabka, all in southern Donetsk region.*


Ceasefire violations²

In Donetsk region, between the evenings of 22 and 23 May, the SMM recorded a similar number of ceasefire violations, including, however, fewer explosions (about 70), compared with the <u>previous reporting period</u> (about 220 explosions). The majority of ceasefire violations were recorded in areas north-west of non-government-controlled Donetsk city, west of Horlivka (non-government-controlled, 39km north-east of Donetsk) and north of Shyrokyne (government-controlled, 100km south of Donetsk).

Between the evenings of 23 and 24 May, the Mission recorded a similar number of ceasefire violations, including a similar number of explosions (about 65), compared with the previous 24 hours. The majority of ceasefire violations were recorded again in areas north Shyrokyne and north-west of non-government-controlled Donetsk city, as well as in areas south-east of Chermalyk (government-controlled, 77km south of Donetsk), southeast of Zalizne (formerly Artemove, government-controlled, 42km north-east of Donetsk) and close to the disengagement area near Petrivske (non-government-controlled, 41km south of Donetsk), where the majority of explosions were recorded (see below).

In Luhansk region, between the evenings of 22 and 23 May, the SMM recorded fewer ceasefire violations, including two explosions, compared with the <u>previous reporting period</u> (about 125 explosions). The majority of ceasefire violations were recorded in areas east of Popasna (government-controlled, 69km west of Luhansk).

Between the evenings of 23 and 24 May, the Mission recorded more ceasefire violations, including, however, the same number of explosions (two), compared with the previous 24 hours. The majority of ceasefire violations were recorded in areas east of the disengagement area near Zolote (government-controlled, 60km west of Luhansk) (see below).

Woman injured while home in Marinka

The SMM followed up on reports of a woman injured in Marinka (government-controlled, 23km south-west of Donetsk) on 7 April. On 9 April, medical staff at a hospital in Kurakhove (government-controlled, 40km west of Donetsk) told the Mission that a woman had been brought in from Marinka on 7 April. On 23 May, the woman (in her sixties) told the Mission that she had been on the porch of her home at 52A Telmanova Street in Marinka on the afternoon of 7 April when she heard an explosion and felt a sudden pain in her right leg. The woman added that shortly thereafter an ambulance had brought her to a hospital in Kurakhove. According to a medical certificate presented by the woman, she had sustained a shrapnel injury to her right knee on 7 April.

At the abovementioned address, the Mission saw recent shrapnel damage to an east-south-east-facing metal fence located about 5m east-south-east of a one-storey house. The woman told the Mission that the fence had been damaged on 7 April.

Members of the armed formations continued to deny the SMM passage at checkpoints along the contact line in Donetsk and Luhansk regions

Members of the armed formations continued to deny the SMM passage at checkpoints in both Donetsk and Luhansk regions along official crossing routes. These restrictions constitute an impediment to the implementation of the Mission's mandate.⁵

In Donetsk region, on 23 May, at a checkpoint west of Verkhnoshyrokivske (formerly Oktiabr, non-government-controlled, 85km south of Donetsk), an armed member of the armed formations <u>again</u> denied the SMM passage towards non-government-controlled areas, referring to quarantine restrictions due to the COVID-19 outbreak.*

On 24 May, at a checkpoint north of Horlivka, two armed members of the armed formations again denied the SMM passage towards non-government-controlled areas, referring to restrictions due to the COVID-19 outbreak. The SMM also continued to observe the presence of a metal barrier and spikes laid across the road, and of a mine hazard sign.*

On the same day, at a checkpoint of the armed formations east of Kreminets (non-government-controlled, 16km south-west of Donetsk), a member of the armed formations again denied the SMM passage, citing "the closure of the checkpoint" and "an ongoing operation in the area".*

In Luhansk region, at a checkpoint south of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge (15km northeast of Luhansk), a member of the armed formations again denied the SMM passage towards non-government-controlled areas on 23 May and toward government-controlled areas on 24 May.*

Disengagement areas near Stanytsia Luhanska, Zolote and Petrivske⁶

On 23 and 24 May, inside the **disengagement area near Stanytsia Luhanska** (government-controlled, 16km north-east of Luhansk), the SMM saw members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) between the new span of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge and their checkpoint south of it.

On 22 May, while positioned on the southern edge of the disengagement area, the SMM observed a non-SMM unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV) (black/grey quadcopter type) flying along the southern edge of the **disengagement area near Zolote**, after which the SMM left the area due to security considerations.*

On the evening of 22 May and during the day on 23 May, the SMM recorded two undetermined explosions and ten projectiles in flight (assessed as outside the disengagement area but within 5km of its periphery).

On the night of 23-24 May, the SMM camera in Zolote recorded an undetermined explosion and 15 projectiles in flight (unable to be assessed as inside or outside the disengagement area), as well as 16 projectiles (assessed as outside the disengagement area but within 5km of its periphery).

On 23 and 24 May, the Mission saw members of the armed formations (wearing armbands with "JCCC" written on them) near the southern edge of the disengagement area. On both days, it saw two of them walking on road T-1316 inside the disengagement area up to about 350m north of its southern edge.

On the evening of 22 May, inside the **disengagement area near Petrivske**, an SMM longrange UAV spotted at least six persons inside a former position of the armed formations near the area's south-eastern edge.

On the evening and night of 22-23 May, the SMM camera 2km east of Bohdanivka (government-controlled, 41km south-west of Donetsk) recorded 32 projectiles in flight at an assessed range of 1-4km east and east-south-east (assessed as inside the disengagement area).

During the day on 23 May, while positioned at two locations near the disengagement area, the SMM observed a calm situation.

On the evening and night of 23-24 May, the abovementioned camera recorded 35 projectiles in flight and a muzzle flash at an assessed range of 1-3km east and east-southeast (assessed as inside the disengagement area), as well as two undetermined explosions at an assessed range of 4-6km south-east (assessed as outside the disengagement area but within 5km of its periphery).

During the day on 24 May, while positioned about 2km north of Petrivske, the SMM heard 37 undetermined explosions and four shots of small-arms fire (assessed as outside the disengagement area but within 5km of its periphery).

Withdrawal of weapons

The SMM continued to monitor the withdrawal of weapons in implementation of the Memorandum and the Package of Measures and its Addendum. It observed weapons in violation of withdrawal lines in government- and non-government-controlled areas of Donetsk region, including in training areas. (For further details, see the tables below.)

Indications of military and military-type presence inside the security zone⁷

In the security zone in Donetsk region, the SMM observed armoured combat vehicles in government-controlled areas, including some in residential areas, as well as newly built trenches in non-government-controlled areas (for further details, see the table below).

On 22 May, while positioned about 2km east of Zolote-2/Karbonit (government-controlled, 62km west of Luhansk), the SMM heard and saw a non-SMM UAV flying south-east to north-east near its position. The SMM left the area due to security considerations.*

On the evening of 22 May, an SMM long-range UAV spotted about four impacts with dust and smoke rising from them in a field about 2km north-west of Lozove (non-government-

controlled, 52km north-west of Donetsk). The SMM was unable to determine the weapons used or the direction of fire.

Mine hazard signs near non-government-controlled Lyman and Luhanske

On 23 May, in a field north of Luhanske (non-government-controlled, 15km south-west of Donetsk), the Mission saw for the first time two mine hazard signs (red with a skull and crossbones and "Mines" written in Cyrilic).

On 24 May, about 2km north-west of Lyman (non-government-controlled, 12km north-west of Luhansk), at the entrance to a newly built trench-bunker on the northern side of a local road, the SMM saw for the first time a mine hazard sign (red metallic or wooden square with "Stop Mines" written in Cyrillic).

SMM facilitation of repairs to and operation of critical civilian infrastructure

On 23 May, from 12:00 to 16:00, in both government- and non-government-controlled areas, the SMM <u>continued</u> to monitor repairs to power transmission lines near Berezivske (non-government-controlled, 53km north-west of Luhansk). While positioned on the western edge of Berezivske, the SMM recorded two undetermined explosions at an assessed range of 3-4km north-west (see the table below).

The SMM continued to facilitate the operation of the Donetsk Filtration Station (DFS) (15km north of Donetsk) on 23 and on 24 May. On 24 May, while positioned at two locations near the station, the Mission heard three undetermined explosions as well as shots of small-arms fire, all assessed as within a 5km radius of the DFS.

Border areas outside government control

On 23 May, the SMM monitored border areas near Petrivske (65km east of Donetsk), Tarany (74km east of Donetsk), Hryhorivka (75km east of Donetsk) and Vilkhivchyk (formerly Novopetrivske, 78km east of Donetsk), where it observed a calm situation.

Measures taken at entry-exit checkpoints and corresponding checkpoints amid COVID-19 outbreak

In Donetsk region, on 23 and 24 May, the SMM noted that the entry-exit checkpoint (EECP) near Marinka and its corresponding checkpoint east of Kreminets remained closed.

On 24 May, the Mission saw that the EECP near Maiorsk (government-controlled, 45km north-east of Donetsk) and the corresponding checkpoint of the armed formations near Horlivka remained closed.*

In Luhansk region, on 23 and 24 May, the SMM saw that the EECP in Stanytsia Luhanska and its corresponding checkpoint of the armed formations south of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge remained closed.*

Security situation in south-east Kherson region

On 23 May, the SMM observed a calm situation in south-east Kherson region, at the checkpoints near Kalanchak (67km south-east of Kherson) and near Chaplynka (77km south-east of Kherson) between Kherson region and Crimea.

Peaceful gathering in Odessa

On 24 May, on Prymorskyi Boulevard in Odessa, the SMM monitored a gathering of about 200 people (mostly men, mixed ages), some of whom were holding Ukrainian flags and expressing messages critical of the Government. The Mission saw police officers onsite securing the gathering, which ended without incidents.

The Mission continued monitoring in Lviv, Ivano-Frankivsk, Kharkiv, Dnipro, Chernivtsi and Kyiv.

*Restrictions of the SMM's freedom of movement or other impediments to fulfilment of its mandate

The SMM's monitoring and freedom of movement are restricted by security hazards and threats, including risks posed by mines and unexploded ordnance (UXO) and other impediments – which vary from day to day. The SMM's mandate provides for safe and secure access throughout Ukraine. All signatories of the Package of Measures have agreed on the need for this safe and secure access, that restriction of the SMM's freedom of movement constitutes a violation, and on the need for rapid response to these violations. They have also agreed that the Joint Centre for Control and Co-ordination (JCCC) should contribute to such response and co-ordinate mine clearance. Nonetheless, the armed formations in parts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions frequently deny the SMM access to areas adjacent to Ukraine's border outside control of the Government (for example, SMM Daily Report 19 May 2020). The SMM's operations in Donetsk and Luhansk regions remain restricted following the fatal incident of 23 April 2017 near Pryshyb; these restrictions continued to limit the Mission's observations.

Denial of access:

- On 23 May, at a checkpoint west of Verkhnoshyrokivske (formerly Oktiabr, non-government-controlled, 85km south of Donetsk), an armed member of the armed formations <u>again</u> denied the SMM passage towards non-government-controlled areas, referring to quarantine restrictions due to the COVID-19 outbreak.
- On 23 and 24 May, at a checkpoint south of the Stanytsia Luhanska bridge (15km north-east of Luhansk), a member of the armed formations <u>again</u> denied the SMM passage towards non-government-controlled areas and towards government-controlled areas, respectively.
- On 24 May, at a checkpoint north of Horlivka (non-government-controlled, 39km north-east of Donetsk), two armed members of the armed formations <u>again</u> denied the SMM passage towards non-government-controlled areas, referring to restrictions due to the COVID-19 outbreak. The SMM continued to observe the presence of a metal barrier and spikes laid across the road, and of a mine hazard sign.
- On 24 May, at a checkpoint of the armed formations east of Kreminets (non-government-controlled, 16km south-west of Donetsk), a member of the armed formations denied the SMM passage, citing "the closure of the checkpoint" and "an ongoing operation in the area".
- On 24 May, at a checkpoint about 1.5km north-east of Starolaspa (non-government-controlled, 51km south of Donetsk), two armed members of the armed

- formations denied the SMM passage, citing "the SMM's safety". While present at the checkpoint, the SMM saw civilian vehicles passing through it.
- On 24 May, in Prymorske (non-government-controlled, 76km south of Donetsk), two armed members of the armed formations denied the SMM passage, citing "sniper activity in the area".
- On 24 May, at a checkpoint near Bessarabka (non-government-controlled, 85km south of Donetsk), three armed members of the armed formations denied the SMM passage, referring to quarantine restrictions and citing the "need to provide written permission from those in control".

Delay:

- On 24 May, at a checkpoint near Shevchenko (non-government-controlled, 69km south of Donetsk), a member of the armed formations allowed the SMM passage after 16 minutes of waiting.

Regular restrictions related to disengagement areas and mines/UXO:

The sides continued to deny the SMM full access, as well as the ability to travel certain roads previously identified as important for effective monitoring by the Mission and for civilians' movement, through failure to conduct comprehensive clearance of mines, UXO and other obstacles.

Other impediments:

- On 21 May, an SMM long-range UAV experienced GPS signal interference, assessed as probable jamming, while flying over areas between Stepanivka (government-controlled, 54km north of Donetsk) and Dokuchaievsk (nongovernment-controlled, 30km south-west of Donetsk), between government-controlled Svitlodarsk (57km north-east of Donetsk) and Katerynivka (64km west of Luhansk), and between Myronivskyi (government-controlled, 62km north-east of Donetsk) and Dolomitne (53km north-east of Donetsk).8
- On 22 May, while positioned about 2km east of Zolote-2/Karbonit (government-controlled, 62km west of Luhansk), the SMM heard and saw a non-SMM UAV flying near its position. The Mission left the area (see above).
- On 22 May, while positioned on the southern edge of the disengagement area near Zolote (government-controlled, 60km west of Luhansk), the SMM saw a non-SMM UAV. The Mission left the area (see above).
- On 23 May, an SMM mini-UAV experienced signal interference, assessed as caused by probable jamming, while flying over areas near Lebedynske (government-controlled, 99km south of Donetsk).


