Using Technology to Combat Trafficking in Human Beings: Turning a Liability into an Asset

Venue

The 19th High-level *Alliance against Trafficking in Persons* conference will focus on how technology is being misused to facilitate trafficking in human beings as well as on how to harness its potential in order to combat trafficking in human beings for different exploitative purposes.

It will take place on **Monday**, **8**th **April** (**afternoon**) **and Tuesday**, **9**th **April**, **2019** at the OSCE premises in the Hofburg Congress Center, Heldenplatz, 1010 Vienna.

The meeting will be held in English with simultaneous interpretation from/to English, Italian, Russian, French, German and Spanish.

Visa support letters can be requested by e-mail to Ms. Elke Lidarik < elke.lidarik@osce.org >. Please note that visas will only be granted for the period of the seminar and that your request should be accompanied by a passport copy.

Please be aware that it might take 14 days to get the requested Schengen visa. Therefore applicants are strongly advised to apply for visa well in time.

Please note that it is NOT possible to have your visa issued at the Vienna International Airport upon arrival. Participants must be in possession of the appropriate identity documents for travel to Austria and medical insurance for the full duration of the intended stay.

Shipments
