2. The impact of COVID-19 pandemic on transport



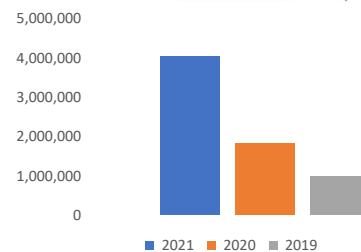
- All border-crossing points operate 24 hours;
- Mandatory health screening upon entering Azerbaijan;
- Disinfection barriers were installed at all customs border crossing points;
- Accompanying of foreign carriers by traffic police services;
- Monitoring of transit vehicles by a GPS system.

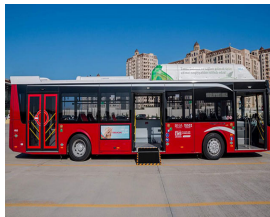


4. Low-carbon and climate-resilient transport

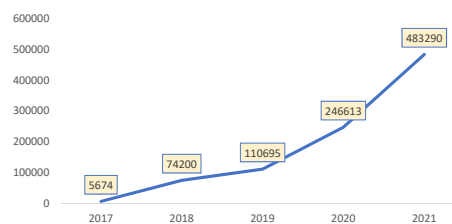

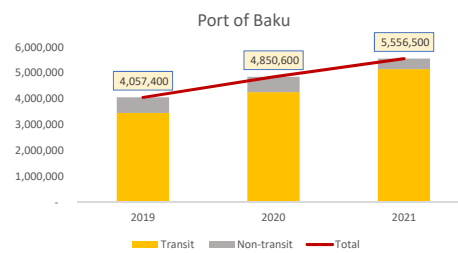




BAKU INTERNATIONAL SEA TRADE PORT
