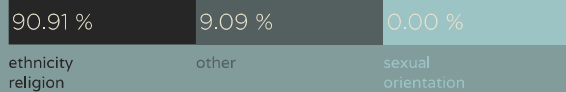

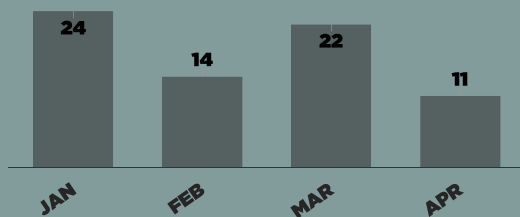

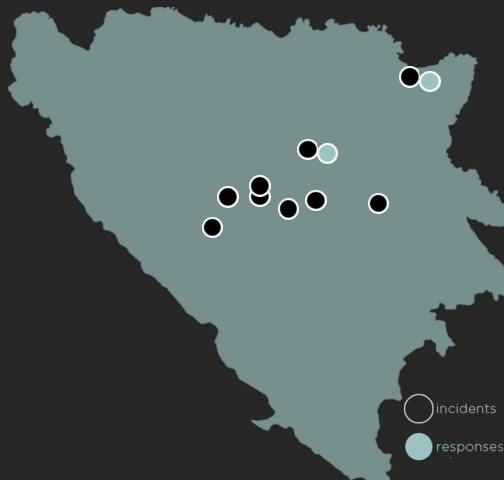

In April, the City of Gradačac adopted the Community Cohesion Action Plan for 2022-2023. This contains planned activities promoting dialogue, culture, tolerance, social cohesion and the integration of marginalized groups. Also, Gradačac City Mayor signed a Protocol on reacting in case of hate motivated incidents which provides guidelines to the City Administration on how to promptly respond to and publicly condemn hate incidents.

The Hate Monitor provides an update on all potential hate-motivated incidents and responses known to the OSCE Mission to BiH at the time of publishing the report.
