Hate crime

The ODIHR will deliver its Law **Enforcement Officer Programme** on Combating Hate Crime in Kyiv on 13-14 September. Over 30 Ukrainian police officers will attend the course, which is being organized in co-operation with the police training academy.

The programme trains officers to recognize and respond to hatemotivated crimes, and has already been run in Croatia, Hungary and Spain.

Domestic violence

In a separate initiative, the ODIHR, in co-operation with the OSCE Project Co-ordinator in Ukraine, organized a training course on combating domestic violence on 6-7 September in Yalta.

The training was delivered by experts from the Austrian Ministry of Interior to 30 senior Ukrainian police officers, and looked at various issues, including co-operation between the police, the judiciary and NGOs.
