OSCE's E-learning Module On Countering the Use of the Internet for Terrorist Purposes

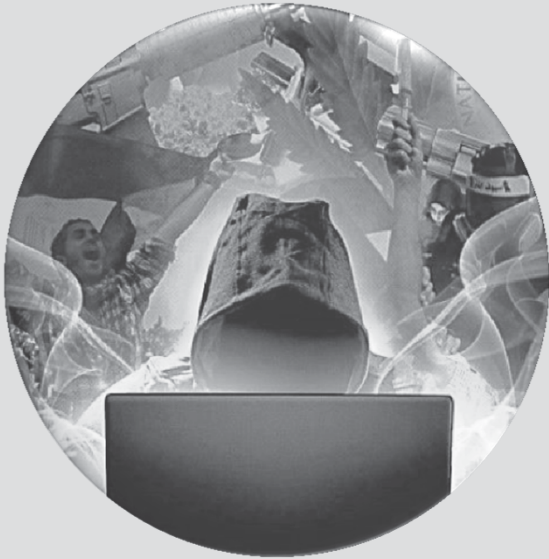


What is an OSCE E-learning Module? What are the objectives?

- ✓ The OSCE is developing a **public, modern on-line tool** that will offer up-to-date course materials
- ✓ It will provide **basic knowledge** about the **most relevant aspects** of the use of the Internet for terrorist purposes such as incitement, recruitment, training new members, collection and transfer of funds and organization of terrorist acts
- ✓ The E-learning module will be placed on the OSCE website and will be available to all visitors free of charge

Who is the beneficiary? What are the anticipated results?

- ✓ The group is a **broad range of beneficiaries**, especially those groups of people involved and interested in security issues
- ✓ Decision makers and government officials, academics, teachers and students in police academies and other similar educational institutions
- ✓ Users will complete the module at their own pace with **increased awareness, knowledge and understanding** on how terrorists use the Internet and on possibilities focused on how to counter this threat

How will the content look?

✓ The content will be **broad** and focus on **conceptual issues** surrounding how terrorists use the Internet for their own purpose and a general toolbox including in-depth explorations of case studies

✓ It will include reading material, audio-visual samples, case studies and relevant realistic examples
