
The presence of principles and policies of gender equality in political life in Bosnia and Herzegovina:

from support for female candidates, through appointments to the representation of women in legislative governmental bodies after the 2022 General Election and to visible and invisible obstacles during their term of office



The OSCE Mission to Bosnia and Herzegovina has been continuously analysing local and general elections in Bosnia and Herzegovina since 2014 in order to improve the position of women and young people within party structures, internal procedures and the political culture of political subjects in Bosnia and Herzegovina. In an indirect way, these analyses also indicate the speed of social movements between elections generally - whether the electorate has matured through the rejection of stereotypes associated with women in politics. The goal of the analysis is to provide data that can be compared with data from previous election cycles and with the following elections, with the purpose of showing trends when it comes to the results achieved by women and young people in elections for different levels of government in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

Representation of women in political parties*









Representation by percent by gender in legislative governmental bodies




Representation of gender by caucuses legislative governmental bodies in total




Age of women in legislative governmental bodies in total




Representation of level of education by caucuses, positions and gender




Age groups in legislative governmental bodies




Representation by gender in committees
