Recommendations to the 2019 HDIM

- *To OSCE participating states and OSCE:* Adopt a Ministerial Council decision on political inclusion of people with disabilities.
- *To ODIHR:* Hold a session related to disability rights at every future HDIM.
- *To OSCE participating states:* National governments and regional bodies should collaborate with DPOs and CSOs working on disability rights to implement and enforce the UN Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (CRPD).
- *To OSCE participating states:* Utilize [ODIHR's Guidelines on Promoting the Political Participation of Persons with Disabilities](#). The guidelines were launched at ODIHR's HDIM side-event on September 16th. Based on standards established in international commitments, these Guidelines to Promote the Political Participation of Persons with Disabilities are a practical resource for OSCE participating States to strengthen the ability of democratic institutions – namely, political parties and parliaments – to engage and empower persons with disabilities in political processes.
