In regards to the Observer Mission on the Russian-Ukrainian border, about which the Secretary General just spoke, I would like to stress that the United States values the work carried out by this OSCE field mission just as we value the important work carried out by the OSCE field missions in Armenia, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, and Uzbekistan.
