## OSCE QUESTIONNAIRE ON ANTI-PERSONNEL LANDMINES

### SAN MARINO

#### Part I

The Republic of San Marino is not a State Party to the 1996 Amended Protocol II on Prohibitions or Restrictions on the Use of Mines, Booby-Traps and Other Devices annexed to the 1980 Convention on Conventional Weapons (CCW). San Marino is considering the accession to the Amended Protocol II.

Since the Republic of San Marino does not produce, import or export such devices, no measures have been taken to prevent the indiscriminate use of mines, booby-traps and other devices.

#### Part II

The Republic of San Marino ratified the 1997 Convention on the Prohibition of the Use, Stockpiling, Production and Transfer of Anti-Personnel Mines and on Their Destruction on 24 February 1998.

The Report submitted by San Marino in accordance with Article 7 of the Convention covering the period 1 January – 31 December 2024 is attached.

The San Marino legal system provides that an international agreement, when ratified through the appropriate parliamentary procedure, becomes, *ipso facto*, part of the legal system. Therefore, the provisions of an international agreement that has been duly ratified are directly applicable and there is no need to further implement the legislation.

Moreover, article 251 and article 252 sexies of the Criminal Code of San Marino punish alternatively with first degree imprisonment, second degree or forth degree arrest anyone who, without the required authorizations: makes, introduces in the domestic territory, circulates, holds for the purpose of circulating arms, bombs, gases or explosive devices or inflammable or explosive materials or explodes mines.

Since the Republic of San Marino is not an affected Country, no measures have been taken to provide assistance to the victims.
