# Assistance to Victims of Trafficking

52 % were subjected to sexual exploitation

45% - to forced labour

2,4 % - to exploitation in begging (the remaining 0,6 % refers to assistance to a family members

Out of 148 victims of trafficking subjected to forced labor, 28 victims were exploited in the agricultural sector.



# Out of 28 cases

5 Russian nationals trafficked inside Russia (originating from Astrakhan)

1 Russian (originating from Ufa) trafficked to Kyrgyzstan

22 - non-Russian nationals trafficked to Russia

13 Uzbek nationals referred by the Ministry of Interior

Forced to work 14 hours a day

Passports confiscated

Denied the salary

Some of the women reported being sexually abused by the traffickers

Allowed to leave the area of the workplace

Two traffickers natives of Azerbaijan were arrested
