

ROMA AND SINTI GENOCIDE COMMEMORATION AND EDUCATION

For the first time, the OSCE Office for Democratic Institutions and Human Rights (ODIHR) presents data on teaching about and commemorating the Roma and Sinti genocide within the OSCE region.

The report is part of ODIHR's efforts to promote knowledge about and recognition of the plight of Roma and Sinti during World War II to both counter current discrimination and racism and to promote tolerance.

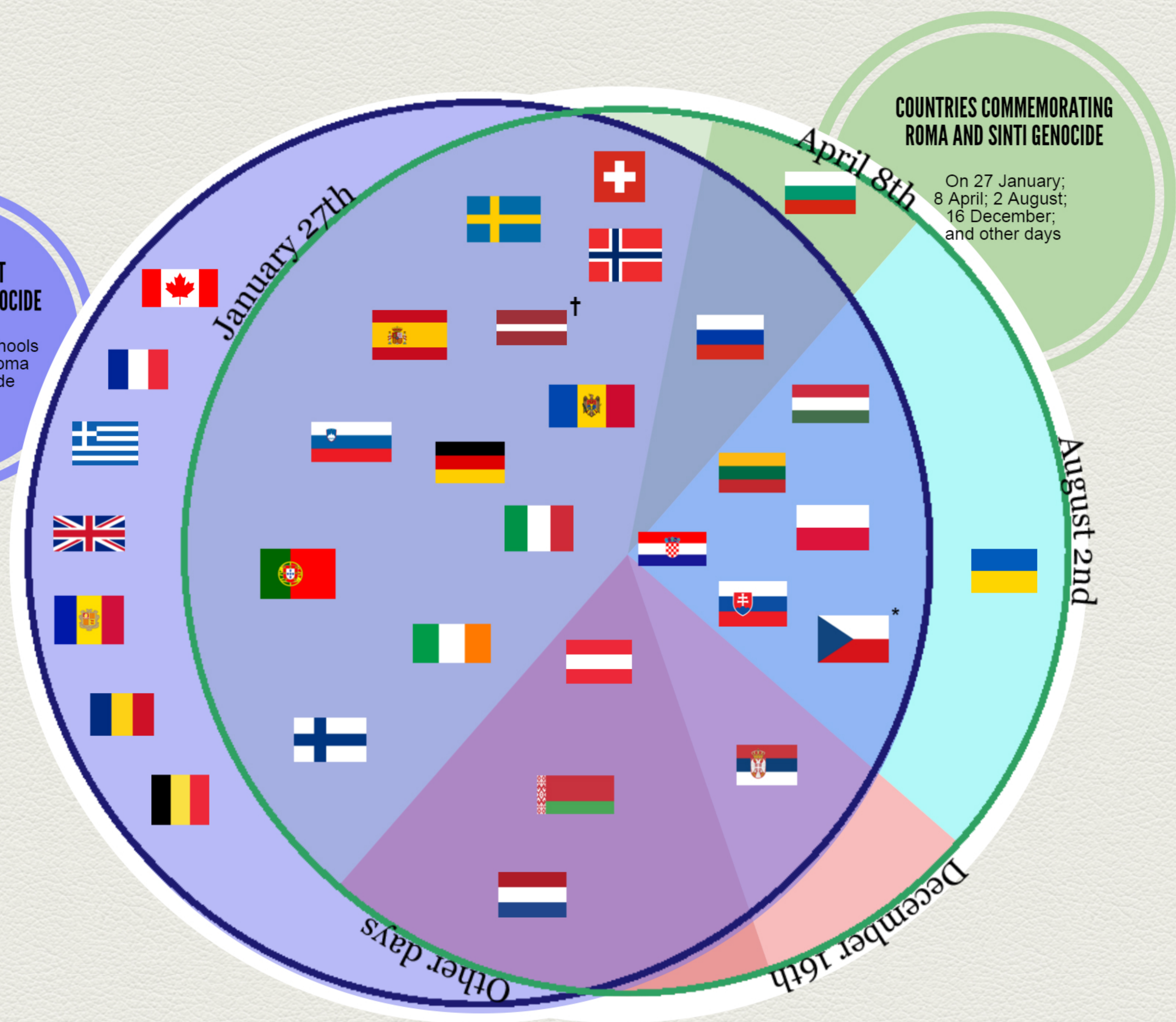
ODIHR also works with participating States to actively promote recognition, education about and commemoration of the Holocaust.
