The Russian Federation's Ongoing Aggression Against Ukraine

As delivered by Chargé d'Affaires Katherine Brucker
to the Permanent Council, Vienna
February 27, 2025

President Trump has been clear: the Russia-Ukraine war must end.

Achieving peace will require significant effort. Last week the President had productive discussions with Presidents Putin and Zelenskyy. All have expressed a shared desire for peace.

These calls demonstrate how we are fully engaged in the diplomacy needed to reach that goal. At the same time, ending the war will be a global effort.

The longer the war continues, the greater the suffering for both nations. The United States is committed to securing a lasting peace—not just a temporary pause. We will continue to play a meaningful and constructive role in this process.
