The Co-Chairs (Spain, Kyrgyz Republic, and United States) of the OSCE's Group of Friends of Youth and Security would also like to recognize the International Day of Youth and give thanks to the young people who have supported their communities in the OSCE region and beyond—especially during the pandemic. With the world's population expected to increase by two billion people in the next 30 years, we support the United Nations' efforts to include youth in addressing future sustainability challenges.

We believe governments must ensure public services not only meet the health and security needs of youth, but that also young people play an active role in shaping community interventions. This year's theme, "Transforming Food Systems: Youth Innovation for Human and Planetary Health," highlights the need for youth to make informed decisions on the healthiest and most sustainable food security choices as the global population continues to grow.
