Madam Chairperson,

I took the floor in reply to the written contribution of the Azerbaijani delegation to the Working session 5 which was distributed today morning. Let me say from the outset that the statement, as delivered by Azerbaijani delegation during the session devoted to Intolerance against Migrants was not about the topic under consideration and was mainly on the role of the Ombudsman. While getting acquainted with the written full version of the statement we found out some elements which have not been voiced during the session and learned that one of the purposes of it was to disseminate falsified information about the nature of Nagoro Karabakh conflict. This kind of usual, repetitive and continued vituperative stance of Azerbaijan towards my country is unacceptable. The tactic of Azerbaijani policy is as clear as a day light. It is very much convenient to claim that Azerbaijan fall a victim of aggression. Armenia firmly denies any such allegations. In reality Nagorno Karabakh conflict is a pure case of implementation of the right of peoples to self-determination exercised by the people of Nagorno Karabakh to which Azerbaijan responded by unleashing large-scale military offence.

I would like to express my regret that Azerbaijan once again abuses the thematic discussions for anti-Armenian propaganda by exploiting international platforms for dissemination of groundless accusations.
