- Natural disaster preparedness initiatives throughout the Southern region
- Regular support to the Central Asian Ecological Journalism Festivals
- Public ecological expertise and participation in decision making in a Transboundary Context

In acknowledging the theme of this seminar and the important transboundary and security context of the theme, we would like to assure you of the further commitment of the OSCE in response to the Environmental and Security priorities.

Before I close, I would like to thank Norway for their most generous contribution to this project and wish you all a fruitful seminar.
