- **Workshop 1 - *Impact of media reporting on migration***

Discussion will focus on frameworks, practices, and the current situation regarding reporting on migration. Participants will also have an opportunity to discuss the related impact of media on public perception, as well as practices in reporting on migration and ways in which these are used in narratives of violent extremist groups.

Workshop panelists are experts in journalism, including on reporting on security challenges, namely **Ms. Ljiljana Zurovac**, former Executive Director of the BiH Press Council and an expert on media self-regulation and ethics, and **Mr. Denis Džidić**, Executive Director and Editor of the Balkan Investigative Reporting Network (BIRN).

The workshop will be held on **Monday, 9 November 2020, starting at 12:00**, and will last for two hours. - **Workshop 2 - *Media literacy among youth in the context of Prevention and Countering Violent Extremism and Radicalization that lead to Terrorism (P/C VERLT)***

Discussion will focus on media literacy among youth, as well as on specific tools for advancing related capacities. Participants will also have an opportunity to improve their understanding on the role of media literacy in resisting VERLT narratives and tools to counter them online.

Workshop panelists are experts in the fields of communication, media and journalism, namely full-time professor at the Faculty of Political Science of the University of Sarajevo, **Prof.dr. Lejla Turčilo**, and Executive Director and Editor of the Balkan Investigative Reporting Network (BIRN), **Mr. Denis Džidić**.
