Transitional Justice Seminar in Novi Pazar:

"Dealing with the past: An Introduction to Transitional Justice with a special focus on War Crimes Trials and the relevant Jurisprudence of the International Criminal Tribunal for the Former Yugoslavia (ICTY) and International Court of Justice (ICJ)."

Location: Novi Pazar

Date: 24 - 27 July 2018.

The seminar is intended for students in the final year of their graduate studies and postgraduate students of universities across Serbia, youth involved in political parties, public administration, media and representatives from the civil society organizations.

The seminar will cover the following topics:

- An introduction to transitional justice mechanisms;
- Truth commissions;
- Reparations;
- The International Criminal Tribunal for the Former Yugoslavia (ICTY) and the International Court of Justice (ICJ) with a special focus on cases dealing with Srebrenica;
- National war crimes trials;
- Crimes based on gender and sexual violence in armed conflict.

Lecturers will include domestic and regional experts in the fields of transitional justice, history, international public law, international humanitarian law, and international criminal law.

The OSCE Mission to Serbia will cover costs of transportation, accommodation and meals for seminar participants. Eligibility is restricted to applicants who are currently residing in Serbia.
