The Organization for Security and Co-operation in Europe (hereinafter referred to as "the OSCE") invites sealed proposals from qualified companies (hereinafter referred to as "the Bidders") for the provision of for the express mail and parcel services (hereinafter referred to as "the Services") in accordance with the requirements outlined in the Request for Proposal Documents (hereinafter referred to as "the RFP Documents").

Any contract awarded as a result of this RFP shall be bound by the terms and conditions specified in the Form of Contract (Section IV). The duration of the proposed contract(s) will be for a period of one year with a possibility of four annual extensions, up to a maximum aggregate duration of five (5) consecutive years. The contract(s) will provide for the use of the Services on "as and when required" basis and throughout the term of the contract the OSCE shall be under no obligation to use the Services of the selected contractor(s). The OSCE can neither confirm to the successful company(ies) any minimum level of business nor the exclusivity of a sole contractor for the Services.
