On the outcome of the Second High-level International Conference on the International Decade for Action "Water for Sustainable Development", 2018–2028

Mr. Chairperson,

We congratulate our Tajik colleagues on the success of the Second High-level International Conference on the International Decade for Action "Water for Sustainable Development", 2018–2028 and also the Central Asian Regional Water Cooperation Forum held on its margins.

The sizeable Russian delegation, headed by Alexander Kozlov, Minister for Natural Resources and the Environment, took a very active part in the conference.
