Special Declaration

We, the participating representatives of the international, regional and sub-regional organizations, bodies of the United Nations system, and international institutions, meeting in Vienna on 11 and 12 of March 2004, express our deepest sympathy and condolences to the Government and people of Spain and solidarity with the victims of the terrorist attacks and their families; reassure our reinforced determination to combat all forms of terrorism in accordance with our responsibilities under our various mandates; and unanimously condemn in the strongest terms the horrifying terrorist attack which took place on 11 March 2004 in Madrid and regard such act, like any act of terrorism, as a threat to peace and security
