STATEMENT BY THE DELEGATION OF PORTUGAL

Mr. Chairperson,

With regard to the elections to the Portuguese Parliament that took place in September 2009 and the assessment of those elections by the Office for Democratic Institutions and Human Rights (ODIHR), I would like to inform delegations briefly as to how the Portuguese Government is continuing to deal with this matter.

The Secretary of State of Internal Affairs of Portugal addressed a letter to Ambassador Lenarčič, Director of the ODIHR, from which I would like to highlight the following:

- Portugal hosted and gave full co-operation to a Needs Assessment Mission carried out in June last year and to the subsequent Election Assessment Mission that was deployed in September.
- The report of the Election Assessment Mission of the ODIHR shows an excellent vision of the electoral process and a very accurate and global understanding of the Portuguese electoral and voter registration legislation.
- The recommendations made therein are also considered fully in respect and coherent with the outlook adopted in ODIHR's electoral missions in a number of participating States. The Portuguese Government studied them carefully and already expressed its views and comments in a reply to ODIHR issued on 5 March.
- On the Mission's remark that the Portuguese legal electoral framework is rather complex, it is conveyed that the Portuguese Government is aware of this situation and has already started a process of harmonization of the norms on procedure, which amount to 80 per cent of the electoral legislation. It is the conviction of the Portuguese Government that, through this exercise, it will be able to address this concern.
- Finally, it is mentioned that the voter registration in Portugal is, since 2008, highly reliable and robust, being permanently auditable by outside parties.

The Secretary of State Internal Affairs assured Portugal's full support to ODIHR's activities which are considered fundamental in the implementation of ever more complete and efficient democratic systems in the OSCE area.

I would like to ask to include this statement in the journal of today's meeting.

The Rules of Procedure of the OSCE will be followed, *mutatis mutandis*, at the Conference. Also, the guidelines for organizing OSCE meetings (Permanent Council Decision No. 762) will be taken into account.

**DECISION No. 947
OSCE POLICE ADVISORY GROUP TO KYRGYZSTAN**

The Permanent Council,

Recalling its statement on the situation in Kyrgyzstan (PC.DOC/1/10) of 15 June 2010, and in particular its offer to assist Kyrgyzstan upon its request in resolving the current crisis, preventing the spillover of tensions in the region, and in promoting post-conflict rehabilitation, and its statement on OSCE Engagement with Kyrgyzstan expressing its readiness to consider the early deployment of a Police Task Force to Kyrgyzstan (PC.DOC/2/10) of 2 July 2010,

Reaffirming the mandate of the OSCE Centre in Bishkek (PC.DEC/245 of 23 July 1998),

Taking into account the Kyrgyz Republic's request for OSCE assistance (PC.DEL/555/10 of 16 June 2010) and its agreement (PC.DEL/791/10 of 20 July 2010) to the proposed OSCE action contained in the "Concept Paper on Enhancing Current OSCE Activities to Address the Situation in Southern Kyrgyzstan" (CIO.GAL/95/10/Rev.1 of 22 June 2010),

Noting the "Report from the OSCE Needs Assessment on the Possible Deployment of an OSCE Police Task Force to Kyrgyzstan" (SEC.GAL/117/10) of 30 June 2010 and the document "OSCE Police Advisory Group to Kyrgyzstan" agreed as a result of negotiations in Bishkek on 15 July 2010 between Kyrgyzstan and the OSCE Secretariat with the participation of the OSCE Chairmanship (CIO.GAL/127/10),

Decides:

1. To authorize the deployment, without delay, of an OSCE Police Advisory Group to assist Kyrgyzstan to reduce inter-ethnic tensions, restore public order and strengthen the capacities of the territorial units of the Ministry of the Interior of the Kyrgyz Republic;
2. That the OSCE Police Advisory Group will be established in accordance with the modalities set forth in document CIO.GAL/127/10 within the mandate of the OSCE Centre in Bishkek. The initial deployment for the Advisory Group will be an operational period of four months commencing with the date of the start of operation. This will be kept under review depending on the security situation in Kyrgyzstan and can be extended or altered as deemed

necessary, subject to the agreement of Kyrgyzstan and the necessary Permanent Council decision;

3. That the Secretary General should make arrangements to meet the financial requirements for the operational period until 31 December 2010;
4. To request the Secretary General or his duly authorized representative to agree with the appropriate authorities of the Kyrgyz Republic on the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding;
5. To request the Secretary General to report regularly to the Permanent Council on the implementation of this decision.

The Permanent Council,

Acting in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Financial Regulations, particularly Financial Regulation 2.09, and Permanent Council Decision No. 923 of 22 December 2009,

Taking note of PC.ACMF/32/10 dated 5 July 2010, Mid-Year Review of the Year 2010 OSCE Unified Budget,

Agrees that the 2010 budget of the Secretariat will be increased by the amount of EUR 480,000, which will be funded from the known 2010 cash surplus;

Agrees that the use of such funds for such a purpose is a one-time event not to be considered a precedent;

Approves the financial and human resources for the Funds, Main Programmes and Programmes of the 2010 Unified Budget, as contained in Annex I and Annex II;

Tasks the Secretary General to examine the circumstances resulting in the difference between the 2010 approved Unified Budget and the 2010 Mid-Year Review and to report to the ACMF on the results of the examination and on possible steps to minimize sharp fluctuations in future budgets;

Tasks the Secretariat to undertake an internal assessment on the possibility of moving towards a Euro-denominated salary policy, and on other ways to prevent unforeseen increases in staff costs, with recommendations to be submitted by the end of September.
