Juvenile Delinquency was the theme of discussion in the one-hour live talk show aired on 12th October 2015 on the First Channel of Radio Television Montenegro (RTCG). This was the sixth on the series of twenty shows named "Reaching the Trust Together", which is supported by the OSCE Mission to Montenegro.

Moderated by Andrijana Kadija, participants in the debate included Slavko Milić from Police Directorate; Goran Đuković, judge of the Basic Court in Podgorica; Valentina Smolović, Advisor at Professional Support Service within the Higher Court in Podogrica; Novo Vukićević from the Center for Children and Youth "Ljubović" and Radoje Novović from the Bureau of Education.

Panellists discussed key causes and consequences, as well as prevention mechanisms and sanctions related to juvenile delinquency and agreed that juvenile delinquency is a serious issue which should concern all levels of society including families, educational institutions as well as rule of law and law enforcement institutions. Panellists recognised the importance of institutional co-operation and good communication with media in order to jointly fight this social problem.

The main aim of the talk shows is to serve as a platform for dialogue and to engage various segments of society in Montenegro which will serve in the enhancement of confidence, trust, and co-operation between the public, institutions, media, and civil society.
