Statement of the European Union on the 10th anniversary of the Organization for Democracy and Economic Development- GUAM

Mr. Chairman,

The European Union thanks the Ambassador of Azerbaijan for his statement on behalf of the member States of the Organization for Democracy and Economic Development - GUAM.
