**STATEMENT BY MR. ALEXANDER LUKASHEVICH,
PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION, AT THE
1312th MEETING OF THE OSCE PERMANENT COUNCIL
VIA VIDEO TELECONFERENCE**

6 May 2021

On the situation at the Kyrgyz-Tajik border

Madam Chairperson,

We followed with concern the escalation of the situation along the border between our close allies the Kyrgyz Republic and the Republic of Tajikistan. Unfortunately, the armed clashes were not without casualties on both sides. We express our condolences to the relatives and friends of those killed and wish a speedy recovery to those who were injured.

On 1 May, the Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Russian Federation, Sergey Lavrov, held telephone talks with the Ministers for Foreign Affairs of the Kyrgyz Republic, Ruslan Kazakbayev, and the Republic of Tajikistan, Sirojiddin Muhridin. It was emphasized that Russia welcomes the agreements reached by the parties to resolve the conflict exclusively through political and diplomatic means. As we can see, the situation remains relatively stable for the time being.

We are counting on the parties to strictly abide by their commitments in order to prevent the recurrence of such incidents, in the interest of restoring trust and good-neighbourliness between the two peoples. In the spirit of the principles of strategic partnership and alliance with Kyrgyzstan and Tajikistan, Russia is ready to provide all necessary assistance to this process.
