

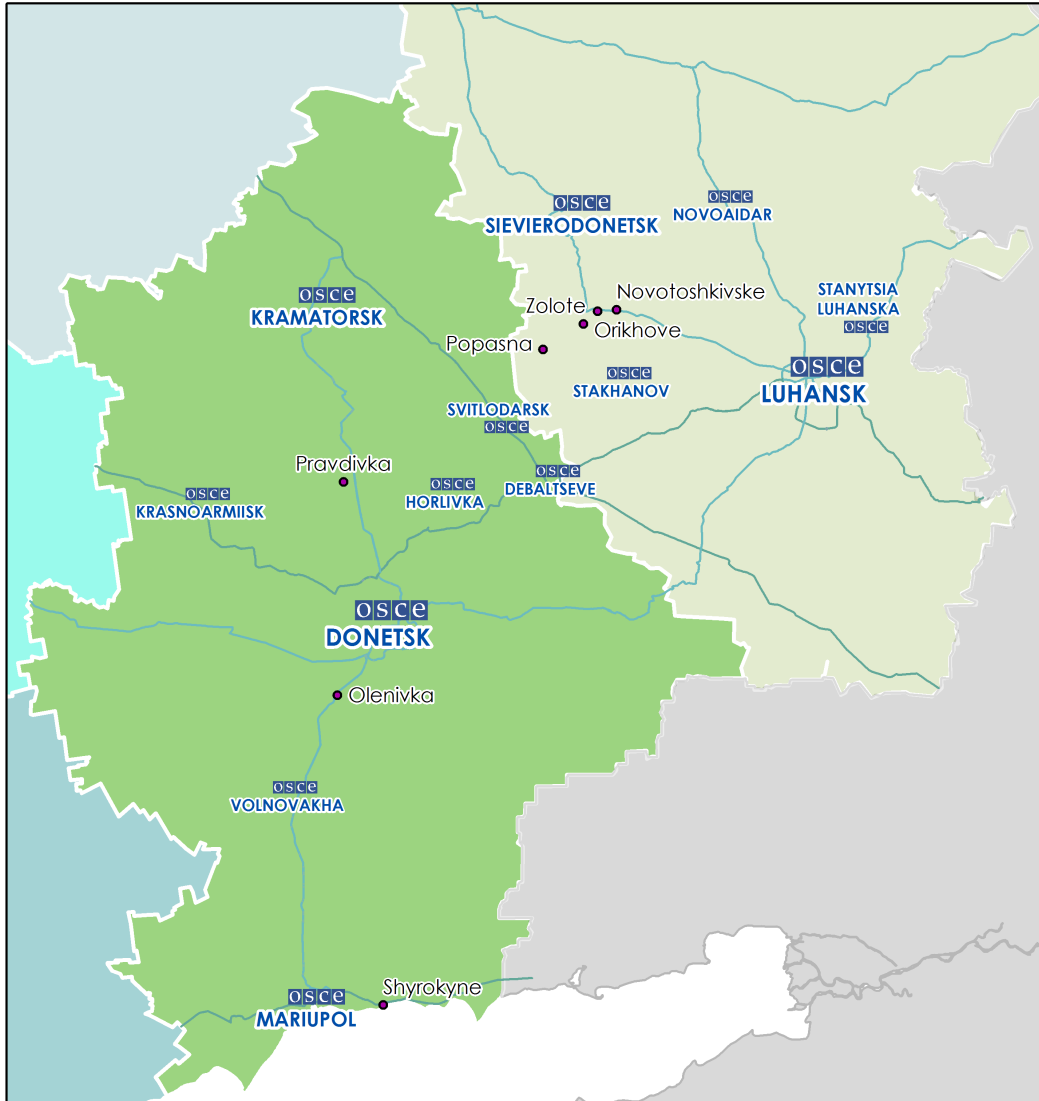

Ceasefire violations recorded by more than one patrol are entered only once.
