### Strategy directive in preparation

- To contribute to coherence and integration between environmental concerns different policies, agreements and legislative measures which have an impact on the marine environment.
- development a Marine Strategy for its marine waters in accordance with the plan of action
- Member States shall cooperate to ensure that, within each Marine Region or Sub-Region, the measures required to achieve the objectives of this Directive, in particular the different elements of the Marine Strategies
